## MP introduces Private Member's Bill in Lok Sabha Bill to mandate compulsory sports, physical education and infrastructure in schools of isles

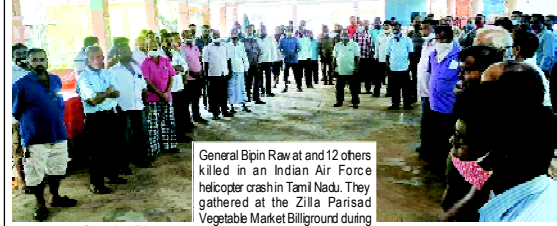

## Over 131.18 crore doses of COVID vaccine administered in the country

Over 131 crore 18 lakh doses of COVID vaccine have been administered in the country so far under the Nationwide Vaccination Drive. Union Health Ministry said, more than 74 lakh 57 thousand vaccine doses were administered in the last 24 hours. The Ministry said, seven thousand 678 COVID patients recovered during the last 24 hours and the national recovery rate stands at 98.36 percent. Till now, more than three crore 41 lakh people have recovered from COVID-19. The country reported eight thousand 503 new Covid cases in the last 24 hours. Currently, India's active case load is around 94 thousand. Presently the active cases constitute 0.27 percent of the country's total Positive Cases, which is the lowest since March last year. The Ministry said, the testing capacity across the country continues to be expanded and more than 65 crore 32 lakh COVID-19 tests have been conducted so far.

### Flyover collapse

A huge chunk of the flyover under construction near Sewa Nagar for the Asian Games in Delhi crashed, injuring at least 17 labourers. Four have been admitted to the All India Institute of Medical Sciences. The rest were given first-aid and discharged. This is the second incident in an Asian Games project site in two days. A labourer was killed on December 7 when a mound of earth fell on him. The workers were too dazed to give a coherent account of what happened to them. The fire brigade and other rescue officials took time to reach the spot. In the meantime, the residents pulled the injured workers from the debris.

Desai Shekhar rift  
Sharp differences between Morarji Desai and Chandra Shekhar over Opposition unity may force a confrontation at the Janata Party's national council meeting. Chandra Shekhar is determined to move a resolution at the meeting on Opposition unity. Desai has been a strong opponent of the merger of the Janata Party's erstwhile components. ## COVID-19 Vaccination going smoothly in isles

Port Blair, Dec 10: The vaccination drive is continuing smoothly in A&N Islands. As per data available, a total of 5,69,759 beneficiaries have been vaccinated so far in A&N Islands, out of the target beneficiaries of 2,81,603 (approx.). A total of 1,76,572 eligible people in the age group of 18 to 44 years have been vaccinated till date. A total of 1175 people were vaccinated in these islands on Thursday. 984 beneficiaries were vaccinated in South Andaman District, out of which 65 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44 years. Similarly, 171 beneficiaries were vaccinated in North & Middle Andaman District out of which 8 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44. 20 beneficiaries were vaccinated in Nicobar District.

## BETI BACHAO, BETI PADHAO | 80% OF FUNDS SPENT ON MEDIA CAMPAIGNS, SAYS PARLIAMENTARY COMMITTEE

The Parliamentary Committee on Empowerment of Women says, "Now, it is time to focus on other verticals to help achieve measurable outcomes related to education and health."

The government spent a whopping 80% of funds under its flagship Beti Bachao, Beti Padhao (BBBP) scheme on media campaigns and must now revisit this strategy and invest in measurable outcomes in health and education for girls, noted the Parliamentary Committee on Empowerment of Women in its report tabled in Lok Sabha.

"The Committee finds that out of a total of ₹446.72 crore released during the period 2016-2019, a whopping 78.91% was spent only on media advocacy," said the report. It adds, "over the last six years, through focussed advocacy BBBP has been able to capture the attention of political leadership and national consciousness towards valuing the girl child. Now, it is time to focus on other verticals by making ample financial provisions to help achieve measurable outcomes related to education and health envisaged under the scheme."

