Farmers' Corner- A Knowledge Hub Spider orchid (Arachnisflosaeris) a potential cut flower

Arachnis (Arachnisflosaeris) is an epiphytic, monopodial orchid commonly called as spider orchid or scorpion orchid. It is an outstanding cut flower with pretty long flower spikes and usually grown under protected condition. To make the production economical, a technology was developed to cultivate this orchid in pandal system in open. The low cost pandal type of support system was established with concrete poles and plastic wire. By this new method



of cultivation, flowering was observed throughout the year with luxurious growth of the plant, whereas in conventional method of growing spider orchid under protected condition, flowering was observed once in a year during November to January. Flowers are produced once in 13-15 days interval from an axillary bud of a plant. Once in three vears, 50 to 60 cm terminal cuttings of the stems can be done and once rooted the same may be planted near the mother plant in the same pole. When the new planted cuttings start bearing the old plants may be removed based on the vigour. By this way the Arachnis orchid production system can be maintained permanently for year round harvest of cut flowers.

Benefit:This technology can be utilized even by farmers with small holdings since spacing adopted between the poles is 30 cm x 45 cm. This crop is highly suitable for home gardening and performs well with minimum organic input in open with less mana

He said India has been a member since the formation of the United Nations and had signed the Charter of the United Nations in 1945 prior to Independence. In 1947-48, when the Universal Declaration of UN Human Rights was being drafted, "All Men are Created Equal" was being inscribed in that Declaration. However, a Delegate from India, Hansa Mehta objected to this and the inscription was changed to "All Human Beings are Created Equal". Shri Modi said this was in consonance with India's age-old tradition of Gender Equality.

The said. systems, banks and other institutions at all levels.

The leadership development training scheme shall be implemented by the Ministry of Minority Affairs through selected organizations. The selected organizations should implement the project directly through their organizational set-up in the locality/village/area. The Central Government and UT Administration training institutes including universities and institutes of higher learning can also implement the scheme. Organizations which would be eligible for applying for financial assistance under this scheme are Societies registered under the Societies Registration Act,1860; a public Trust registered under any law for the time being inforce, a private limited non-profit company registered under Section 25 of the Indian Companies Act,1956; Universities/Institutions of higher learning recognized by University Grants Commission(UGC), Training institutes of Central and State Government/UT Administration including Panchayati Raj Training institutes and duly registered Cooperative Societies of Women/Self Help Groups.

The selected organization would have the responsibility to motivate, identify and select women to be trained in accordance with the criteria of the scheme from villages/urban localities having a substantial minority population. The organizations will involve Head of the Gram Panchayat/Municipal Body/ Local Authority for identification/selection of women trainees.

The details of the trainees will be submitted by the organization before the start of training through the Online Application Management System (OAMS) for Nai Roshni, once the project is approved. Although there will be no annual income bar, a woman/parent or guardian of woman having annual income not exceeding Rs.2.50 lakh from all sources would be given preference in selection. They should be between the age group of 18 years to 65 years.

The proposal should be submitted in the prescribed format through Online Application Management System (OAMS). The link of OAMS is available on by community in setting Plant Varieties and official website of Ministry of Minority Affairs i.e. www.minorityaffairs.gov.in.

After filling up the complete proposal in the OAMS, a print of the same may be taken and submitted to the District Collector/ District Magistrate for their recommendation in the prescribed format.

The detailed guidelines of the scheme are available on the website www.minorityaffairs.gov.in, a press release from Directorate of Social Welfare said.
