Stale fruits, vegetables allegedly on sale at Junglighat Sunday Market

Consumers demand check by Food Safety Officials

Port Blair, Dec 29: Wish for fresh vegetables and fruits is one of the few things that consumers wake up early on a Sunday morning for visiting Junglighat area. Suggestions pour in from relatives and friends that the commodities sold are fresh and healthy unlike found elsewhere in the retail markets in the South Andaman region on routine days. People get up for morning expedition, head towards Junglighat market only to find that the Haat Vegetable Market with farmers selling a staggering range of local and seasonal produce. Some return home with bad experience finding that the vegetables and fruits they purchased are rotten.

Some of the consumers whom this Correspondent spoke to stated that vendors

at the Junglighat Sunday Market sold them stale vegetables and fruits. "The commodities looked fresh, but while cooking and consumption we found the items to be rotten." Some even claimed that vendors used certain chemicals to keep the agriculture produce look fresh and healthy, but it turns otherwise when consumed. Amid rising of commodities, retail vendors at the Junglighat Market have made it a way to turn profits by cheating gullible customers, as per reports.

"What are the Food Safety Officials doing? Over the years the Sunday Vegetable Market has become extremely popular among consumers from different parts of the city. Heavy rush can be witnessed on Sunday with people along with their families coming to shop for greens here. Such crowd provides

an opportunity to vendors to cheat their customers selling stale fruits and vegetables. The officials concerned should conduct surprise checks on vendors on Sundays to check the quality of green commodities being sold to customers," said a resident of Delanipur. The Sunday Vegetable Market at Junglighat has gained immense popularity in the recent years. Hundreds of shoppers from different parts of South Andaman visit the popular Vegetable market at Junglighat. Cultivators from different parts of South Andamanager at the venue every Sunday to sell their produce. Such is the popularity of the Vegetable Haat Market that even footpaths and parking spaces leading to Junglighat School remains occupied by vendors.

MP for one Pollution Testing Centres each at Baratang, Kadamtala & Billyground

Port Blair, Dec 29: The Member of Parliament of Andaman and Nicobar Islands, Mr. Kuldeep Raj Sharma has requested the Chief Secretary of A & N Administration to direct the concerned departments to open at least one pollution testing center at Baratang, Kadamtala and Billyground areas, so that people of these regions can get pollution test done for their vehicle, without any trouble.

In a letter to the Chief Secretary the Member of Parliament stated that the Andaman and Nicobar Administration has started "Catch the Polluter" drive and has announced a heavy penalty on vehicle owners, who don't

have a PUC certificate. Like always, law-abiding people of Andaman and Nicobar Islands have taken this direction positively and are trying their best to get PUC certificates from different pollution testing centers.

He pointed out that from Baratang to the Mayabunder region there is only one pollution testing center at Rangat. The Member of Parliament said that Middle Andaman is a vast region and taking a two-wheeler, three-wheeler or four-wheeler from places like Baratang to Rangat, just to get a PUC certificate is a difficult task, which in many cases is not possible to complete

in one day. He mentioned that the condition of ATR is also not favourable for two-wheelers and three-wheelers for such a long distance journey. He added that People of the Middle Andaman region are now worried that in case they fail to get a PUC certificate on time, they will have to pay a hefty fine, which most of the Islanders can't afford. Mr. Kuldeep Raj Sharma pointed out that the people of Andaman and Nicobar Islands are willing to get pollution tests done for their vehicle and get a PUC certificate but people of Middle Andaman have the genuine problem of reaching a pollution testing center.

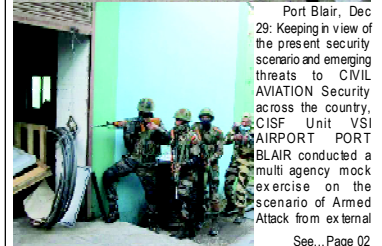

Plan priorities

The Planning Commission has decided upon a reordering of plan priorities and reallocation of resources. In taking this decision, the commission had in view the demands of the areas for higher financial allocation — petroleum exploration and power generation. The sixth plan provides for an indigenous crude production of only 2.6 million tonnes by the last year of the Sixth Plan. Recently, while seeking the massive IMF loan, the government had assured a crude production of 30 million tonnes by the end of the plan period. This called for an increase in the allocation for this sector. The government is also committed to increase the allocation in some other core areas like steel and cement if imports are to be cut.

