What is a Coral?

have an outer stony skeleton and live in colonies in the sea. They belong to the same animals group as the sea anemones, and jelly fish. Each coral animal is called a polyp and lives inside a cup of carbonate (Limestone). It has a mouth at the top surrounded by tentacles. The tentacles help to capture food like plankton for the coral. While it is alive, a coral poly's tentacles protrude from the cups for feeding. In times of danger, the polyp can withdraw into its cup. This is similar to a turtle withdrawing into its shell when disturbed. A coral polyp cannot move and remains fixed to its cup throughout its life. Coral polyps can be of several species - in A&N alone, 135 species are found.

#### Restrictions to be Imposed on Commercial Vehicles in Vehicle Ferries between Chatham - Bambooflat

Port Blair, Dec. 23: In view of the manifold increase in the vehicular traffic in the route between Chatham and Bambooflat, the Directorate of Shipping Services has decided to impose restriction on the movement/ transportation of commercial vehicles, through the vehicle ferry vessels operating in the above route, during the peak hours i.e. between 7.30 am to 9.45 am and from 5 pm to 6.45 pm on all working days except Holidays.

Similarly, movement/transportation of non-commercial four wheeler vehicles, has also been restricted to 2 four Wheeler vehicles per trip, during the above peak hours in the above route.

In order to clear the rush especially during peak hours, the vessels once full to its capacity, instead of waiting for her scheduled departure time, shall sail immediately.

Success is not an activity but a process ...

#### Twitter After Elon Musk

It has been nearly two months since business magnate Elon Musk took control of Twitter Inc. after a \$44 billion acquisition. The fear that there would be a loosening of content standards under his helmsmanship has played itself out to be eerily true. Yet, no one could have foreseen the chaos that has reigned since the takeover of the popular social media platform. There has been a whittling down of the workforce which has also included summary dismissals based on whimsical reasons. The loss of employees, especially those working in the appeals process and other content moderation teams, has hurt redress processes. Poorly thoughtout decisions such as users paying a monthly fee to get a "verified account" have been overturned after an embarrassing increase in impersonation. The Twitter accounts of some journalists critical of Mr. Musk or who merely reported on a controversial decision by Mr. Musk to suspend the accounts of flight trackers have been suspended too without proper notice or explanation. Twitter also came up with a controversial rule about users not posting links to specific and rival social media platforms. This resulted in a severe backlash and forced Mr. Musk to post a poll asking his over 122 million followers whether he should step down as the "head of Twitter", and in turn eliciting a majority response in the affirmative. Mr. Musk has now promised to find another CEO.

The past two months have made it clear that Mr. Musk is out of his depth in running operations in a platform that has gained outsized significance and appeal despite being unable to remain a financial success consistently. For better or worse, Twitter has become a key member of the Internet public sphere, connecting journalists, public officials and powerful corporate leaders to the people and allowing for the dispersal of news, opinions and critiques, even if it has also retained aspects related to hate speech, bullying and disinformation. Twitter had tried to mitigate misgivings about the platform by coming up with content moderation principles and a rules-based order to govern content, although it has been a work in progress. But ever since Mr. Musk took over, this has been overshadowed by his arbitrary diktats and posturing. He seems to be aware that the loss of advertisers (a process that has continued because of the lowering of content standards) and of reputation (because of his arbitrariness) will further hurt the company's financial interests. This explains why he has agreed to step down. But his innate tendency of being a political reactionary seems to get in the way of doing the right thing. A more democratic and well-governed social media universe with newer platforms can help reduce the harm, but Twitter and its users also deserve better.



# 'One of the Greatest Players of this Club' -Guardiola Lauds 'Grumpy' De Bruyne Whose **Masterclass Takes Man City Past Liverpool**

December 23: After a disappointing showing with Belgium, whose long-hyped 'golden generation' suffered a group-stage exit at the recently concluded World Cup, Kevin De Bruyne proved why he is one of the best players in the world as club football resumed. The Belgian ran the show in Manchester City's midfield, getting two assists which could have been five, in their 3-2 win over Liverpool in the EFL Cup.

Following the game, coach Pep Guardiola was full of praise for his talisman, claiming the 31year-old needs to be "grumpy", as he may have been after the World Cup, to find the killer instinct. "Today he was outstanding. Kevin has had eight years here, you know him like me – he has to find the right fire inside of himself, just to be a little bit, I would say grumpy or upset toplay his best," Guardiola said in his post-match press conference.

"I know it is not easy to find every three days this consistency but today he had something inside that says I am going to it, I want to fight," he added. "What can I say, eight years he has done everything for this club, an



absolute legend. He will be remembered forever as one of the greatest, greatest, greatest players of this club."

Despite the game being the first since players return from the World Cup - Guardiola was particularly brutal in his team selection, picking Natahan Ake, who had played 120 minutes in the Netherlands' quarterfinal defeat to Argentina just last week, as well as Manuel Akanji and Rodri who had played the Round of 16 with Switzerland and Spain respectively - but it was played at a terrific pace.

De Bruyne found Erling Haaland with a brilliant cross down the left toopen the scoring,

with Fabio Carvalho opening the scoring shortly after. City went into half time at 1-1 as the better team, and through a marvellous touch and finish from Riyadh Mahrez, took an early lead in the second, only for Mohamed Salah to equalise shortly after.

De Bruyne created the last of his five chances to pick up his second assist, a pinpoint cross after a short corner routine into the path of Ake, who headed home. Liverpool could have equalised, or even been in the lead, had Darwin Nunez converted a couple of clear-cut chances that fell his way, but City's overall domination saw them pick up a deserved win to knock out the title

December 23: IPL Auction 2023 Live Updates: The countdown to the 2023 edition of the Indian Premier League will officially begin from Kochi when franchises will look to rejig their squads before the big event in the IPL mini auction. Titans need a replacement for Lockie Ferguson while Royal Challengers Banglaore will probably look for a batter with a good strike rate.

Kolkata Knight Riders have already added Shardul, Lockie and Rahmanullah Gurbaz in their ranks and will probably look for a death over specialist while Chennai and Mumbai will be looking to fill the big holes left by Bravo and pollard respectively. Punjab will be eyeing a fast bowling allrounder, Rajasthan will be in the market for a reliable middle order batter and Lucknow will be eveing a couple of fast bowlers.

It is that time of the year when IPL franchise officials turn poker-faced and keep their cards close to their chest. Fifteen seasons have gone by since the Indian Premier League came into

existence, and the auction strategy has proved to be a tough egg to crack, unless one is an insider.

Every auction throws up a surprise or two. Yes, all-rounders and multi-utility players, ones who are regarded as X-factors tend to get a windfall, but there is no certainty to any of it.

For instance, in the full-fledged auction held last year, it was the fast bowlers, especially the Indians, who walked away with big pay cheques. As the IPL gets ready for a mini-auction on Friday in Kochi, it is time to expect the unexpected. Despite this being a mini-auction, 405 players are in the pool. Ben Stokes, Sam Curran and Cameron Green, all capable fast-medium allrounders and match-winners, are set to trigger a paddle-raising frenzy at the auction.


