## First 'Justice J.S. Verma Memorial Lecture' held Vice President asks media to be extra careful while reporting about judiciary

New Delhi, Sept.18 (PIB)

The Vice President, Shri Jagdeep Dhankhar today asked the media to be extra careful while reporting about the judiciary. He also said that dignity of judges and respect for judiciary is inviolable as these are fundamentals of rule of law and constitutionalism. Speaking as the Chief Guest at the first 'Justice J.S. Verma Memorial Lecture' at Jabalpur, Madhya Pradesh today, the Vice President said



that a spinally strong, nurtured when all fair and independent constitutional institutions are wholly Justice System is the safest guarantee to blossom and flourish in their respective domain," he added. The first 'Justice J.S. Verma Memorial Lecture' was delivered

by the Supreme Court Judge, Justice Sanjay Kishan Kaul to the august gathering. Recalling his many interactions as senior advocate with Justice Verma at Rajasthan High Court and Supreme Court, Shri Dhankhar said that his tenure was marked with judicial ecosystem upliftment, enhancing the transparency and accountability.

Praising Justice Verma for delivering many judgments with far reaching impact on society, the Vice

President said that his landmark judgment in Vishaka case structured the mechanism for adequately providing for specific protection of women from sexual harassment in work places. "Late Justice Jagdish Sharan Verma will always be best remembered for path-breaking judgments and ideas that have empowered citizens and enabled the Government to overhaul institutions for the larger welfare of the people," he added.

## Over 1 lakh people donate blood under 'Raktdaan Amrit Mahotsav' in the Country

New Delhi, Sept. 18

Over one lakh seven thousand people voluntarily donated blood under Raktdaan Amrit Mahotsav. The fifteen-day-long countrywide mega voluntary blood donation drive was kick started by Union Health Minister, Dr. Mansukh Mandaviya yesterday, on the occasion of 72<sup>nd</sup> birthday of Prime

Minister, Shri Narendra Modi. More than six thousand camps have been registered for this mega drive along with more than two lakh fourteen thousand blood donors registered so far on E-Rakt Kosh portal. Dr Mandaviya said, a new world record was created on the very first day with 87 thousand 137 people voluntarily donating in a single day.

The campaign is aimed at increasing awareness regarding regular non-remunerated voluntary blood donations and ensure that blood or its components are available, accessible, affordable and safe. As per 2021 statistics, India's annual requirement is around 1.5 crore units. (Source: india.gov.in)

## Making the impossible possible Andamanese tribal girl shares her success story in cracking NEET (UG) 2022 Follow your dream and never lose hope, work hard & keep the determination alive: Ms Techa

Port Blair, Sept. 18

As Nelson Mandela puts it "It always seems impossible until its done" and this has been proved right by a young tribal girl, Ms Techa, D/o Look and Late Kobo hailing from the Andamanese Tribe of Strait Island. Ms Techa's achievement of clearing the only medical entrance exam- National Eligibility Cum Entrance Examination-NEET (UG) 2022 conducted in India, has sent ripples of happiness and pride not only among her tribe but the entire Islands rejoicing at the success of this young girl. Techa's success serves as a shining example of grit and determination. In an interview with DT recently, Ms Techa shared insight into her life and her achievement. Here is the tete-a-tete with the aspiring doctor, whose achievement will inspire many along the way. "My dream is to become a cardiologist", said Techa while sharing her future aspirations with



team DT. Beaming with joy, Techa said when she completes her studies, she would like to go back and serve her people. "I understand my people better than anyone else would, hence, I would like to dedicate my service to them and serve them after the

completion of my studies."

The aspiring cardiologist revealed that it was her childhood dream to become a doctor and her brother Olek, a diploma in Civil Engineering by qualification, currently working for AAJVS has been her biggest inspiration. "My brother has always been supportive and looking at his confidence and achievements, I am more inspired to do the impossible". "Initially, I thought I wouldn't make it through, but the encouragement of my family, friends and well-wishers backed by the A&N Administration's support made me turn the impossible to possible", said Techa adding that Seva Niketen and Vanvasi Kalyan Ashram has also been very supportive towards her.

When asked what was her strategy while preparing for NEET, Techa said, the outbreak of COVID pandemic has almost quashed her

She was provided financial support by the Administration for coaching at an institute in Port Blair for her NEET preparation.

Upon learning about her success in cracking the NEET 2022, Techa said her folks back at Strait Island rejoiced and they congratulated her. Techa has not forgotten those who helped her in realizing her dream of pursuing MBBS. She expressed her gratitude to the Administration for the fervent support extended to her as well as other students from the Andamanese Tribe pursuing their education at Port Blair.

"Administration has always been there for me, be it getting admitted to schools, coaching, counselling and other requirements while institutions like AAJVS, Model Career Centre and the schools I studied (VKZPV, Port Mout, Class 1 to 5, VKV, Ranchi Tekri, class 6 to 10 and Govt. Girls SSS, Class 11 & 12, the faculty and my teachers have always supported me". They have given me the courage to dream and make it come true and for which I will always remain grateful, said Techa.

In her message to NEET aspirants, Techa reminds them to follow their dream and never lose hope but to work hard and keep the determination alive.

Techa also disclosed that she loves reading mysteries and science related books apart from listening to music. She also has a flair for sports. "I use to play kabaddi, badminton and kho kho when I was in school".

Techa's success in cracking NEET and her dream of becoming a doctor would prove to be a milestone achievement for the Andamanese tribe which in turn will provide them a doctor of their own and help in better health care delivery at the comfort of their home. During the interaction, Techa's brother Olek revealed that apart from fishing and hunting, they have also started kitchen gardening at Strait Island which is quite popular among the tribe now and they look forward to taking up more self-sufficiency activities along the way.