Three party pact

The Janata Party, the Lok Dal and Congress (S) took the first step towards "unity". After a luncheon meeting Chandra Shekhar, Charan Singh and Shree Pawar decided to set up a four-member coordination to explore the nature and possibility of "joint action" in Parliament and state legislatures. The Bharatiya Janata Party having rejected the move for "organisational unity" with the three parties was not invited to the meeting.

NSA upheld

The Supreme Court in a unanimous decision upheld the National Security Act but laid down guidelines on the use of the law. The judgment warned that preventive detention laws like the NSA must be restricted in their application to "as few cases as possible".

APPLE PUTS FOXCONN'S TN FACILITY ON 'PROBATION' UNTIL STANDARDS ARE MET

Tech titan and Phone maker Apple on Wednesday said it has put Foxconn's Sriperumbudur facility on 'probation', and asserted it will ensure strict standards are met before the unit reopens.

Foxconn's Sriperumbudur factory hit headlines recently over mass food poisoning at its office dormitory facility, an incident that led to

workers' protest

Apple supplier Foxconn, in a statement, said it is restructuring local management team and management systems to ensure it can achieve and maintain the high standards that are needed.

Foxconn Technology Group further informed that all employees will continue to be paid while necessary improvements are undertaken before

restarting operations.

Foxconn said that some of its office dormitory facilities did not meet the required standards.

An Apple spokesperson said: "We hold our suppliers accountable to the highest standards in the industry and regularly conduct assessments to ensure compliance."

Following recent concerns about food safety and accommodation conditions at Foxconn Sriperumbudur, Apple dispatched independent auditors

to undertake additional detailed assessments.

"We found that some of the remote dormitory accommodations and dining rooms being used for employees do not meet our requirements and we are working with the supplier to ensure a comprehensive set of corrective actions are rapidly implemented," Apple spokesperson said.

Apple spokesperson added: "Foxconn's Sriperumbudur facility has been placed on probation and we will ensure our strict standards are met before the facility reopens. We will continue to monitor conditions closely."

Foxconn Technology Group statement said that safety and well-being of employees is the company's top priority.

"We have been investigating recent issues at our Sriperumbudur facility in Tamil Nadu and have found that some of its dormitory facilities do not meet the required standards."

"We are very sorry for the issues our employees experienced and are

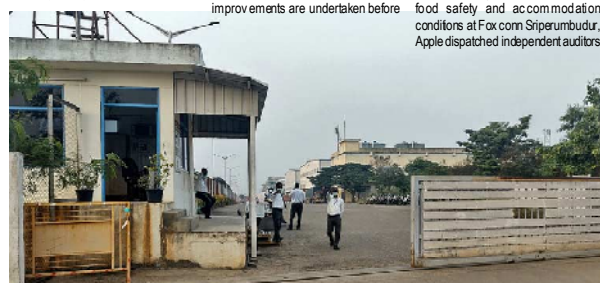
taking immediate steps to enhance the facilities and services we provide at the remote dormitory accommodations," Foxconn said.

The company said it is "restructuring our local management team and our management systems to ensure we can achieve and maintain the high standards that are needed".

"All employees will continue to be paid while we make the necessary improvements before restarting our operations and we will continue to provide support for our employees as they return to work," Foxconn said.

While the plant was widely expected to open around December 30, Apple's latest move to put Foxconn facility on probation could mean some delay in resumption of operations at the plant until all of the standards are met by Foxconn for its employees, say market watchers.

There is no official word from Foxconn yet on when the operations at the said unit will resume.



Congress to get full-time president next September, says head of party's poll body

New Delhi, 29th Dec, 2021: The Congress will get its full-time president by September next year, said a senior member of the grand old party.

The party is currently headed by interim president Sonia Gandhi, who took over after her son and Congress MP Rahul Gandhi resigned from the post following the

Lok Sabha debacle. Madhusudan Mistry, president of the Congress Central Election Authority, said the election process for the post of Congress president will be completed by September according to the schedule decided by the Congress Working Committee. "As per schedule decided by Congress Working Committee, the election process for the post of Congress president will be completed by September: Madhusudan Mistry, president, Congress Central Election Authority," he was quoted as saying by news agency ANI.

