During the RT-PCR test conducted on 473 passengers who arrived here yesterday, two positive cases have been detected. Every shop dealing with electronic goods can become a collection point for E-Waste items. All Shops may have a dedicated bin for collecting E-Waste. Further, this E-Waste may be sold by the shop owner to authorize vendor thereby earning profit. It was also communicated that failure to abide by E-Waste Rules 2016 may result in heavy penalties for the violators.

The workshop witnessed enthusiastic participation from the shop owners. Further, acting on the suggestion of the shop owners, the Joint Secretary directed concerned for creation of a social media group for the purpose of E-Waste. 




