Port Blair, Feb. 8
Several specific orders were issued by the District Administration, South Andaman from time to time to ensure compliance of the C o n t a i n m e n t Measures for COVID-19. In exercise of the powers conferred under Section 24 (1) of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, the Chairperson, Union Territory Disaster Management Executive Committee for the Union Territory of Andaman and Nicobar Islands

has ordered to ensure compliance of C o n t a i n m e n t measures for COVID-19 as well as increased detection of the Variant of Concern (VoC), 'OMICRON' in different parts of this Union Territory as per the advisory issued by the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare (MoHFW) dated 21st December, 2021 for ensuring strict c o m p l i a n c e prescribing a normative framework for taking evidence based containment measures at District/

Local Level for the whole of Andaman and Nicobar Islands and shall remain in force till 28th February, 2022.
In order to ensure compliance to the containment measures of isolation and social distancing in the South Andaman District and with special emphasis on continued focus on the fivefold strategy, i.e. Test-Treat-Track-Vaccination and adherence to COVID a p p r o p r i a t e behaviours, i.e., wearing of face masks

and maintaining safe social distancing in all public areas/gatherings to control any surge of the cases of COVID-19-Variant of Concern (VoC), 'OMICRON' and also to prevent any disturbance to the peace and tranquillity and taking into consideration the request of the public representatives and general public, Shri Suneel Anchipaka, District Magistrate, South Andaman District, in exercise of the powers vested U/s 144 of Cr.P.C., has

ordered the following in supersession to Order Nos. 05 dt. 3rd January, 2022, No.30 dt. 10th January, 2022 and 111 dt. 3rd February, 2022:
Night curfew enforced in the entire District of South Andaman is hereby withdrawn with immediate effect with no restrictions on movement of men and materials.
Social/Political/Sports/Entertainment/Academic/Cultural/Religious/ Festivals related and other gathering and

congregations shall be permitted with strict adherence to COVID A p p r o p r i a t e Behaviours like wearing of mask, social distancing, cough etiquettes etc. Provision of thermal scanning and use of hand wash and sanitizers will be mandatory. As part of the ensuing Panchayat & Municipal Elections - 2022, the Office of the Director (Panchayat and Municipal Elections) today organised a training programme for the Sector Officers & Model Code of Conduct (MCC) teams at the DBRAIT auditorium.
Addressing the trainees, the DPME, Shri Suneel Anchipaka reiterated that the Sector

Officers play a vital role in the management of elections and is responsible for multifarious aspects of election management from the day of their appointment till the completion of the poll process. He asked all the Sector Officers and the MCC teams to attend the briefing classes to acquaint themselves fully with the election procedures contained in the Election Rules so that the election is

conducted in a free, fair and transparent manner. He further stated that Sector officers as sector magistrates have to check the enforcement of MCC strictly which is already in place soon after the declaration of Elections. The Govt. of India has inter alia requested individual beneficiaries under NFSA to furnish proof of Aadhaar number or undergo A a d h a a r authentication to receive subsidies under NFSA. The Department of Civil Supplies & Consumer Affairs has been repeatedly informing and requesting the ration card holders through press releases and fair price shop

dealers from time to time to get their Aadhaar number seeded with the ration card data base. Many ration card beneficiaries have still not got their Aadhaar number seeded with the ration cards. Hence, it is once again requested to all the NFSA (PHH & AAY) card holders to get their and their family member's Aadhaar seeded in the ration card database through the respective Circle

Office of Civil Supplies & Consumer Affairs Department and its subordinate supply units in Inter-Islands by 31st March, 2022. All the beneficiaries have been informed that with implementation of 'One Nation One Ration Card' in this UT, no ration card holder will be able to draw their PDS items in absence of Aadhaar authentication in ration card database.

Vaccination drive in A&N Islands 99.53 % children in the age group of 15-18 inoculated with 1st dose of vaccine so far

Port Blair, Feb. 8

COVID-19 vaccination for children between 15-18 years of age which began in these Islands from Jan. 3 is continuing smoothly. With the concerted effort taken by the A&N Administration and the Health Department, so far, 22,893 doses of Covaxin have been administered to children between 15-18 years of age, out of the 23,000 approx eligible beneficiaries under this age group. To cover maximum number of eligible beneficiaries, the Health teams are administering

Covaxin to the Feb. 8, 2022.

Precautionary doses of vaccines have been administered to 7102 beneficiaries. As per data available, a total of 6,05,553 beneficiaries in the age group of 18 and above have been vaccinated so far in A&N Islands, a press release from DHS said.

behaviours and any violations in this regard shall be liable for fine to the tune of Rs.25,000/-.

All religious places/places of worship shall be permitted for public worship with strict adherence to COVID Appropriate Behaviours like wearing of mask, social distancing, cough etiquettes etc. Provision of thermal scanning and use of hand wash and sanitizers will be mandatory. The Management Committee of the religious places shall be responsible to ensure strict compliance to the COVID Appropriate Behaviours and any violations in this regard shall be liable for fine to the tune of Rs.25,000/- payable by the Committee.

All Tourists spots in South Andaman District is permitted to open for tourism activities with immediate effect and strict adherence to COVID Appropriate Behaviours like wearing of mask, social distancing, cough etiquettes etc. Provision of thermal scanning and use of hand wash and sanitizers will be mandatory. Any violations of the above by the operators of the tourism activities shall be liable for fine to the tune of Rs.20,000/-.