The party has been facing

internal rifts in multiple states, besides several senior party leaders openly calling for sweeping changes and an organisational restructuring. In one of the last CWC meetings, Sonia had said the revival of the Congress requires "self-control, discipline, unity and keeping the party's interests paramount." She had further said the party has started preparations for the upcoming elections but "undoubtedly, we face many challenges." She had also underlined that if "we are united, if we are disciplined and if we focus on the party's interests alone, I am confident that we will do well."



Covid: Catching omicron variant could also protect against delta, study finds

London, 29th Dec, 2021: People who catch the omicron variant of Covid may develop enhanced immunity against delta, study has found.

Researchers at the Africa Health Research Institute (AHRI) found that immunity against delta improved four-fold following an exposure to the omicron strain, which is spreading rapidly in the UK.

Omicron displaced delta as the dominant variant in circulation in London earlier this month, and is believed to be significantly more transmissible, thus driving a surge in cases across the UK with a record 129,471 daily cases reported

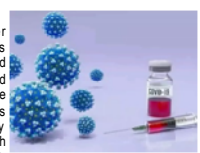
on Tuesday. The AHRI study, which involved 33 vaccinated and unvaccinated people, found that exposure to omicron rose 14-fold after infection. Protection against delta rose 4.4-fold against delta. The increase in delta variant neutralisation in individuals infected with Omicron may result in decreased ability of delta to infect those individuals, the scientists who conducted the study said.

Alex Sigal, the study's co-author, said that "less pathogenic" as it appears, "then this will help push delta out." This could mean "the disruption Covid-19 has caused in our lives may become less," he

added.

According to an earlier South African study, there is reduced risk of hospitalisation and severe disease in people infected with Omicron compared with the Delta variant. However, scientists have cautioned the authors say some of that is likely due to high population immunity in South Africa.

The UK Health Security Agency (UKHSA) estimates that someone with omicron is between 31 per cent and 45 per cent less likely to attend A&E and 50 per cent to 70 per cent less likely to be admitted to hospital than an individual with the Delta variant.



These findings are broadly in line with studies published earlier this month by Imperial College London and the University of Edinburgh. The omicron variant, first detected in southern Africa and Hong Kong in November, has since spread worldwide and threatened to overwhelm hospitals in countries.

Income tax return: Relief by Tax Dept ahead of ITR filing due date

Port Blair, 29th Dec, 2021: The Central Board of Direct Taxes (CBDT) has provided one-time relaxation for verification of e-filed Income Tax Return (ITR) for the Assessment Year (AY) of 2020-21, the Income Tax Department stated.

Taxpayers must remember that the last date to furnish ITR for AY 2021-22 is December 31, 2021. CBDT provides one-time relaxation for verification of e-filed ITRs for AY 2020-21 which are pending for verification due to non-submission of ITR-V form or pending e-Verification. Income Tax India tweeted.

The decision has been taken after large number of electronically filed ITRs for the AY of 2020-21 still

remain pending with the Income Tax Department for want of receipt of a valid ITR-V form at CPC, Bengaluru or pending e-Verification from the taxpayers concerned, the CBDT said in a statement.

CBDT will provide one-time relaxation for submission of ITR-V e-Verification for resolving the grievances of the taxpayers associated with non-verification of ITRs for the AY 2020-21 and to regularise such ITRs. For ITR which is filed electronically without digital signature, the taxpayer is required to verify it within the time limit of 120 days from date of uploading the Income Tax Return.

Taxpayers can complete the verification procedure through Aadhaar OTP, by logging into e-filing account through netbanking, by sending a duly signed physical copy of ITR-V through post to the Income Tax Department Centralized Processing Centre in Bengaluru.



Insurer Can't Deny Claim by Citing Existing Medical Condition: SC

New Delhi, 29th Dec, 2021: An insurer cannot reject a claim by citing an existing medical condition disclosed by the insured person in the proposal form once the policy has been issued, the Supreme Court (SC) has said. The SC held that no insurance company can refuse a claimant citing that the policyholder only disclosed certain medical conditions while signing up.

The SC bench of justices DY Chandrachud and BV Nagarathna also said a proposer is under a duty to disclose to the insurer all material facts within his knowledge. The proposer is presumed to know all the facts and circumstances concerning the proposed insurance, it added.

