

47th GST Council Meeting concludes All rate changes recommended by the Council to be made effective from July 18

New Delhi, June 29

The 47th GST Council Meeting under the Chairmanship of Union Minister for Finance & Corporate Affairs, Smti. Nirmala Sitharaman in Chandigarh ended today. The meeting was attended by the Union Minister of State for Finance, Shri Pankaj Choudhary besides Finance Ministers of States and UTs and senior officers of the Ministry of Finance & States, UTs.

The Finance Minister spoke about rate rationalisation, the GST compensation to States, corrections of invested duties, and virtual digital assets. She said, the Council directed that the



Group of Ministers on Casino, Race Course and Online Gaming re-examine the issues in its terms of reference based on further inputs from States and submit its report within a short duration.

In the meeting, the GST on LED lamps, lights and fixtures, and their metal printed circuits board is raised from 12 per

cent to 18 per cent. In the case of the Solar Water Heater System GST was raised from 5 to 12 per cent whereas in the Works contract for roads, bridges, railways, metro, effluent treatment plant, crematoriums, etc. the tax was raised by 12 to 18 percent.

The tax also hiked in Works contract supplied to Central

and State Governments, local authorities for historical monuments, canals, dams, pipelines, plants for water supply, educational institutions, hospitals, etc. & sub-contractor from 12 to 18 percent. Electric vehicles whether or not fitted with a battery pack, are eligible for the

concessional GST rate of 5 per cent.

GST rate on Tetra Packaging has been raised from 12 to 18 percent. Cut and Polished diamonds are up from 0.25 per cent to 1.5 percent. All rate changes recommended by the 47th GST Council will be made effective from 18th July, 2022. (Source: india.gov.in)

Vice Presidential election to be held on August 6 : ECI

The Vice Presidential election will be held on the 6th of August. In a statement, the Election Commission of India (ECI) said, notification for the election will be issued on 5th July and nominations can be filed till 19th of

next month.

The scrutiny of the nominations will be done on 20th July. The Commission said, the Electoral College for the Vice Presidential Election consists of 233 elected members of Rajya Sabha, 12 nominated members of Rajya Sabha and

543 elected members of Lok Sabha. The Secretary-General of Lok Sabha will be the Returning Officer for the Election. The term of Vice President, Shri M Venkaiah Naidu is ending on 10th August. (Source: india.gov.in)

High speed Expendable Aerial Target - ABHYAS - successfully flight-tested off Odisha coast

Chandipur, June 29 (PIB)

ABHYAS - High speed Expendable Aerial Target (HEAT) was successfully flight-tested from the Integrated Test Range (ITR), Chandipur off the coast of Odisha today.

The performance of the aircraft at low altitude including sustained level and high manoeuvrability was demonstrated during the test flight. The target aircraft was flown from a ground based controller in a pre-designated low altitude flight path, which was monitored by various tracking sensors deployed by ITR, including radar and electro-optical targeting system.

ABHYAS is designed & developed by



Aeronautical Development Establishment of Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO). The air vehicle was launched using twin under-slung boosters which provide the initial acceleration to the vehicle. It is powered by a small gas turbine engine to sustain a long endurance flight at high subsonic speed. The target aircraft is equipped with Micro-Electromechanical Systems-based Inertial Navigation System for navigation along with the Flight Control Computer for guidance and control along with Indigenous Radio Altimeter for very low altitude flight and Data Link for encrypted communication between the Ground Control Station and Target Aircraft. The vehicle is programmed for fully autonomous flight.

Tokyo Olympian Deepak Punia won a bronze medal after defeating Maksat Satybaldy in the 86kg freestyle weight category at the U-23 Asian Wrestling Championships 2022 in Bishkek, Kyrgyzstan. Despite a win, it was an

unimpressive result of Uzbekistan and Nurtilek Karypbaev of Kyrgyzstan. However, he was expecting a better outing from the world championships silver medallist in the tournament. In the opening two rounds, India won 25 medals in all in the U-23 meet in the event, including 10 gold medals.