The Committee is chaired by Heena Vijay Kumar Gavit and the report is titled "Empowerment of Women through education with special reference

to Beti Bachao Beti Padhao'. It was tabled in Lok Sabha on Thursday. The Beti Bachao scheme was launched by Prime Minister Narendra Modi in January 2015 with the aim to address

sex selective abortion and the declining child sex ratio which was at 918 girls for every 1,000 boys in 2011. The programme is being implemented across 405 districts in the country.

The total utilisation under the scheme was also poor — the Committee found that since the inception of BBBP in 2014-15 till 2019-20, the total Budgetary allocation under the scheme

was ₹848 crore, excluding the COVID-sticken financial year of 2020-21. During this period, an amount of ₹622.48 crore was released to the States but only 25.13% of the funds, i.e. ₹156.46 crore, have been spent by the States and Union Territories. According to the implementation guidelines of the scheme on the website of the Ministry of Women and Child Development, there are two key components of BBBP. These include advocacy and media campaign — radio spots or jingles in Hindi and regional languages, television publicity, outdoor and print media, community engagement through mobile exhibition vans, SMS campaigns, brochures, etc. and multi-sectoral intervention in selected gender critical districts that perform poorly with respect to child sex ratio. The Committee noted that the massive spend on advertisements was despite the clearly laid down formula for utilisation of funds — ₹50 lakh per year earmarked for a district for utilisation under six different components. Of this, 16% of funds are for inter-sectoral consultation or capacity building, 50% for innovation or awareness generation activities, 6% for monitoring and evaluation, 10% for sectoral interventions in health, 10% for sectoral interventions in education and 8% as flexi funds.



## 25 Omicron cases detected in India so far, symptoms mostly mild: Govt

The government, on Friday, said 25 cases of the Omicron variant of the coronavirus have been detected in India so far and that mostly mild symptoms have been observed in all the cases.

Clinically, Omicron is not posing burden on the healthcare system yet, but the vigil has to be maintained, according to the Indian Council of Medical Research (ICMR).

At a joint press briefing on the pandemic, the government said 25 cases of the Omicron variant have been reported in India — 10 in

Maharashtra, nine in Rajasthan, three in Gujarat, two in Karnataka, and one in Delhi.

"Mainly mild symptoms have been seen in the cases of Omicron variant detected so far," health ministry secretary Lav Agarwal said.

According to the government, the WHO has highlighted that compliance to public health and social measures is declining globally with the increase in vaccination rates.

Another official said the government has not received any

recommendation from the National Technical Advisory Group on Immunisation (NTAGI) on the pediatric vaccination against COVID-19 yet.

The government said 86.2 per cent of the country's adult population received the first dose of COVID-19 vaccine, while 53.5 per cent has been administered both doses.

It said the weekly positivity rate in 19 districts was between five and 10 per cent and it was over 10 per cent in eight districts of three states.

India's coronavirus tally climbed to 3,46,74,744 with the addition of 8,503 infections in a day, while the number of active cases rose to 94,943, according to the Union Health Ministry data updated on Friday.

The death toll mounted to 4,74,735 with the addition of 624 new fatalities, according to the data updated at 8 a.m. The daily rise in new coronavirus infections has been recorded below 15,000 for the last 43 days now.



## Nicaragua becomes latest country to ditch Taiwan, re-establish ties with China

Taiwan's ministry of foreign affairs confirmed on Friday morning that Nicaragua had broken off ties with the island.

The Nicaraguan government, under President Daniel Ortega, had issued a statement on Thursday evening that affirmed, "... in the world there is only one China. The People's Republic of China is the only legitimate government that represents all China, and Taiwan

is an inalienable part of the Chinese territory. As of today, Nicaragua breaks its diplomatic relations with Taiwan and ceases to have any official contact or relationship." Associated Press reported.

The development means now only 14 countries, mostly in the Caribbean and Central America, recognise Taiwan. Taiwan's ministry of foreign affairs expressed "sadness and regret"

over the move and announced it was recalling its diplomats.

Reuters reported that Ortega may have switched recognition as US sanctions had necessitated the need to consider China as a source of aid and support.

Xiomara Castro, incoming president of the Honduras, had declared she would switch recognition to China when she was campaigning. However, recently her aides have backedtracked on the claim.

