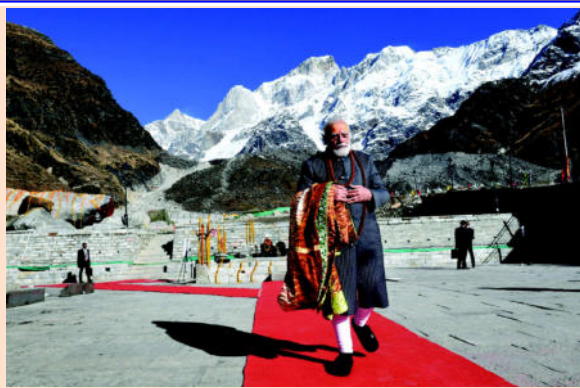
Visit places related to glorious freedom struggle of India and pious places of pilgrimage & get acquainted with 'spirit of India': PM

Indian philosophy talks about human welfare and looks at life in a holistic way

New Delhi, Nov. 5 (PIB)

The Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi laid foundation stones and dedicated to the Nation various development projects in Kedarnath. He inaugurated Shri Adi Shankaracharya Samadhi and unveiled the statue of Shri Adi Shankaracharya. He also reviewed and inspected the ongoing infrastructure works. The Prime Minister also offered prayers at the Kedarnath Temple. Prayers were offered and celebrations held at 12 Jyotirlingas and 4 dhams and many places of faith all over the country along with the event at Kedarnath Dham. All events were linked to the main event at Kedarnath Dham.

Addressing the gathering, the Prime Minister evoked the great spiritual rishi tradition of India and expressed his indescribable



joy on coming to Kedarnath Dham. Recalling his interaction with soldiers at Nowshera yesterday, he said yesterday, on Diwali, he took the feelings of 130 crore Indians to soldiers, today, on Govardhan Puja, he said that I was on the land of soldiers and in the divine presence of Baba Kedar. The Prime Minister said that new facilities like shelters, facilitation centres will ease the lives of priests and devotees and allow them to fully immerse in the divine experience of the pilgrimage. Recalling the Kedarnath floods in 2013, the Prime Minister noted that damage caused by the floods years ago was unimaginable. He said "people who used to come here

used to think that will this our Kedar Dham stand up again? But my inner voice was saying that it will stand with more pride than ever before." The Prime Minister said due to the grace of Lord Kedar and inspiration of Adi Shankaracharya and his experience of managing the aftermath of the Bhuj Earthquake, he could be of help in those difficult times. He struck a personal note and said that it is a blessing that he could serve the place which nurtured him earlier in his life. He thanked all the workers, priests, officials and the Chief Minister for relentlessly pursuing the development works at the Dham. I said he kept monitoring the work through drones and other technologies. He said that "this combination of modernity with the eternal on this ancient

PM FME offering Branding & Marketing support for SPV of Micro Food Enterprises/ FPOs/ SHGs/ Co-operatives

Pradhan Mantri Scheme for Formalization of Micro Food Processing Enterprises (PM FME), Centrally Sponsored Scheme of Ministry of Food Processing Industries (MoFPI), Govt. of India under Atmanirbhar Bharat Abhiyaan offers Branding and Marketing support for the SPV of Micro Food Enterprises/ FPOs/ SHGs/ Co-operatives on the

principle of One District One Product (ODOP). The enterprises would be provided Branding and Marketing support limited to 50% of total expenditure for expanding one or more food products.

A legal entity would be eligible that brings together Micro units of an area including FPOs/ SHGs/ Co-operatives for common branding and marketing of their produce under the scheme. It could be

private entity or in association with state agencies including SRLM. The proposal for Branding and Marketing must fulfill following prerequisites:

- ♦ The product short-listed should be within ODOP Scheme. The ODOP identified for South Andaman district is Marine Fish products while Coconut based products for other two districts of A&N Islands.
- ♦ Minimum turnover

Media briefed on COVID-19

No positive case detected during tests conducted on incoming flight and inter-island bound passengers: Director (IP&T)

Port Blair, Nov. 5

The Director (IP&T), Shri Alok Kumar addressing the media briefing on COVID-19 held in the conference hall of IP&T today stated that during the RT-PCR test conducted on 658 passengers who arrived here yesterday, no positive case has been detected.