All Parks/ Playgrounds/ Stadiums/Gyms and yoga institutes shall be permitted with strict adherence to COVID Appropriate Behaviours like wearing of mask, social distancing, cough etiquettes etc. Any person violating the above directions shall be liable for fine to the tune of Rs.1,000/-, whereas the organisation shall be fined to the tune of Rs.25,000/-.

Academic congregations shall be allowed with strict adherence to COVID Appropriate Behaviours like wearing of mask, social distancing, cough etiquettes etc. Provision of thermal scanning and use of hand wash and sanitizers will be mandatory. The Owner/ Proprietor of the Academic Institutions/Coaching Centre shall be responsible to ensure strict compliance of the COVID appropriate behaviours and any violations in this regard shall be liable for fine to the tune of Rs.25,000/-.

Indoor/Outdoor Sports activities shall be allowed with strict adherence to COVID Appropriate Behaviours like wearing of mask, social distancing, cough etiquettes etc. Provision of thermal scanning and use of hand wash and sanitizers will be mandatory. The management of the indoor facility shall be responsible to ensure strict compliance and any violations of the directions shall be liable for fine to the tune of Rs.25,000/-.

Theatres shall be permitted to function with strict adherence to COVID Appropriate Behaviours like wearing of mask, social distancing, cough etiquettes etc. Provision of thermal scanning and use of hand wash and sanitizers will be mandatory. The owner of the theatre shall be liable for fine to the tune of Rs.25,000/- in case of any violations.

In view of the emergent circumstances, this order is being issued ex-parte and is addressed to the public in general. Further, the Superintendent of Police/Sub-Divisional Magistrate/Executive Magistrates and all authorities concerned shall ensure strict compliance of this order and shall adequately inform and sensitize the field functionaries to note that these restrictions fundamentally relate to movement of people, but not to that of essential services.

Any disobedience of the above orders shall invite penal action u/s 188 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and the relevant provisions of the Disaster Management Act, 2005 against the violator(s) and fine shall also be imposed as per orders issued by this office from time to time.

This order has come into immediate effect and shall remain in force till further orders.

Meanwhile, the District Magistrate, N&M Andaman District, Smti Anjali Sehrawat in an order issued today has also withdrawn the imposition of night curfew in the district. Similarly, public transport and buses have been allowed to ply with 75% capacity. Sale and service of liquor at licenced premises permitted as per timings approved for respective licences, closure of all parks/playgrounds/stadiums/gyms/ yoga institute, religious places, all tourist spots stands withdrawn.

Prohibition of Social/ Political/ Sports/ Entertainment/ Academic/ Religious/ Festival related gathering and congregation has also been withdrawn.

The above relaxations are conditional to the strict adherence of COVID appropriate behaviour including wearing of mask, maintaining social distance, cough etiquettes, provision for thermal scanning, handwash and sanitizers.

Any non-adherence to COVID Appropriate Behaviour shall be liable to a fine up to Rs. 25000/- in case of management committees of concerned gatherings/religious places, tour operators, sports organisers and up to Rs.1000/- (Rupees one thousand only) for individual violators.

In view of the emergent circumstances, this order is being issued ex-parte and is addressed to the public in general. Any disobedience of the above orders shall invite penal action u/s 188 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and the relevant provisions of the Disaster Management Act, 2005 against the violator) and fine shall also be imposed as per order issued from time to time.

This order has come into force with effect from 8th February, 2022 and shall remain in force till further orders.

supervisory police officers and report any situation of law and order to the District Magistrate. They should be present at the time of distribution and should be in constant touch with the Returning Officers and keep extra polling materials within vehicle on the day of poll.

They should report when all polling parties along with polling materials reach their polling stations under their jurisdiction. The responsibility of the Sector Officer is enormous on the day of Poll, they have to assist the Presiding Officers in the Polling Stations so that the voting starts in time and continues without any hiccups, intimate commencement of poll and submit two hourly report promptly including the close of poll.

They have to also escort and transport the polled boxes and polling materials to the collection centres. Further the Sector Officers should be present at the collection centre after end of poll to ensure all the Presiding/Polling Officers have deposited polled materials in the Collection Centre.

On the day of counting, they should ensure that the polled materials are shifted to the counting centre under proper security well in time before commencement of counting and also keep a close watch on law and order situation after declaration of results.

The DPME also asked the Sector Officers of North & Middle Andaman to take the training seriously and acquaint themselves with the procedures so that they can train fellow election officials of their respective areas without any difficulty. The DPME also directed the MCC teams to be strict on the violators of Model Code of Conduct.

Earlier, the Nodal Officer, Training & Vehicle, Dr. Aom Dhole welcomed the DPME and the trainees present.

Shri Som Naidu (Retd) as the resource person briefed about the roles and responsibilities of Sector Officers pertaining to conduct of elections in the UTs.

The Sector Officers & MCC teams from South Andaman, North and Middle Andaman District attended the training at DBRAIT while the Sector Officers of Campbell Bay joined the training through Google Meet.

Meanwhile, a training programme for the Model Code of Conduct (MCC) teams comprising civil and police officers was also held in the conference room of the DBRAIT today. The Nodal Officer, MCC, Shri Dilkhush Meena enlightened the MCC team about their roles & responsibilities during the election. The Nodal Officer, Media, Shri Alok Kumar enlightened the trainees about video surveillance to check the expense of campaigning and to prepare a report about violations, if any.

The Director, Panchayat & Municipal Elections sought the cooperation and active involvement of all officials involved in the election process in conduct of a smooth, free and fair elections in the Islands.