## 37% of trains in India being hauled by diesel locomotives, rest by electric engines



A daily average of 13,555 trains are operating in India currently, and 37% of these are being hauled by diesel locomotives, Railway Minister Ashwini Vaishnaw said on Friday.

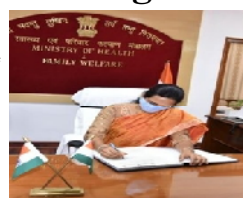
The remaining 63% are hauled by electric engines, he stated in a written response to a

question in Rajya Sabha. As per annual statistical statements for the year 2019-20, total diesel and electricity consumed for running trains were 2,370.55 million litres and 13,854.73 million KWH respectively, which work out to 6.49 million litres per day of diesel

and 37.96 million KWH per day of electricity, he mentioned. "On an average, 13,555 trains/day (both freight and passenger) are running over Indian Railways, out of which about 63 pc & 37 pc of trains are operated/hauled by electric and diesel locomotives, respectively," he noted.

## Govt approves establishment of 157 new medical colleges

The Central Government has approved establishment of 157 new medical colleges in three phases. Out of these, 70 medical colleges have become functional till date. In a written reply in the Lok Sabha on Friday, Union Minister of State for Health and Family Welfare Dr. Bharti Pawar said, the ministry administers a Central Sponsored Scheme for establishment of new Medical Colleges attached with existing district and referral hospitals with preference to underserved areas and aspirational districts, where there is no existing Government or private medical college. He said, this step will help to improve the health care delivery system in these areas.



## 'It's ok to be mediocre': Group Cpt. Varun Singh in letter to students of his school

Group Captain Singh was conferred with the Shaurya Chakra for displaying exemplary composure and skill when his Tejas aircraft developed the technical snag during a sortie last year.

"It's ok to be mediocre," this is what Group Captain Varun Singh, the lone survivor of the IAF chopper crash, had conveyed to the students of his school in a letter to his principal in September.

He was conferred with the Shaurya Chakra in August for averting a possible mid-air accident after his Tejas light combat aircraft suffered a major technical glitch last year.

"It is ok to be mediocre. Not everyone will excel at school and not everyone will be able to score in the 90s. If you do, it's an amazing achievement and must be applauded," Group Captain Singh wrote in the letter to the principal of the Army Public School in Chandimandir in Haryana.

"However, if you don't, don't think that you are meant to be mediocre. You may be mediocre in school but it is by no means a measure of things to come in life," he said.

"Find your calling, it could be art, music, graphic design, literature etc. Whatever you work towards,

be dedicated, do your best. Never go to bed thinking I could have put in more effort," he added.

The air warrior said he was an average student and barely scored first division in 12th standard, but had a passion for airplanes and aviation. "I write to you filled with a sense of pride and humility. On August 15 this year, I have been awarded Shaurya Chakra by the President of India in recognition of an act of gallantry on October 12, 2020," he said.

"I credit this prestigious award to all those I have been associated with over the years in school, NDA and thereafter the Air Force, as

firmly believe that my actions that day were a result of the grooming and mentoring by my teachers. Instructors and peers over the years," Group Captain Singh wrote in the letter dated September 18.

The Group Captain said he was not trying to blow his own trumpet or writing with a desire to seek a pat on the back, and that he wanted to let the children know a few of his life's experiences that may help them in future.

"I was a very average student who barely scored first division in 12 class. Even though I was made the Discipline Prefect in 12th I was equally average even in sports and

other co-curricular activities. But I had a passion for airplanes and aviation," he wrote.

Group Captain Singh was conferred with the Shaurya Chakra for displaying exemplary composure and skill when his Tejas aircraft developed the technical snag during a sortie last year.

"Despite being in extreme physical and mental stress in an extreme life-threatening situation, he maintained exemplary composure and recovered the aircraft, thereby exhibiting exceptional flying skills," the award citation said.

## RBI grants approval to LIC to up stake in IndusInd Bank to nearly 10%

Private bank IndusInd Bank on Friday said the RBI has given approval to Life Insurance Corporation to increase its stake in the bank to nearly 10 per cent.

