

## PM releases benefits under PM CARES for Children Scheme

### PM CARES for children is a reflection of the fact that every countryman is with you with the utmost sensitivity: PM

New Delhi, May 30 (PIB)

Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi released benefits under PM CARES for Children Scheme today via video conference. Union Minister Smt Smriti Irani, many other members of the Council of Ministers, and Chief Ministers were among those connected to the event.

Addressing the gathering, the Prime Minister empathised with the difficulties in the lives of those children who lost their loved ones due

to Corona. "Every day's struggle, every day's challenges. It is difficult to put into words the pain of the children who are with us today, for whom this program is happening", a moved Prime Minister told the children. He told them that he is speaking as a member of the family, not as a Prime Minister.

In such a scenario, the Prime Minister said "PM CARES for Children is a small effort to reduce the difficulties of such corona affected children who lost both their mother and



father. PM CARES for children is also a reflection of the fact that every countryman is with you with the utmost sensitivity." The Prime Minister informed that if someone needs an education loan for

professional courses or higher education, then PM-CARES will help in that too. For other daily needs, arrangements have also been made for 4 thousand rupees every month for them through other schemes. Apart from

Rs 10 lakh on attaining the age of 23 years the children will be given health coverage through the Ayushman Card and emotional counselling through samvad helpline for psychological and emotional help.



The Prime Minister saluted the

children for facing the most painful impact of the pandemic so bravely and said that nothing can compensate for the love of the parents. "Maa Bharati is with all you children in this hour of difficulty". The nation is trying to meet its responsibility through PM CARES for Children, he said.

The Prime Minister recalled the instances of human kindness during the pandemic, especially how people contributed to the welfare of the affected people. The Prime Minister noted that this fund also helped a lot in preparing hospitals, buying ventilators and setting up oxygen

## Electricity Department conducts meter reading exercise at 38 hotels & commercial establishments

### Non operation of DG Sets & power theft at 13 hotels & commercial establishments reported

### 66 complaints received at Site Offices resolved instantly

### Line clearance exercises minimize power disruptions significantly in last two days

Port Blair, May 30

In pursuance of the directions of the Chief Secretary, teams of JEs and Meter Readers of Electricity Department conducted meter reading exercise at 38 hotels and commercial establishments in Bazar, Shadipur and Bathubasti areas and reported non operation of DG Sets at the peak hours and power theft at 13 hotels and commercial establishments. Strict legal action will be taken against such establishments as per Electricity Act 2003. Further it is to be noted that meter reading exercises were very less in last many years which will be done regularly in future as per the directions of the Administration.

In a continuous effort to resolve power disruptions, several teams consisting of officials of Power Department, APWD, Forest and Fire exercise electricity



Departments have been mobilized. These multi departmental teams have continuously worked on line clearance and pruning of dangerous trees to create safe corridor for electricity feeder lines. Total 153.8 kilometers of feeder lines were provided with safe corridor so that frequent power disruption and electricity faults are prevented. During this exercise electricity

supplies of that specific area are being stopped for the safety of staffs who are engaged in line clearance work. The general public is requested to support the team so that this exercise may be completed at the earliest and power disruptions may be minimized.

Further, the general public are requested to contact the District Control Room on the numbers 03192-238881,

240127, 9531888844 (WhatsApp) or at the phone numbers of area site offices and pass on the information regarding misuse/ theft of electricity by commercial establishments. The general public should lodge any complaint regarding power disruption on help line numbers given above. Total 66 complaints have been reported on the phone numbers of area Site Offices of Electricity Department which were instantly resolved by the staffs of Electricity Department.

It is further to be noted that total electricity disruptions in all feeders were reported 182 times, 67:38 hours on 28th May, 2022, while 142 times & 45:02 hours on 29th May, 2022. Line clearance exercise and maintenance of feeder lines have minimized power disruptions significantly from 67:38 hrs to 45:02 hrs in the last two days, a press release from the Director (Power) said.

