The welfare schemes devised by the Central Government aim at uplifting the socio-economic status of the last mile beneficiary by bringing them under the fold of such welfare & social security schemes, said the Hon'ble Minister of State for Information & Broadcasting and Fisheries, Animal Husbandry & Dairying, GoI, Dr. L. Murugan while interacting with the media persons at a press conference held at



hotel Coral Cove near Minnie Bay this evening.

Addressing the scribes, the Minister mentioned some of the schemes viz. PM Awas Yojana, Ujala Yojana, SVANidhi Yojana, Jan Dhan Yojana, Suraksha Beema Yojana, Garib Kalyan Yojana etc. and pointed that these schemes have

been devised to improve the living conditions and uplift the economic condition of the common man.

The Minister stated that under the Jan Dhan Yojana, the benefits are directly transferred to the accounts of the beneficiaries. COVID-19 vaccine Amrit Mahotsav 1025 beneficiaries above 18 years administered precautionary dose on first day

Port Blair, July 15

As part of the COVID-19 vaccine Amrit Mahotsav, the Health Department, under the overall supervision of the Chief Secretary, A&N Administration, is undertaking inoculation of free Precaution dose of COVID-19 vaccine to all the eligible beneficiaries above 18 years of age in the Islands.

On the first day of the campaign today, a total of 1025 beneficiaries were administered precautionary dose apart from regular 1st and 2nd COVID-19 vaccine doses.

Those beneficiaries who are above 18 years of age and have completed 26 weeks or 182 days after administering the second dose can get the

precautionary dose. The Health Department has appealed to all the eligible beneficiaries to get themselves vaccinated with a precautionary dose and further encourage their near and dear ones to get the same through various social media platforms, as the campaign will last for 75 days, a press release from DHS said.

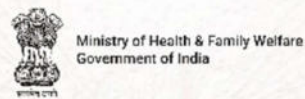

Vaccination drive in A&N Islands
24,743 beneficiaries in the age group of 12 to 14
years administered both doses of vaccine

Port Blair, July 15

The vaccination drive is continuing smoothly in A&N Islands. As per data available, a total of 6,84,328 doses of vaccine have been administered to beneficiaries in the age group of 18 and above so far. Similarly, 23,596 beneficiaries have been vaccinated in the age group of 15 to 18 years. 24,743 beneficiaries in the age group of 12 to 14 years have been administered both doses of vaccine. The number of

beneficiaries administered precautionary dose of vaccine so far stood at 29436.

A total of 1097 eligible beneficiaries were vaccinated in A&N Islands today. 978 beneficiaries were vaccinated in South Andaman District, out of which, 9 beneficiaries were in the age group of 12-14 years, 1 beneficiary was in the age group of 18-44 years and the number of beneficiaries administered precautionary dose of vaccine stood at 1, a press release from DHS said.