Malaysia Open Badminton: P. V. Sindhu and P Kashyap advance to pre-quarter finals in singles category

Kuala Lumpur, June 29

In Badminton, Olympic medallist P. V. Sindhu advanced to the pre-quarter finals of Malaysia Open in Kuala Lumpur today. She beat Thailand's Pornpawee Chochuwong 21-13, 21-17 to enter into the second round. Parupalli Kashyap also progressed to the 2nd round in the men's singles. He won his opening round match



against South Korea's Heo Kwang Hee 21-12, 21-17.

However, Olympic Bronze medallist Saina Nehwal lost to American Iris Wang 11-21, 17-21 in the first round. B. Sumeeth Reddy and Ashwini Ponnappa were also humbled by the duo of Robin Tabeling and Selena Piek of the Netherlands. The Indian pair lost 15-21, 21-19, 17-21.

Under SEP component of the scheme, financial assistance with interest subvention is provided to individuals/groups and Self Help Groups (SHGs) including street vendors/hawkers for setting up gainful self-employment ventures/micro enterprises, suited to their skill training, aptitude and local conditions.

Under this scheme, a loan amount of up to Rs.2 lakhs for an individual and up to Rs.10 lakhs for SHGs can be availed. The interest subvention under the scheme is approx. 5%. Women and SHGs are entitled for further interest subvention of 3% who repay their loan in time, a press release from PBMC said.

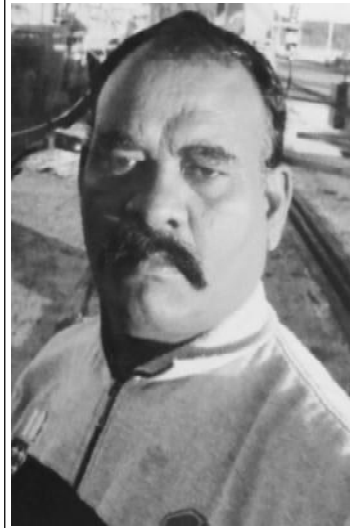

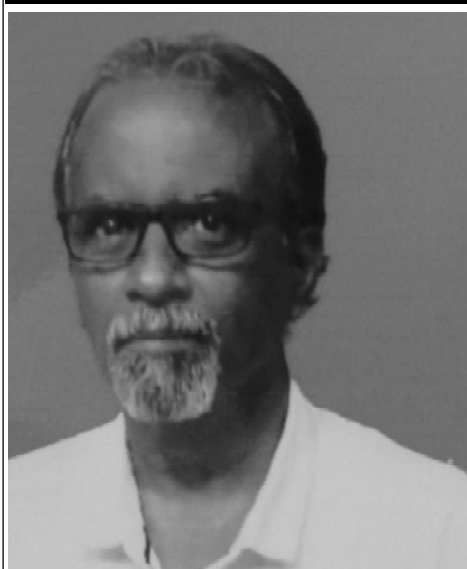

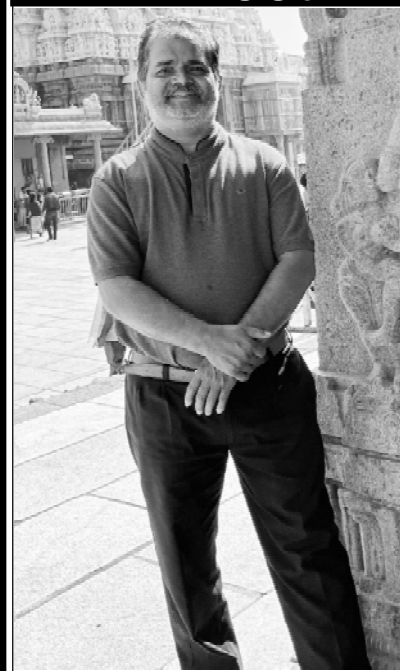
