

Preventive steps taken to contain spread of COVID-19 & Omicron variant in South Andaman

Night curfew to be imposed with no movement of men & materials from today between 9 pm and 5 am

- Shops to be allowed to open from 6 am to 9 pm with 70% capacity of customers by observing COVID appropriate behaviour
- Public Transport/Buses to be allowed to ply with 70% of the capacity; POL outlets to be opened from 5 am to 9 pm

Port Blair, Jan. 3

In order to ensure compliance to the containment measures of isolation and social distancing in the South Andaman District with some of the strategic areas of intervention focusing on containment, test, track, surveillance, clinical management, vaccination and COVID Appropriate Behaviour to control any surge of the cases of COVID-19-Variant of Concern (VoC), 'OMICRON' and also to prevent any disturbance to the peace and tranquility and taking into consideration the request of the public representatives and general public, Shri Suneel Anchipaka, District Magistrate, South Andaman District, in exercise of the powers vested U/s 144 of Cr.P.C., has ordered that night curfew shall be enforced in the entire District of South Andaman from tomorrow (Jan. 4) to Jan. 11, 2022 with no movement of men and materials between 9 pm and 5 am until and unless permitted by the District Magistrate on case to case basis.

Shops selling essential and non-essential items shall be allowed to open from 6 am to 9 pm with 70% capacity of customers by observing COVID appropriate behaviour. It shall be the sole

responsibility of the owner/In-Charge of the shop/business establishment to ensure its compliance and he/she shall be held responsible for any violation and he/she shall be liable to be fined to the tune of Rs.50,000/- in addition to sealing of the shop/establishment for a period of 14 days by the Executive Magistrate and shall be liable for action under DM Act.

No movement of men and material without valid movement pass/e-pass shall be allowed after 9 pm. Movement shall be allowed after 9 pm for medical emergency cases. Persons engaged for essential activities for movement of goods on Andaman Trunk Road, loading and unloading of essential cargo after 9 pm shall be allowed on production of valid movement permit issued by the Office of District Magistrate.

Travel of persons who intend to proceed to their destinations at mainland after 9 pm shall be allowed on production of valid travel documents. However, the person (one person) who intend to pick/drop after 9 pm, should apply for e-pass well in advance with supporting documents and the same shall be issued by the Office of District Magistrate on case to case basis.

Movement of officers/officials involved in providing essential services such as District Administration, Police, CISE, Health Services, ICMR, PBMC, Electricity, Shipping Services, Home Guards, Civil Defence, Tribal Welfare, Fire and Emergency Services, Defence personnel on duty after 9 pm shall be permitted on production of valid Identity Cards issued by their concerned departments. Movement of Officers/Officials, involved in providing services such as Forest, Water Supply & Sanitation in Rural Areas, Disaster Management, Port and related services, Telecommunication shall be allowed after 9 pm on production of movement passes to be issued by the Office of District Magistrate. Movement of personnel involved in providing broadcasting, all print and electronic media persons after 9 pm shall be allowed on production of valid movement passes to be issued by the Office of District Magistrate.

Movement of personnel involved in providing essential/emergency services shall be allowed after 9 pm on production of e-passes to be issued by the Office of District Magistrate. It shall be the

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India records 33,750 new cases of COVID-19, Omicron tally rises to 1,700

New Delhi, Jan. 3

A total of one thousand 700 cases of Omicron variant of COVID-19 have been reported so far in the country. Out of these cases, 639 patients have already recovered. Maximum number of 510 cases have been reported from Maharashtra followed by Delhi with 351 cases. Omicron cases have been reported from 23 States and Union Territories.

