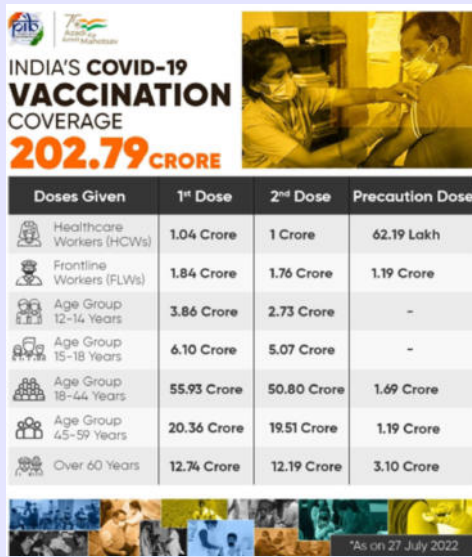

## Over 202 crore 79 lakh COVID vaccine doses administered in country so far

New Delhi, July 27

Over 202 crore 79 lakh vaccine doses have been administered so far under Nationwide Vaccination Drive. The Health Ministry said, over 27 lakh 37 thousand doses were administered yesterday. The recovery rate is currently at 98.47 per cent. Over 20 thousand people recovered in the last 24 hours. Total number of recoveries have reached four crore 32 lakh 67 thousand 571.

Over 18 thousand new cases were recorded in the last 24 hours. India's Active caseload currently stands at one lakh 45 thousand 26. Active cases stand at 0.33 per cent. Daily Positivity Rate is at 4.31 per cent



and Weekly Positivity Rate is at 4.57 per cent. 57 deaths were reported during the last 24 hours. Over 87 crore 36 lakh tests have been conducted so far. Over four lakh 25 thousand tests were conducted in the last 24 hours. (Source: india.gov.in)

Bangladesh will host the 2024 Women's T20 World Cup, while the 2026 edition will be held



in England. Sri Lanka has secured hosting rights for the Women's T20 Champions Trophy, slated for 2027, provided it qualifies for the event.

The hosts were selected via a bidding process overseen by a

ICC Board Sub-Committee which included BCCI President, Shri Sourav Ganguly.

Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi released the 11th installment of the scheme on 31st May, 2022 directly to the bank accounts of the PM KISAN beneficiaries.

The Govt. of India has decided to undertake e-KYC verification of all the eligible registered beneficiaries of PM-KISAN Scheme for smooth transfer of benefits. Accordingly, eKYC is mandatory for PM-KISAN registered farmers. It is therefore informed to all eligible registered farmers of PM-KISAN scheme to update their KYC. The e-KYC authentication of the beneficiaries can be done by both e-KYC OTP mode as well as e-KYC biometric mode. The e-KYC authentication of the beneficiaries through OTP mode can be done on PM-KISAN portal free of cost by the beneficiaries or State functionaries. And for e-KYC biometric authentication facility, the beneficiary may visit the nearest CSC center. The CSC will charge for bio-metric authentication from each beneficiary. For any query/doubt related to e-KYC, the beneficiaries can also contact the concerned Zonal Agriculture Office/Field Extension functionaries of Agriculture Department. The farmers are advised to use only the official website of PM-KISAN portal and not to download any other App for e-KYC authentication.

The deadline of eKYC for all the PM-KISAN beneficiaries has been extended till 31st July, 2022, a press release from Directorate of Agriculture said.

In supersession of all previous appointment orders of Booth Level Officers(BLOs),under Section 13B(2) of Representation of People Act, 1950, the following Govt. Servants are hereby appointed as <b>Booth Level Officers</b> for the Part(s)/Polling Station(s) mentioned against their name with immediate effect.				
The BLOs shall attend to the Electoral Roll related duties in the polling area as indicated against their name. They would be considered on deputation to the Election Commission of India for this purpose and would be subject to the disciplinary control of the Election Commission of India under Section 32 of Representation of People Act, 1950. BLOs shall not proceed on leave without obtaining permission and making over his election related charge. Even in case of their transfer, they should ensure to hand over all election related papers, records and registers to their successor within the prescribed time.				
The BLOs shall have to perform their duties in addition to their official work in such manner that it does not affect their normal official duties. The objective of BLOs shall be to prepare an error-free Electoral Roll and to achieve cent percent enrolment of eligible citizens.				
During the course of Special Summary Revision of Electoral Rolls, ordered by the Election Commission of India, the BLOs shall be required to be present in their respective jurisdiction. Duties and Responsibilities of BLOs is annexed herewith as <b>ANNEXURE-I</b> .