## NFBS being implemented by Social Welfare Deptt.; BPL category family eligible for availing benefit under the scheme

The Directorate of Social Welfare is implementing the National Family Benefit Scheme (NFBS) under the National Social Assistance Programme (NSAP). Under this scheme, an amount of Rs.20000/- will be given as a lump sum

assistance to the bereaved household in the event of death of the breadwinner. It is clarified that in the event of death (natural or otherwise) would make the family eligible for assistance. A woman in the family, who is a homemaker, is also considered a 'bread-

winner' for this purpose. The family benefit will be paid to such surviving member of the household of the deceased poor, who after local enquiry, is found to be the head of the household. For the purpose of the scheme, the term

plants during the Corona period. Because of this many lives could be saved, and the future of many families could be saved.  
The Prime Minister remarked that even in the darkest atmosphere of despair, if we believe in ourselves, then a ray of light is definitely visible. He cited our country itself to be the biggest example of this. The Prime Minister advised the children not to allow despair to turn into defeat. He asked them to listen to their elders and their teacher. He also said that in these difficult times good books can be their reliable friends. He also asked them to stay disease-free and get involved and lead Khelo India and Fit India Movement. He also asked them to participate in the Yoga day also. He said that in that atmosphere of negativity, India relied on its strength. "We trusted our scientists, our doctors, and our youth. And, we came out as a ray of hope, not a worry for the world. We did not become the problem but we came out as the solution giver. We sent medicines, and vaccines to countries around the world. Even in such a big country, we took the vaccine to every citizen", he said. Our country is moving as the fastest growing economy and the world is looking towards us with new hope and faith, he added.  
The Prime Minister expressed happiness that today when his government is completing its 8 years, the confidence of the country, the confidence of the countrymen in themselves is unprecedented. With corruption, scams worth thousands of crores, nepotism, terrorist organizations spreading across the country, and regional discrimination, the country is getting out of the vicious cycle in which it was trapped before 2014. 'household' would include spouses, minor children, unmarried daughters, and dependent parents. In case of death of an unmarried adult, the term household would include minor brothers/ sisters and dependent parents.  
The death of such breadwinner should have occurred while he/she is more than 18 years of age and less than 59 years of age. The assistance would be given to every case of death of a breadwinner in a family.  
The eligibility criteria for availing the Scheme is that the family should belong to the BPL category. The eligible beneficiaries may obtain the form from the Directorate of Social Welfare or Offices of the CDPOs at Urban Project, Ferrargunj, Rangat, Diglipur, Car Nicobar and other out stations, a press release from Directorate of Social Welfare said.

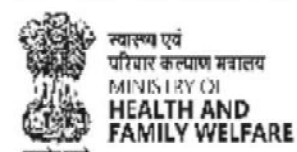

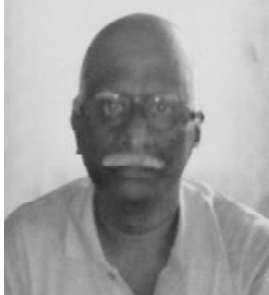

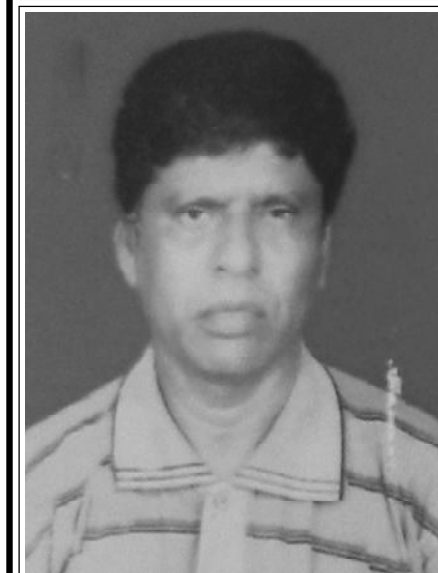