The bank has received an intimation from

the direction on 'Prior Approval for Acquisition of Shares and Voting Private Sector Banks' as well as regulations of the SEBI and any guidelines or regulations.

The RBI last month had accepted most of the recommendations of its



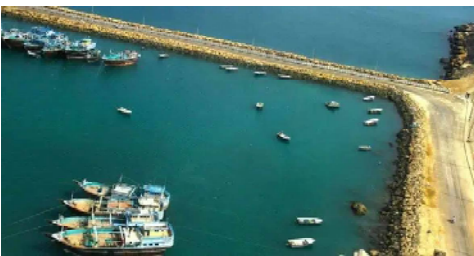
the RBI on December 9, 2021, that it has granted its approval to LIC, a shareholder of the bank, to acquire up to 9.99 per cent of the total issued and paid-up capital of the bank, the bank said in a regulatory filing on stock exchanges.

The stake-run insurer holds 4.95 per cent of the total issued and paid-up capital of the bank. The RBI approval is subject to compliance with

15 years from the exit of 15 per cent and also the new capital requirements.

This was deemed beneficial for banks like Kotak Mahindra Bank and IndusInd Bank. The said approval is valid for a period of one year, that is, up to December 8, 2022, the bank said. IndusInd Bank shares were marginally up at Rs 947 on BSE in afternoon trade on Friday.

## US SANCTIONS ON IRAN HAVE NO BEARING ON INDIA'S CHABAHAR PORT PROJECT: GOVT



The US sanctions on Iran have not affected India's Chabahar port project, External Affairs Minister S. Jaishankar told Lok Sabha on Friday.

Replying to a question from BSP member Ritesh Pandey, the minister also clarified that US sanctions are "not relevant" to India's Chabahar port project in Iran "at all". During the Question Hour, Pandey sought to know from the government if US sanctions on Iran had any bearing on India's project at the Chabahar port, and claimed that the Iranian government is "publicly saying that our Chabahar port project has been miserably delayed" due to sanctions imposed by the US. The BSP member also claimed he is "aware" that China is trying to work on the project by taking advantage of US sanctions on Iran as it is "in the real link", and asked the government if it is working on a "solution". "I would like to inform the member that his assertion is completely inaccurate. This

agreement was signed in 2016. We took possession of the terminal in 2018. We have already supplied six cranes. The terminal is fully functional," Minister Jaishankar said. "The US sanctions are not relevant to this project at all," he said in his reply. In a supplementary question, the BSP member sought to know from the government if India has signed "any backdoor agreement" to continue using the Chabahar port to provide help to central Asian countries and Afghanistan after Taliban took over the control of the Afghanistan government. "All our agreements on the Chabahar port operations are limited to Iran. Originally, there was a bilateral agreement but that was the basis to set it up. In terms of port operations, we are not required to have any agreement with the government of Afghanistan. And, I assure you that the port is functioning and functioning back," the external affairs minister said in his reply.

# SUMMIT OF DEMOCRACY MISSES KEY SOUTH ASIAN POWERS, BUT ENDORSES INDIA'S PROMINENCE

It has certainly not begun with a bang. Prime Minister Narendra Modi was one of twelve invited to speak at President Joe Biden's Summit of Democracy—an endorsement of India's special place—on Thursday. But the two-day summit—a flagship Biden endeavour—that brought together a hundred leaders, has been far from a hit.

"Democracy doesn't happen by accident," said Biden in his inaugural address. "And we have to renew it with each generation. In my view, this is the defining challenge of our time." But beyond the battle for democracy globally—the summit has thrown up challenges for America within South Asia, a region that America realises is key to dealing with China. Beijing was never on the list.

Only four countries from the region were invited: Pakistan, India, Maldives and Nepal. On Wednesday, Prime Minister Imran Khan backed out of the virtual summit. The invitation issued to Khan was not so much an endorsement of sound democratic institutions, but more an acknowledgement of the importance Pakistan plays especially with Afghanistan's instability. Khan, however, still miffed about not being included in Biden's call list, has chosen to politely decline.