Today, 11 flights with 1900 passengers arrived, out of which, 1260 were vaccinated with both doses while RT-PCR test was conducted on 640 passengers and the reports are awaited. RAT was conducted on 132 passengers bound for North & Middle Andaman at Ferrargunj

and no positive case has been detected. At Mohanpura Bus Terminus, test was conducted on 69 passengers and all were found negative. At Helipad, RAT was conducted on 11 passengers and all were found negative.

A & N Islands reduces VAT for both Diesel & Petrol from existing 6% to 1%

Revised rate of taxes has come into effect from Nov. 5

Port Blair, Nov.5

In exercise of power conferred under Section 113 read with Sub-Section (2) of Section 4 of Andaman and Nicobar Value Added Tax Regulation 2017 and in partial modification of Notification No. 1-2/DC (SA)/VAT/Notification/2018-19/4070 dated 20th June, 2019 and Notification No.1-2/DC(SA)/VAT/Notification/2021-22 dated 23rd September,



2021, the Lieutenant Governor (Government), Andaman and Nicobar Islands has notified the revised rate of taxes in respect of High Speed Diesel and Motor Spirit (Commonly Known as Petrol) mentioned in the First Schedule of Andaman and Nicobar

Islands Value Added Tax Regulation 2017. With this, the revised rate of taxes in respect of both High Speed Diesel and Motor Spirit (Commonly Known as Petrol) has been reduced to 1% from the existing 6%.

The revised rate has come into force with effect from 5th November, 2021, a notification to this effect issued by Commissioner (VAT) said.

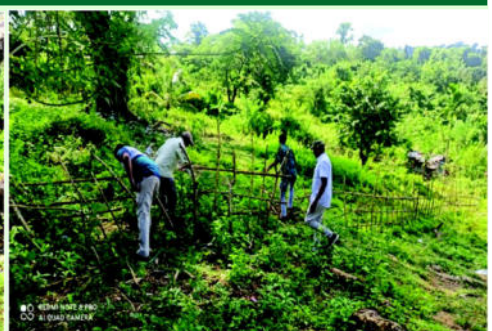
Revenue Deptt.(SA) conducts eviction drive in

Refrigerated vehicle for transportation of fishes procured by women beneficiary under the scheme flagged off

Beneficiary to become role model for others to emulate: DC(SA)

Port Blair, Nov. 5

A refrigerated vehicle for the purpose of transportation of fishes purchased by a beneficiary named Smt. Manimegalie under Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana (PMMSY) was flagged off this morning by Shri Suneel Anchipaka, Deputy Commissioner/Chairman, District Level Committee (DLC) of PMMSY South Andaman from the premises of DC office, South Andaman. The beneficiary availed 60% subsidy assistance from Department of Fisheries for a



unit cost of Rs.25.00 Lakh from the fund released by Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying, Govt. of India for implementation of various components

of PMMSY in A&N Islands. The refrigerated truck is designed to keep the fish fresh in a temperature ranges from -18°C to -20°C for transporting fish from North and Middle Andaman for catering the whole sale demand of Port Blair as well as to enhance the direct export potential.

This refrigerated vehicle will protect fish from spoilage while transporting and arrest the post mortem changes by lowering temperature. This can be used for longer transportation of fish even from Diglipur to Port Blair without compromising the

Pahargaon Police cracks 3 theft cases in Garacharma area

On the night of 31/10/21, three burglaries happened in Garacharma and mobile phone worth Rs.15000/-, cash worth Rs.17,000/- and Rs.50,000/- were stolen. Upon receipt of complaints from Shri. Chandan Kumar Bepari, S/o Shri. Purna Bepari (39) yrs, Pvt Carpenter, R/o Garacharma, Shri. Rahul Bissu, S/o Ramesh Gandhi (27) yrs, R/o Garacharma and Smti. Shila Karmakar, W/o Shri. Narayan Karmakar (39) yrs, Housewife R/o Garacharma (II), regarding theft of Rs.