More than 145 crore 68 lakh COVID-19 vaccine

doses have been administered in the country so far under the Nationwide Vaccination Drive. Health Ministry said, over 23 lakh 30 thousand doses were administered yesterday. India reported over 33 thousand 750 new cases during the last 24 hours. India's Active caseload stands at one lakh 45 thousand 582. Active cases account for less than one percent of total cases and it is currently at 0.42

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Transport Deptt. issues SOP for operation of Public Road Transport in Isles

Port Blair, Jan. 3

In compliance to the Order issued by the District Magistrate, South Andaman to contain COVID-19, the SOP for operation of Public Road Transport in the UT of Andaman and Nicobar Islands shall be as under: **Passenger Autorickshaw**
♦ Not more than two passengers are permitted to travel at any point of time in any autorickshaw for maintaining social distancing.
♦ Sanitization of the

autorickshaw shall be carried out by the driver after every trip using the prescribed sanitizer.
♦ Wearing of the mask by the driver as well as passengers is compulsory while travelling.
♦ Driver shall ensure that the passengers would wear mask properly.
♦ Driver shall provide hand sanitizer to the passengers mandatorily. **Jeep and Taxis**
♦ Not more than five passengers in Jeep and

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Classes from I to VI in all schools to remain suspended for a period of two weeks from today

Physical classes for Classes VII to IX to be conducted on alternate days & for Class X to XII on daily basis

Attendance will not be mandatory for students of Class VII to XII; can prefer online / digital mode of education

Port Blair, Jan. 3

The classes from I to VI in all schools of all managements (Govt./ Govt. Aided/Private/ Local Bodies/KV/JNV) across Andaman and Nicobar Islands shall remain closed as a precautionary measure for a period of two weeks with immediate effect from tomorrow (Jan. 4). However, the remaining classes of all management schools and other activities shall be conducted as per the details given below:

Physical Classes from Classes VII to IX will be conducted on alternate days with immediate effect for two weeks.

* Physical Classes from Class X to XII will be conducted on daily basis being senior and Board class students.
♦ Attendance will not be mandatory for the students from Class VII to XII. They can prefer to continue their studies through online/digital mode of education.
♦ Academic instruction to the entire student from Class I to XII shall continue to be made available through alternate mode by the Cable TV, Education Department's You Tube Channel 'AN Education Deptt. Andaman' and WhatsApp group.
♦ Cooked Mid Day Meal under PM-POSHAN

Scheme will be served to the students of Class VII & VIII of Govt., Govt. Aided and Local Body Schools only on the days when they attend schools and Food Security Allowance will be provided to these students for the remaining working days excluding holidays as per the norms.

♦ Students from Class I to VI of Govt., Govt. Aided and Local Body Schools will be provided with Food Security Allowances as per norms for all the school working days, a press release from Directorate of Education said.

COVID-19 vaccination for children between 15-18 years of age begins in A&N Islands

1486 doses of Covaxin administered to children on the first day

Port Blair, Jan. 3

Alongwith the rest of the country, the COVID-19 vaccination for the children between 15-18 years of age began in A&N Islands also today. The children were inoculated with Covaxin and second dose will be repeated between 4-6 weeks after the first dose. The beneficiaries will receive the certificate online after the vaccination which needs to be downloaded



from portal. The beneficiaries will also be given a vaccination slip which needs to be produced during the second dose of vaccination. If anyone is

not able to download the vaccination certificate online they must contact the nearest COVID Vaccination Center within 24 hours. The beneficiaries also can



administer the second dose in any part of the Islands.

Today, a total of 1486 doses of covaxin were administered in 13 CVCs. The vaccination

process will be augmented from tomorrow in the entire UT.

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'Catch the Polluter' Campaign to eliminate movement of polluting vehicles

Relaxation granted for motor vehicle owners to produce PUC certificates

Port Blair, Jan. 3

A&N Administration launched 'Catch the Polluter' Campaign to eliminate the movement of polluting vehicles by intensifying enforcement against such vehicles. In this regard, the Competent Authority has provided 15 days relaxation to all the vehicle owners to get their vehicles checked for PUC Certificates i.e up to Jan. 11, 2022 but it is observed that long queues are still persisting.