A statement put out by Pakistan's foreign office said: "We value our partnership with the US, which we wish to expand both bilaterally as well as in terms of regional and international cooperation. We remain in contact with

the US on a range of issues and believe that we can engage on this subject at an opportune time in the future." It also, helps that China would be less than happy with Pakistan attending.

Bangladesh, another country—Muslim dominated—did not make the list—a slight that will certainly not be forgotten. "We have had a stable democracy over the last several years, a very clear and transparent democracy," foreign minister Dr A.K. Abdul Momen said. "Free and fair voting is happening."

Taiwan has been invited—which has ensured that the summit instead of looking inclusive seems to be targeted against China—a move that might help America win friends especially as smaller countries might find it hard to stand up to Chinese displeasure. America has also not invited Sri Lanka, Singapore, Thailand and Vietnam.

Meanwhile, China has unleashed a propaganda war on America as it was kept out of the summit, releasing a white paper titled, "China: Democracy That Works".

"China's whole-process people's democracy is not the kind that wakes up at the time of voting and goes back to dormant afterwards," Vice Foreign Minister Le Yucheng has been quoted as saying. For India, however, the invitation, as well as the singling out of Prime Minister to Modi, is certainly an acknowledgment of the role the country can play.



## NES, SNES creator Masayuki Uemura dies at 78

The Japanese designer behind the Nintendo Entertainment System (NES) and the Super Nintendo Entertainment System (SNES) has passed away at 78, the university he taught at said on Thursday.

Masayuki Uemura's work resulted in the sale of over 100 million video game consoles, sparking Nintendo's "golden age" and its transformation into one of the world's leading video game companies. As lead architect for the Famicom (rebranded as the NES in the United States), he designed the 8-bit console that would become synonymous with the video games it made a household name, including titles like Mario Super Bros, Donkey Kong, The Legend of Zelda, Metroid, Mega Man,

Castlevania and Contra.

The release of the Famicom in 1983 and the NES in 1985 coincided with the decline in arcade gaming, as more people found it convenient to play video games at home.

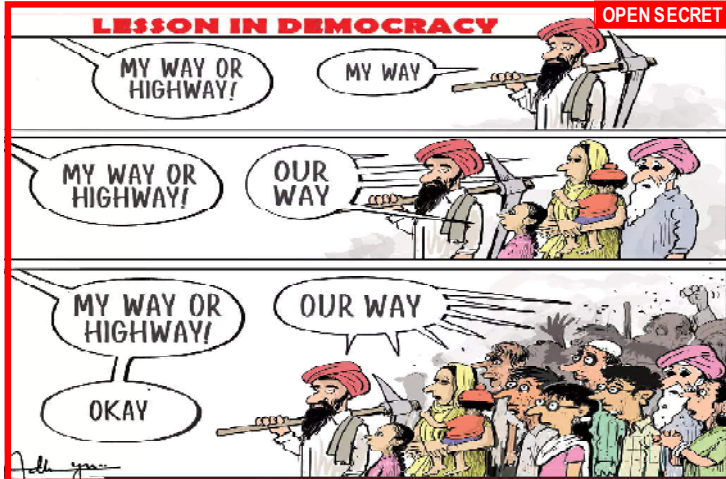
Uemura initially worked at Sharp, where he was involved in a project that developed

photosensitive cells. When Nintendo wanted a way to make a "light gun" (which was shipped along with the NES and allowed for videogames that let you point the attached gun peripheral at the screen and shoot), Sharp's technology came in handy.

Uemura joined Nintendo in 1972 where he worked on the

photovoltaic technology that would eventually become the iconic light gun. The genesis of the NES came after Nintendo President Hiroshi Yamauchi called Uemura after having a few drinks and suggested he make a video game console.

The gun would prove key to the NES's success. After the Famicom recorded average sales figures in Japan (initially), the decision to take it to North America was taken, along with some changes to suit the American audience. Nintendo dubbed the "NES Zapper" light gun with the NES as "Americans in general are interested in guns—a piece of trivia Uemura told New York University's Game Center in 2018, Kotaku reported. Uemura's wife proposed the name "Famicom" as a portmanteau of "family" and "computer".