17000/-, Rs. 50000/- and Mobile phone worth Rs. 15000/- respectively, three FIRs were registered at PS Pahargaon.

Acting swiftly upon the complaints, immediately, a special team comprising of SI Mohd. Rahil Islam, SI Samiran Mridha, SI Manish Narayan and supporting staff was constituted for search and arrest of the unknown accused person. All efforts including local intelligence and technical surveillance in the form of CCTV footages were

- ♦ The final product should be the one to be sold to the consumer in retail pack.
- ♦ Product and produces should be scalable to larger levels.
- ♦ Management and entrepreneurship capability of promoting entity should be established in the proposal.

The eligible entities should prepare a Detailed Project Report (DPR) and submit physical copy/ Electronic copy of the proposal containing details mentioned in these guidelines with necessary supporting documents. Support up to Rs. 5 lakhs would be available from the State Nodal Agency for preparing DPR for Branding and Marketing proposals.

Since the scheme is operational from 2020-2021 to 2024-2025, all the proposal should be submitted well within this period to ensure timely and effective implementation. quality of fish to be transported. The vehicle is made with high insulation quality and thickness suitable for local climatic conditions. This kind of cold transportation facility will help to get maximum value for the local fishers of outer Islands and also will ensure the regular supply of fish.

Strengthening of cold chain and transport facility for fish and fishery products is also one of the major objectives of Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana. Considering the Marine Fisheries Potential of the Islands, the Department of Fisheries has introduced several components in this line like purchase of Insulated/Refrigerated vehicle, three-wheeler, setting up of Cold storage/Ice plants, Fish value added units etc. since 2020 with a vision to make concrete infrastructure for direct export from these Islands. Many beneficiaries have already availed assistance for these components through District Level Committee and the grounding of assets is under process. The Department is targeting negligible post harvest loss and maximum value addition of Island branded marine fish catch by 2025 through these schemes of PMMSY to make A&N Islands a marketing and exporting hub of fish and fishery products to Southeast Asia.

Expressing his views on the occasion, the Deputy Commissioner, South Andaman, said that the 'Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana' is a flagship scheme and the Govt. of India is pushing it very meticulously so that the scheme reaches out to the beneficiaries. To implement the scheme in letter & spirit in Isles, the A&N Administration has reached out to the beneficiaries by creating awareness about the scheme.

The efforts of the Administration have borne fruits as the application of a lady beneficiary, who has taken the lead and applied for the scheme, was approved by the District Level Committee. This has paved way for the purchase of 'Refrigerated Van' and the lady beneficiary, Smt. R. Manimegalie has become a role model to others to emulate, the Deputy Commissioner said.

This is the first of its kind venture under this scheme, which will enable the beneficiary to transport sea food from remote areas including North & Middle Andaman maintaining and upkeeping the freshness/shelf life of the Marine produce. The Deputy Commissioner further urged other beneficiaries to come forward and be in touch with the District Office & Fisheries Department to avail the benefits under 'Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana'.

Almonds	- 8 to 10 (finely chopped)
Raisins	- 1 table spoon

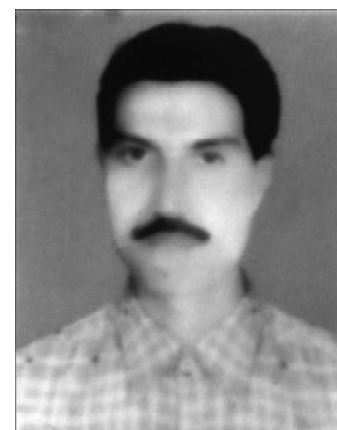