The bench made the observations while hearing an appeal filed by one Manmohan Nanda, who had bought an overseas Mediacoin business and holiday policy before travelling to the US.

After arriving at the San

Francisco airport, Mr Nanda suffered a heart attack, was admitted to a hospital and underwent an angioplasty. Three stents were inserted to remove the blockage from his heart vessels.



Subsequently, Mr Nanda claimed the treatment expenses from the United India Insurance Company, which was repudiated by the latter stating that the appellant had a history of hyperlipidaemia and diabetes, which was not disclosed while buying the insurance policy.

Earlier, Mr Nanda's plea seeking treatment expenses from the insurer was rejected by the National Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission

(NCDRC), saying he did not disclose that he had been taking statin drugs while buying the Mediacoin policy.

The NCDRC said he failed to comply with his duty to make a complete disclosure of his health conditions. Mr Nanda filed an appeal against the NCDRC order in the SC. At the hearing of the case, the SC observed that the rejection by United India Insurance Company for Mr Nanda's claims for treatment expenses was illegal and not in accordance with the law.

The judges pointed out that the purpose of buying a Mediacoin policy is to seek indemnification for illness or sickness that is not expected and may occur overseas. While the proposer can only disclose what is known to him, his duty of disclosure is not confined to his actual knowledge. It also extends to those material facts he ought to know in the ordinary

course of business, the court said. "Once the policy has been issued after assessing the medical condition of the insured, the insurer cannot repudiate the claim by citing an existing medical condition, which was disclosed by the insured in the proposal form and which condition has led to a particular risk in respect of which the claim has been made by the insured," the SC ruled.

The court said the purpose of buying a Mediacoin policy is to seek indemnification for illness or sickness that is not expected and may occur overseas. "If the insured suffers a sudden sickness or ailment, which is not expressly excluded under the policy, a duty is cast on the insurer to indemnify the appellant for the expenses incurred thereunder," the bench added.

The bench also stated that those signing up for Mediacoin have to disclose to the insurer all material facts within his or her knowledge.

BJP promises to provide alcohol at Rs 50 per bottle if voted to power in Andhra

The BJP in Andhra Pradesh has promised to offer liquor at Rs 50 per bottle, besides several initiatives, if voted to power in 2024 assembly polls.

In a public meeting held on Tuesday, state BJP chief Somu Veeraj, lashing out at Chief Minister Y.S. Jagan Mohan Reddy-led YSR Congress government and opposition Telugu Desam Party, said the political forces in the state 'failed' to develop the state despite the abundant resources and long seacoast it has.

"I am telling you that one crore people are drinking (alcohol) in the state. All of you

people vote for BJP, we will offer you cheap liquor at Rs 75. If the revenues are good we will even supply at just Rs 50 (not bad liquor), definitely a good one," Veeraj said indirectly pointing to high prices of liquor in the state.

Referring to some of the state government direct benefit transfer schemes, the BJP leader said on an average a person consumes liquor for about Rs 12,000 per month and Jagan Mohan Reddy is collecting all that amount and giving it back in the name of a scheme.

Veeraj asserted that BJP is committed to making Amaravati the capital and developing the region in just three years if voted to power in AP.

Describing Communists as barking dogs, Veeraj alleged that the left parties destroyed the country.

Former Union Ministers Prakash Javadekar, Purandareswari and Rajya Sabha members Y.S. Chowdary and M.C. Ramesh also spoke in the meeting.

THE CENTRE IN QUANDARY OVER APPOINTMENT OF COAST GUARD CHIEF G.K. NATARAJAN'S SUCCESSOR

The central government is in a quandary over announcing the name of the next chief of Indian Coast Guards after one of the key contenders for the post has moved the Delhi High Court challenging the latest promotion policy of the Ministry of Defence. And in response to the petition, the high court has stated that promotion, if any made, shall be subject to further orders to be passed by the Delhi High Court.

Current Director-General G.K. Natarajan is retiring on December 31. And after retirement, Natarajan is set to take up the international assignment of executive director of the Regional Cooperation Agreement on Combating Piracy and Armed Robbery against Ships in Asia (ReCAAP) Information Sharing Centre, Singapore.