Considering the long queues of the vehicles at the Pollution Testing Centre, it has been

decided to provide further relaxation for the motor vehicle owners to produce PUC certificates. Accordingly, for two wheelers, relaxation to produce PUC has been given upto Feb. 11, 2022, LMV (Non-Transport Personal Cars) upto Feb. 1, 2022 and for Goods Carriages/Buses/Auto Rickshaws/Others upto Jan. 21, 2022.

The activity of PUC Testing Centre is an outsourced activity by granting authorization under Rule 115(2) of the CMVR 1989 by Transport Department based on the applications received

from the interested applicants. Motor vehicle owners can get their vehicle tested in any of the under mentioned PUC Testing Centers functioning in the UT viz. M/s Annex Marine Engineers, Dollygunj, M/s Rani Laxmi Bai Mahila Mondal, Junglighat, M/s R.D Brothers, Prothrapur, M/s R.D Brothers, Haddo, M/s Fumo, Teylarabad and M/s Sukhoda Engineering Agency & Services near Bus Terminus, Rangat.

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COVID-19 status in A&N Islands

Ten positive cases detected during test conducted on incoming flight passengers

Port Blair, Jan. 3

During the RT-PCR test conducted on 379 passengers who arrived here yesterday, 10 positive cases have been detected. Today, 13 flights with 2170 passengers arrived, out of which, 1773 were vaccinated with both doses while RT-PCR test was conducted on 397 passengers (includes 34 international travellers)

and the reports are awaited.

During RAT conducted on 93 passengers bound for North & Middle Andaman at Ferrargunj, all were found negative. At Mohanpura Bus Terminus, test was conducted on 58 passengers and all were found negative. At Phoenix Bay Jetty, 54 passengers were tested

with RAT and all were found negative. At Helipad, 15 passengers were tested with RAT and all were found negative. Today, 1510 doses of vaccines were administered to beneficiaries, out of which, 1486 Covaxin doses were administered to children, a press release from Directorate of IP&T received here said.

- ♦ Sanitization of the vehicle shall be carried out by the driver after every trip.
- ♦ Wearing of the mask by the driver as well as passengers is compulsory.
- ♦ Driver shall ensure that the passengers would wear mask properly.
- ♦ Driver shall provide hand sanitizer to the passengers mandatorily.

Contract carriage cabs

- ♦ Not more than five passengers in SUV and three passengers in Sedan/ Hatchback are permitted for ensuring social distancing.
- ♦ Sanitization of the vehicle shall be carried out by the driver after every trip.
- ♦ Wearing of the mask by the driver as well as passengers is compulsory.
- ♦ Driver shall ensure that the passengers would wear mask properly.
- ♦ Driver shall provide hand sanitizer to the passengers mandatorily.

Stage carriage buses

- ♦ Stage carriage buses shall be allowed to ply with 70% of the registered seating capacity.
- ♦ No passengers shall be permitted to sit in the co-driver's seat and standing passengers are not allowed.
- ♦ Sanitization of the buses shall be carried out by the driver after every trip and hand sanitizers shall also be kept in the bus for the use of passengers.
- ♦ Wearing of the mask by the crew as well as passengers is compulsory.
- ♦ Bus conductors to ensure that the passengers wear mask properly.
- ♦ Bus conductors shall provide hand sanitizer to the passengers mandatorily.

Any persons violating these measures will be liable to be proceeded against as per the provisions of Section 51 to 60 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, besides legal action under Section 188 of the IPC, and other legal provisions as per Motor Vehicle Act, 1988 & Rules.

Strict Penal action will be taken against the vehicle/ permit owners for violation of any of the conditions without any leniency which may lead to cancellation of permit, an order to this effect issued by Director of Transport said.

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sole responsibility of the owner/In-Charge of the shop/business establishment to ensure its compliance and also if any person attached with such organisation is found misusing the e-passes or using the same for purposes other than it is meant for, the owner/in-charge shall be held responsible and he/she shall be liable to be fined to the tune of Rs.25,000/- and shall also be liable for action under DM Act.

