Night curfew to be imposed with no movement of men & materials from today between 9 pm and 5 am

- Shops to be allowed to open from 6 am to 9 pm with 70% capacity of customers by observing COVID appropriate behaviour
- Public Transport/Buses to be allowed to ply with 70% of the capacity; POL outlets to be opened from 5 am to 9 pm

In order to ensure compliance to the containment measures of isolation and social some of the strategic areas of intervention focusing on containment, test, track, surveillance, clinical management, vaccination and COVID Appropriate Behaviour to control any surge of the cases of COVID-19-Variant of Concern (VoC), 'OMICRON' and also to prevent any disturbance to the peace and tranquility and taking into consideration the request of the public representatives and general public, Shri Suneel Anchipaka, District Magistrate, South Andaman District, in exercise of the powers vested U/s 144 of Cr.P.C., has ordered that night curfew shall be enforced in the entire District of South Andaman from tomorrow (Jan. 4) to Jan. 11, 2022 with no and 5 am until and unless permitted by the District Magistrate on case to case basis.

Shops selling essential and non-essential items 70% capacity of customers by observing COVID same shall be issued by the Office of District by the Office of District Magistrate. It shall be the appropriate behaviour. It shall be the sole Magistrate on case to case basis.

responsibility of the owner/In-Charge of the shop/ business establishment to ensure its compliance and he/she shall be held responsible for any distancing in the South Andaman District with violation and he/she shall be liable to be fined to the tune of Rs.50,000/- in addition to sealing of the shop/establishment for a period of 14 days by the Executive Magistrate and shall be liable for action under DM Act.

> valid movement pass/e-pass shall be allowed after 9 pm. Movement shall be allowed after 9 pm for medical emergency cases. Persons engaged for essential activities for movement of goods on Andaman Trunk Road, loading and unloading of essential cargo after 9 pm shall be allowed on production of valid movement permit issued by the Office of District Magistrate.

- three passengers in Taxi are permitted for ensuring social distancing.
- Sanitization of the vehicle shall be carried out by the driver after every trip. Wearing of the mask by the driver as well as passengers is compulsory.
- Driver shall ensure that the passengers would wear mask properly.
- Driver shall provide hand sanitizer to the passengers mandatorily.

Contract carriage cabs

- ♦ Not more than five passengers in SUV and three passengers in Sedan/ Hatchback are permitted for ensuring social distancing.
- Sanitization of the vehicle shall be carried out by the driver after every trip. • Wearing of the mask by the driver as well as passengers is compulsory.
- Driver shall ensure that the passengers would wear mask properly.
- Driver shall provide hand sanitizer to the passengers mandatorily.

Stage carriage buses

- ♦ Stage carriage buses shall be allowed to ply with 70% of the registered seating
- No passengers shall be permitted to sit in the co-driver's seat and standing passengers are not allowed.
- Sanitization of the buses shall be carried out by the driver after every trip and
- hand sanitizers shall also be kept in the bus for the use of passengers.
- Wearing of the mask by the crew as well as passengers is compulsory. Bus conductors to ensure that the passengers wear mask properly.
- Bus conductors shall provide hand sanitizer to the passengers mandatorily.
- Any persons violating these measures will be liable to be proceeded against as per the provisions of Section 51 to 60 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005. besides legal action under Section 188 of the IPC, and other legal provisions as per Motor Vehicle Act, 1988 & Rules.

Strict Penal action will be taken against the vehicle/permit owners for violation of any of the conditions without any leniency which may lead to cancellation of permit, an order to this effect issued by Director of Transport said.

sole responsibility of the owner/In-Charge of the shop/business establishment to ensure its compliance and also if any person attached with such organisation is found misusing the e-passes or using the same for purposes other than it is meant for, the owner/in-charge shall be held responsible and he/she shall be liable to be fined to the tune of Rs.25,000/and shall also be liable for action under DM Act.

All POL outlets shall be opened from 5 am to 9 pm. Movement of private medical personnel such as Doctors, nursing staff, paramedics etc. attached with diagnostic centres and clinics, veterinary clinics shall be allowed after 9 pm on production of e-passes to be issued by the Office of District Magistrate. Movement of persons from containment zones shall be strictly restricted and shall only be permitted on case to case basis upon approval from the Office of District Magistrate.

Port services will continue to operate as usual and both essential and nonessential cargo can be moved in and out of port, as per requirement for loading/ unloading/clearing of cargo and the same shall be permitted till 9 pm only. e-Passes for operation of cargo movement after 9 pm needs to be obtained, which shall be strictly permitted on case to case basis by the Office of the District Magistrate.

Shipping services for Shaheed Dweep and Swaraj Dweep shall be permitted with a carrying capacity of 70% of the vessel and with strict adherence to COVID protocols. Construction activities shall be permitted till 9 pm. Construction activities of national importance and strategic projects beyond 9 pm shall be permitted with prior permission of District Magistrate and e-Passes needs to be obtained, which shall be strictly permitted on case to case basis by the Office of the District Magistrate.

