'Made in India' products are now reaching new markets in every corner of the world: PM

New Delhi, Mar. 27

Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi today exuded pride that India achieved the export target of 400 billion dollars. Addressing the people through his Mann Ki Baat programme on All India Radio, Shri Modi said Made in India products are now reaching new markets in every corner of the world. He pointed out that when Indians become Vocal for Local, the Local becomes Global. He asked people to make the local 'global' and augment the prestige of Indian products further.

The Prime Minister said, the demand for items made in India is increasing all over the world. He said it also signifies that the supply chain of India is getting stronger. He highlighted that the exports of leather products from Hailakandi in Assam, handloom products from Osmanabad, fruits and vegetables from Bijapur and black rice from Chandauli are increasing. The world-famous Apricot of Ladakh has reached the markets of Dubai and bananas are being



shipped from Tamil Nadu to Saudi Arabia. Prime Minister stated that Made in India products are now more visible than ever before in foreign countries.

Prime Minister stated that the potential of India in this field is great and farmers, artisans, weavers, engineers, small entrepreneurs, MSME sector, are the true strength. He added that it is only due to their hard work that the goal of exporting to the tune of 400 billion dollars has been achieved.

Prime Minister also said that small

entrepreneurs are playing a major role in Government procurement through Government e-Market place - GeM. He added that a much transparent system has been developed through technology. During the last one year through the GeM portal, the Government has purchased items worth more than one lakh crore rupees.

Close to 1.25 lakh small entrepreneurs, and small shopkeepers from every corner of the country have sold their goods directly to the Government. Prime Minister said, there was a time when only big companies could sell goods to the Government but that is changing now. He said even the smallest of shopkeepers can sell one's goods to the Government on the GeM Portal now. He said New India not only dreams big, but also shows the courage to reach that goal.

Prime Minister spoke of Padmashree awardee Baba Sivanand. He said everyone was surprised to see the agility of 126-year-

DRDO successfully flight tests Indian Army version of Medium Range Surface to Air Missile off Odisha coast



New Delhi, Mar. 27 (PIB)

Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO) conducted two successful flight tests of the Indian Army version of Medium Range Surface to Air Missile (MRSAM) at Integrated Test Range, Chandipur off the coast of Odisha today. The flight tests were carried out as part of

the live firing trials against high-speed aerial targets. The missiles intercepted the aerial targets and destroyed them completely, registering direct hits at both the ranges. The first launch was to intercept a medium altitude long range target and second launch was for proving the capability of a low altitude short range

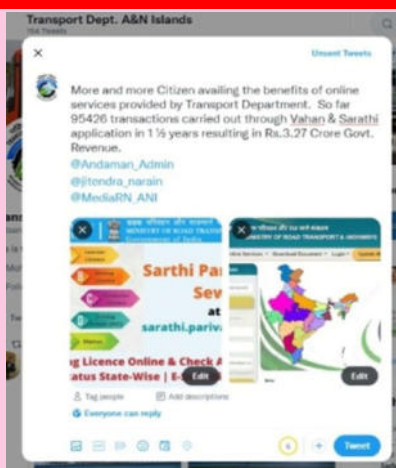
Generates revenue collection of Rs. 3.27 crores

To ensure better and transparent governance, A & N Administration has been taking many proactive steps. In this direction, VAHAN 4.0 and Sarathi 4.0 dedicated softwares for registration of Motor Vehicles and Driving Licenses respectively were implemented by Andaman and Nicobar Administration from 15/08/2020 and 20/05/2021 as a step towards ease of doing business. The intent was to minimize the visit of citizen to the Transport Offices and the same has started showing positive results.

After the implementation of 'VAHAN 4.0' application on August 15, 2020, the services like Road Tax Payment, Fancy Registration Number Reservation, Hypothecation related activities, Vehicle Fitness, Renewal of Registration, Alterations, New Registration of vehicle, Duplicate Copy of Certificates, NOC etc. have been made available to the citizen online.

So far, 86305 transactions have been done by the citizens online which has resulted in a revenue earning of



Rs.2,96,76,763/-. Similarly, Sarathi 4.0 implementation has also enabled the citizen to avail

online services like fee payment for Driving & Learner's License, Slot Booking as per the applicant's convenience, renewal of DL, Change of Address, Issue of Duplicate DL etc. Till date, 9121 transactions have been carried out by the citizens resulting in a revenue earning of Rs.30,03,550/-.

In the ICC Women's World Cup, South Africa defeated India by three wickets at the Hagley Oval. South Africa reached the target of 275 runs in the last ball of the last over in a nail-biting match. This was India's final group stage

match. South Africa has already secured a place in the semi-finals. Earlier, Shafali Verma, Smriti Mandhana and Skipper Mithali Raj struck half-centuries and set the platform for India to reach a competitive 274 for seven.

But South Africa fought back, supported by a 125-run second-wicket stand between Lara Goodall and Laura Woolvardt, which came in just 113 balls. Laura Woolvardt scored 80 runs and Mignon du Preez hit 52 runs for the winners.

This MRSAM version is a Surface-to-Air Missile developed jointly by DRDO and Israel Aerospace Industries (IAI), Israel for use by the Indian Army. The MRSAM Army weapon system comprises multi-function radar, mobile launcher system and other vehicles. The flight tests were carried out with the weapon system in deliverable configuration. The performance of the weapon system was validated through the flight data captured by range instruments like radars, electro-optical tracking systems and telemetry deployed by ITR, Chandipur. old Baba Sivanand at the Padma Awards. He said the age of 126 years and the fitness of Baba Sivanand are the subject of discussion in the country today. He said the life of Baba Sivanand is an inspiration for all people to follow a healthy lifestyle.

Shri Modi said that World Health Day will be celebrated on the 7th of April. He emphasised that the collective Indian thought on health, whether it is Yoga or Ayurveda, is increasingly trending all over the world. A Yoga programme was organised last week in Qatar where citizens of 114 countries participated and made a new world record. He said the market of the Ayush Industry is also increasing. Shri Modi said that six years ago, the market for Ayurveda medicines was around 22 thousand crores.

Today, the Ayush Manufacturing Industry is touching around one lakh forty thousand crore rupees. He added that in the Start-up world as well, AYUSH is becoming a subject of attraction.

Prime Minister mentioned a number of Ayush Start-Ups. He spoke about a start-up called Kapiva. This Start-Up is based on healthy eating habits in accordance with Indian traditions. Nirog-Street was another such Start Up mentioned by the Prime Minister which is a unique concept in the Ayurveda Healthcare Ecosystem. Its technology-driven platform connects Ayurveda Doctors from across the world directly to the people.

More than 50 thousand practitioners are associated with it. He also mentioned Atreya Innovations, a healthcare technology start-up, which is working in the field of Holistic Wellness. He said Ixoreal has spread awareness about the use of Ashwagandha and Cureveda has created dietary supplements for holistic life through the confluence of modern herbal research and traditional knowledge.

Prime Minister said such Start Ups are a symbol of the young entrepreneurs of India and the new possibilities being created in the country. He requested the Start-Ups of the Health Sector and especially the Ayush Start-Ups that they should try to make the content in their portal in all the languages recognized by the United Nations. He expressed confidence that Ayush Start-Ups from India with better quality products will reign all over the world.