All POL outlets shall be opened from 5 am to 9 pm. Movement of private medical personnel such as Doctors, nursing staff, paramedics etc. attached with diagnostic centres and clinics, veterinary clinics shall be allowed after 9 pm on production of e-passes to be issued by the Office of District Magistrate. Movement of persons from containment zones shall be strictly restricted and shall only be permitted on case to case basis upon approval from the Office of District Magistrate.

Port services will continue to operate as usual and both essential and non-essential cargo can be moved in and out of port, as per requirement for loading/unloading/clearing of cargo and the same shall be permitted till 9 pm only. e-Passes for operation of cargo movement after 9 pm needs to be obtained, which shall be strictly permitted on case to case basis by the Office of the District Magistrate.

Shipping services for Shaheed Dweep and Swaraj Dweep shall be permitted with a carrying capacity of 70% of the vessel and with strict adherence to COVID protocols. Construction activities shall be permitted till 9 pm. Construction activities of national importance and strategic projects beyond 9 pm shall be permitted with prior permission of District Magistrate and e-Passes needs to be obtained, which shall be strictly permitted on case to case basis by the Office of the District Magistrate.

Movement of persons involved with Hotels/Restaurants and Mess for home delivery of food shall be allowed till 9 pm. Dine-in shall be permitted between 6 am to 9 pm only with 70% seating capacity and with strict adherence of COVID appropriate behaviours like wearing of mask, social distancing, cough etiquettes etc. Provision of thermal scanning and use of hand wash and sanitizers will be mandatory. However, take away/parcel service and home delivery should be encouraged. It shall be the sole responsibility of the owner/In-Charge of the shop/business establishment to ensure its compliance and he/she shall be held responsible for any violation and shall be liable to be fined to the tune of Rs.50,000/- in addition to sealing of the shop/establishment for a period of 14 days by the Executive Magistrate and shall also be liable for action under DM Act.

Public Transport/Buses shall be allowed to ply with 70% of the capacity following COVID protocols. Sale and service of liquor at licensed premises shall be permitted till 9 pm with 70% seating capacity and with strict adherence of COVID appropriate behaviours like wearing of mask, social distancing, cough etiquettes etc. Provision of thermal scanning and use of hand wash and sanitizers will be mandatory. SOPs and orders regarding the timings for sale and service of liquor at all licensed establishments (C, C1, B1, B2, B3 and B4 category) issued by the Deputy Commissioner (Excise), South Andaman should be strictly adhered to.

All Parks/ Playgrounds/ Stadiums/Gyms and yoga institutes shall be permitted till 9 pm with gathering not exceeding 70% of carrying capacity of the same and with strict adherence of COVID appropriate behaviours like wearing of mask, social distancing, cough etiquettes etc. Any person violating the above directions shall be liable for fine to the tune of Rs.1,000/-, whereas the organisation shall be fined to the tune of Rs.25,000/-.

All Religious places/places of worship are allowed to open till 9 pm with gathering not exceeding a maximum of 70% of the capacity of the hall and with strict adherence of COVID appropriate behaviours like wearing of mask, social distancing, cough etiquettes etc..Provision of thermal scanning and use of hand wash and sanitizers will be mandatory. The Management Committee of the religious places shall be responsible to ensure strict compliance of the COVID appropriate behaviours and any violations in this regard shall be liable for fine to the tune of Rs.25,000/- payable by the Committee. Religious places/places of worship in containment zones shall remain closed. Only those outside containment zones will be allowed to open up. No tribal passes will be issued for southern group of Islands till further orders except for official purposes/national importance and strategic projects.