Movement of persons involved with Hotels/Restaurants and Mess for home delivery of food shall be allowed till 9 pm. Dine-in shall be permitted between 6 am to 9 pm only with 70% seating capacity and with strict adherence of COVID appropriate behaviours like wearing of mask, social distancing, cough etiquettes etc. Provision of thermal scanning and use of hand wash and sanitizers will be mandatory. However, take away/parcel service and home delivery should be encouraged. It shall be the sole responsibility of the owner/ In-Charge of the shop/business establishment to ensure its compliance and he/she shall be held responsible for any violation and shall be liable to be fined to the tune of Rs.50,000/- in addition to sealing of the shop/establishment for a period of 14 days by the Executive Magistrate and shall also be liable for

Public Transport/Buses shall be allowed to ply with 70% of the capacity following COVID protocols. Sale and service of liquor at licensed premises shall be permitted till 9 pm with 70% seating capacity and with strict adherence of COVID appropriate behaviours like wearing of mask, social distancing, cough etiquettes etc. Provision of thermal scanning and use of hand wash and sanitizers will be mandatory. SOPs and orders regarding the timings for sale and service of liquor at all licensed establishments (C, C1, B1, B2, B3 and B4 category) issued by the Deputy Commissioner (Excise), South Andaman should be strictly adhered to.

All Parks/ Playgrounds/ Stadiums/Gyms and yoga institutes shall be permitted till 9 pm with gathering not exceeding 70% of carrying capacity of the same and with strict adherence of COVID appropriate behaviours like wearing of mask, social distancing, cough etiquettes etc. Any person violating the above directions shall be liable for fine to the tune of Rs.1,000/-, whereas the organisation shall be fined to the tune of Rs.25,000/-.

All Religious places/places of worship are allowed to open till 9 pm with gathering not exceeding a maximum of 70% of the capacity of the hall and with strict adherence of COVID appropriate behaviours like wearing of mask, social distancing, cough etiquettes etc..Provision of thermal scanning and use of hand wash and sanitizers will be mandatory. The Management Committee of the religious places shall be responsible to ensure strict compliance of the COVID appropriate behaviours and any violations in this regard shall be liable for fine to the tune of Rs.25,000/- payable by the Committee. Religious places/places of worship in containment zones shall remain closed. Only those outside containment zones will be allowed to open up. No tribal passes will be issued for southern group of Islands till further orders except for official purposes/national importance and strategic projects.

Social gatherings shall be allowed with 70% capacity of the hall and prior permission of the District Magistrate with strict adherence of COVID appropriate behaviours like wearing of mask, social distancing, cough etiquettes etc. Provision of thermal scanning and use of hand wash and sanitizers will be mandatory. The parties concerned and management committee of the Hall/Hotel shall be responsible to ensure strict compliance of the COVID appropriate behaviours and any violations in this regard shall be liable for fine to the tune of Rs.50,000/-.

Theatres shall be permitted to function with 70% seating capacity and with strict adherence of COVID appropriate behaviours like wearing of mask, social distancing, cough etiquettes etc. Provision of thermal scanning and use of hand wash and sanitizers will be mandatory. The owner of the theatre shall be liable for fine to the tune of Rs.50,000/-, in case of any violations.

Academic congregations shall be allowed with 70% seating capacity and with strict adherence of COVID appropriate behaviours like wearing of mask, social distancing, cough etiquettes etc. Provision of thermal scanning and use of hand wash and sanitizers will be mandatory. The Owner/ Proprietor of the academic institutions/coaching centre shall be responsible to ensure strict compliance of the COVID appropriate behaviours and any Vaccination Centers and get themselves vaccinated. violations in this regard shall be liable for fine to the tune of Rs.50,000/-. Fresh SOPs in this regard shall be issued by the Education Department.

Indoor sports activities shall be allowed with 70% capacity and strict inaugurated the vaccination drive in JNRM today adherence of COVID appropriate behaviours like wearing of mask, social distancing, cough etiquettes etc. Provision of thermal scanning and use of hand wash and sanitizers will be mandatory. The management of the indoor facility shall be responsible to ensure strict compliance and any violations of the directions shall be liable for fine to the tune of Rs.25,000/-. SOPs in this regard shall be issued by concerned department.

e-pass for emergency movement during restricted timings may be submitted online on https://epass.andaman.gov.in. The applicants/ organizations submitting applications for e-pass should invariably submit valid and clear supporting documents, failing which the application will be summarily rejected.

In view of the emergent circumstances, this order is being issued exparte and is addressed to the public in general. This order shall be promulgated in the South Andaman District. Further, the Superintendent of Police/Sub-Divisional Magistrate/Executive Magistrates and all authorities concerned shall ensure strict compliance of this order and shall adequately inform and sensitize the field functionaries to note that these restrictions fundamentally relate to movement of people, but not to that of essential