The ministry of defence is leaned to have recommended a panel of shortlisted officers to the Appointments Committee of Cabinet to take the final decision. But, the government seems to be cautious over announcing the name, as it may lead to an embarrassment if the court over-rides the appointment.

Two Additional Director-General rank officers are in the race for the appointment—Rajan Bargar, chief of the Western Seaboard, and D.S. Pathania, Additional Director General (ADG) at the headquarters in New Delhi. And Bargar has challenged the new promotion policy, which makes it mandatory to consider annual confidential reports (ACR) of the previous five years of a candidate for promotion in the Indian Coast Guard. Thus, to fill vacancy

this year, the candidate's ACRs of 2018, 2017, 2016, 2015 and 2014 would be scrutinised by the promotion panel. The new policy made it mandatory to follow the

central armed police forces (CAPFs). Challenging the MoD policy in the HC, Bargar stated that the Indian Coast Guard has its procedure and rules, policies and guidelines for promotion and does not follow the DoP&T guidelines. Indian Coast Guard follows rules akin to the Indian Navy.

"Two different stands on promotion policy by the Indian Coast Guard has complicated the selection," said a senior defence ministry official. Recently, the defence ministry had conducted an inquiry into allegations of discrepancies in the appointment of top Coast

Guard officers and learnt that alterations were made in ACRs against the norm and certain records were also missing. It was believed that discrepancies were raised in the promotion board for an ADG-level posting, which is the second-highest in the Indian Coast Guard. And early this month, a Director Inspector General of the Indian Coast Guard senior armed forces officer has filed a complaint to the National Commission for Scheduled Castes alleging caste prejudice by his seniors, which was intended to prevent his career progression. He has alleged that his grading was misrepresented, denying him a timely promotion and resulting in a downgrade of seniority.

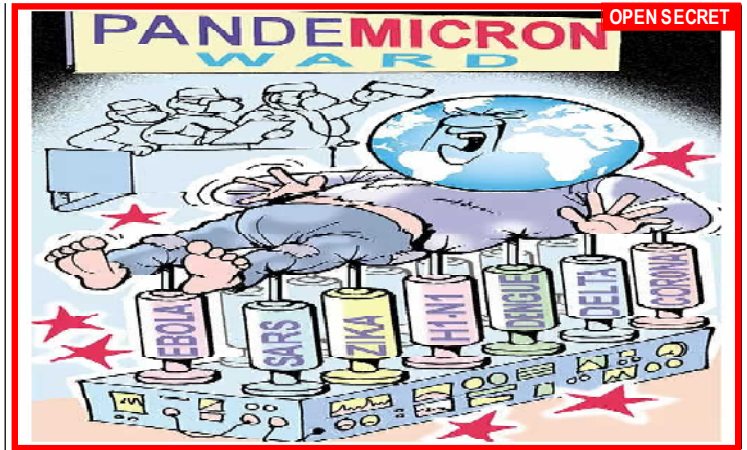

Narco-terror case: NIA files charge sheet against 2, including Pakistani national

The NIA on Wednesday filed a third supplementary charge sheet in a special court Mohali against two narcotics traffickers, including a Pakistani national, for their alleged involvement in a narco-terror case of Hizbul Mujahideen terror group, an official said.

Charges have been slapped on Gurjant Singh of Amritsar and Nasir of Pakistan under sections of the IPC, the NDPS Act and the UA (P) Act, the official of the premier investigation agency said.

The case was registered in April last year in Amritsar after the arrest of Allah Ahmed Sherogini, seizure of a truck and recovery of Rs 29 lakh from his possession.

He was an overground worker and a close associate of

Riyaz Ahmad Naikoo, the then commander of Hizbul Mujahideen in Kashmir, the NIA official said. The National Investigation Agency (NIA) took over the investigation in May last year.

Earlier, a charge sheet against 12 accused was filed by the NIA in this case. Gurjant Singh, a narcotics trafficker, was in close contact with other co-conspirators for the supply of heroin and channelling the proceeds of the sale of narcotics, the official said. Nasir, a Pakistan-based trafficker, was involved in the smuggling of heroin into India in the garb of export of rock salt granules through Attari border, the NIA official said, adding that further investigation in the case continues.

His elder brother Snehasish Ganguly had also tested positive for Covid early this year.