Social gatherings shall be allowed with 70% capacity of the hall and prior permission of the District Magistrate with strict adherence of COVID appropriate behaviours like wearing of mask, social distancing, cough etiquettes etc. Provision of thermal scanning and use of hand wash and sanitizers will be mandatory. The parties concerned and management committee of the Hall/Hotel shall be responsible to ensure strict compliance of the COVID appropriate behaviours and any violations in this regard shall be liable for fine to the tune of Rs.50,000/-.

Theatres shall be permitted to function with 70% seating capacity and with strict adherence of COVID appropriate behaviours like wearing of mask, social distancing, cough etiquettes etc. Provision of thermal scanning and use of hand wash and sanitizers will be mandatory. The owner of the theatre shall be liable for fine to the tune of Rs.50,000/-, in case of any violations.

Academic congregations shall be allowed with 70% seating capacity and with strict adherence of COVID appropriate behaviours like wearing of mask, social distancing, cough etiquettes etc. Provision of thermal scanning and use of hand wash and sanitizers will be mandatory. The Owner/ Proprietor of the academic institutions/coaching centre shall be responsible to ensure strict compliance of the COVID appropriate behaviours and any violations in this regard shall be liable for fine to the tune of Rs.50,000/-.

Fresh SOPs in this regard shall be issued by the Education Department. Indoor sports activities shall be allowed with 70% capacity and strict adherence of COVID appropriate behaviours like wearing of mask, social distancing, cough etiquettes etc. Provision of thermal scanning and use of hand wash and sanitizers will be mandatory. The management of the indoor facility shall be responsible to ensure strict compliance and any violations of the directions shall be liable for fine to the tune of Rs.25,000/-.

SOPs in this regard shall be issued by concerned department. e-pass for emergency movement during restricted timings may be submitted online on <https://epass.andaman.gov.in>. The applicants/ organizations submitting applications for e-pass should invariably submit valid and clear supporting documents, failing which the application will be summarily rejected.

In view of the emergent circumstances, this order is being issued exparte and is addressed to the public in general. This order shall be promulgated in the South Andaman District. Further, the Superintendent of Police/Sub-Divisional Magistrate/Executive Magistrates and all authorities concerned shall ensure strict compliance of this order and shall adequately inform and sensitize the field functionaries to note that these restrictions fundamentally relate to movement of people, but not to that of essential services.

Any disobedience of the above orders shall invite penal action u/s 188 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and the relevant provisions of the Disaster Management Act, 2005 against the violator(s) and fine shall also be imposed as per Order issued by this office from time to time. The order shall subsequently be reviewed after one week, the order to this effect issued by DM (SA) added.

The Ministry said, the recovery rate is currently at 98.20 percent. Over ten thousand people recovered in the last 24 hours and total recoveries touched three crore 42 lakh 95 thousand 407.

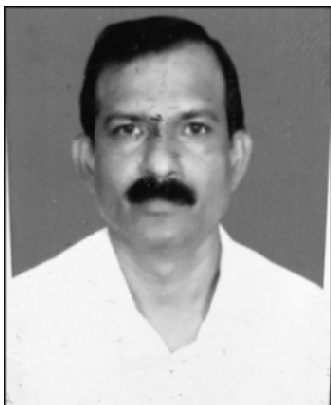

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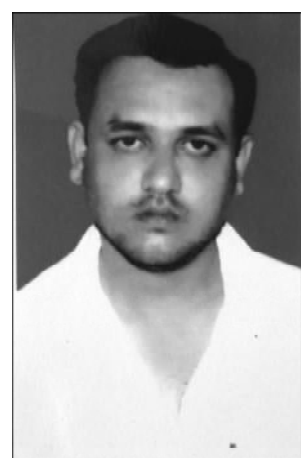

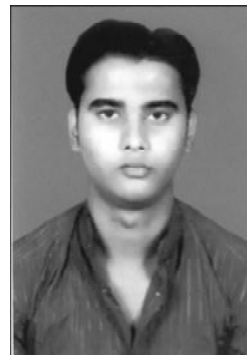