## Women's football in India is rising: IM Vijayan

KOZHIKODE: The national women team's ascendancy was on display during the recent exposure tour of Brazil, said Indian football legend IM Vijayan, who believes that adding competition between players will further help in the growth of the game in the country.

India had played against Brazil, Chile and Venezuela in a four-nation tournament as part of its preparation for the AFC Asian Cup to be held in India – Mumbai and Pune – from January 20 to February 6.

While India lost all their three matches but the highlight of the tour was the one-goal that they scored against mighty Brazil, who are the 2007 World Cup runners-up.

"The way India played against Brazil was impressive. We scored a goal against the top team globally which shows that women's football in India is rising," the 52-year-old Vijayan, a former India men's team captain, said in a release issued by AIFF.

"Our team has improved a lot and the federation is also trying hard to give them the much needed exposure."

"India is hosting the Asian Cup next year

and every one is trying hard to build the team and play good football. I am very happy to see everyone contributing to the growth of women's football to take Indian Football forward together."

India international M. Suresh also echoed his sentiments.

"Indian women's team is in a good phase now. The way they performed against the top teams was a treat to watch," he quipped.

The two Indian footballers were also present at the stands to support the girls on the final day of the Senior Women's National Football Championship.

Defending champions Manipal claimed their 21st crown after a dramatic penalty shootout win over Railways in the final on Thursday.

"The way AFF and Kerala Government has organized the championship is commendable despite the COVID situation. It shows how each and every one is working towards the growth of Indian Football," Vijayan said.

"I am so happy to see that 32 teams



participated with so many young talents. I have come here for the first time to watch the girls play and I really enjoy the brand of football they showed."

"In our times, scoring was very easy for the teams but now the competition has become tougher which is needed for the growth of women's football in India." AIFF General Secretary, Kunal Das also hailed the efforts of all the state federations and the Government of Kerala involved to make the championship a success.

## Asian Champions Trophy will be great platform for fringe players: Hockey captain Manpreet Singh

BHUBANESWAR: The upcoming Asian Champions Trophy in Dhaka will be a perfect platform for the fringe players to show case their talent and stake a claim in the first team, said Indian men's hockey team captain Manpreet Singh.

The tournament, originally scheduled to be held last year, has been postponed multiple times due to the COVID-19 pandemic, and will now be played from December 14 to 22.

This will be India's first outing after the team's historic Olympic bronze medal winning campaign earlier this year. The Manpreet

Singh-led side will be without eight players from the Tokyo Games squad, including the likes of veteran goalkeeper PR Sreejesh who has been rested.

"With nearly 10 players who were part of the Tokyo Olympic squad being rested, this is a fantastic opportunity for the players who had been waiting on the sidelines to get a chance to perform in a major international tournament. This will be a good platform for them to show case their talent and temperament," said Manpreet before leaving for Dhaka on Friday.

Defending champions India would begin their campaign on the

opening day against Korea before locking horns against Japan, Malaysia, Pakistan and hosts Bangladesh in the single-pool tournament for top honours.

"This is our first outing after the Tokyo Olympics so naturally there is a lot of excitement among the players. We have had a good training camp in Bhubaneswar and I feel since the weather here is quite similar to that of Dhaka, we won't take long to acclimatise," the skipper said. "It will be a good tournament not just in terms of competition but also to understand about our team's capabilities. We assess the progress of other Asian countries

ahead of the all-important Asian Games and Asia Cup next year," the ace mid-fielder added. After Korea, India will play Bangladesh on December 15, followed by matches against arch-rivals Pakistan on December 17, Malaysia on December 18 and Japan on December 19. The top-four teams from the pool stages will progress to the semi-finals to be played on December 21 followed by the title clash on December 22.

In the previous edition of the event held in Muscat in 2018, India had jointly lifted the title along with Pakistan as the final was called off due to incessant rains.

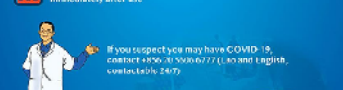

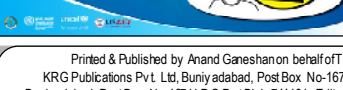
