The 78th anniversary of the hoisting of the National Tri-colour for the first time on the Indian Soil by Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose was celebrated today. It was on this day i.e December 30, 1943, Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose had hoisted the national tri-colour Flag for the first time at Port Blair, declaring the Islands, the first Indian Territory freed from

the British rule.
