Non-functional mortuary unit at GBPH gives tough time to kin of deceased

Port Blair, Dec 6: The mortuary unit of GB Pant hospital has been non-functional for the past 15 days. As a result of non-functioning of the mortuary unit of GB Pant Hospital, the bodies of dead people cannot be kept at the mortuary unit of this hospital. The mortuary unit of this hospital has capacity to keep about eight dead bodies in the freezers, but due to non-functional freezers, kin of the dead are compelled to keep the body in the mortuary without the freezers and have to rush to take the body before the decomposition starts. The hospital authorities are tightlipped and are not informing the relatives of the dead persons about non-functional freezers in the mortuary. They quickly dispose of the bodies. Generally, the kin of the dead person keep the body in the mortuary unit for a night and



take the body to their homes for cremation on the next day. But with non-functional morgue, the health authorities are befiling the kin of the dead by not disclosing the information about non-functional morgue. People believing that the

morgue is functional keeps the dead bodies in the mortuary. As most families take away the bodies on the very next day, they don't have an idea on non-functional morgue at GB Pant Hospital. But the health authorities look for

excuses when asked to keep the unclaimed bodies. A morgue staff on the condition of anonymity told EOI that bodies are getting decayed due to non-functional freezers and air-conditioning system, but this fact is hidden from the kin of the dead.

Cap doesn't fit

G7 plus Australia have imposed a price cap of \$60 a barrel on seaborne export of Russian crude oil in an effort to squeeze the country's revenue and thereby undermine its war-fighting capabilities. The price cap represents a 30% discount to the price of the benchmark Brent crude. The 'price cap coalition', which has elicited the support of the EU, plans to enforce the ceiling price by using its clout with the major shipping, insurance and re-insurance companies headquartered there. The stated aim is to weaken the Russian military without triggering a spike in oil price.

It's bound to fail. But notwithstanding that, many beleaguered emerging market economies will be affected by the collateral fallout of this attempt. The eight months of sanctions on Russia since it invaded Ukraine in February have neither brought the fighting to an end nor had any impact on the former's behaviour. It provides more evidence that sanctions are a blunt tool that end up hurting countries unrelated to the problem, without achieving any of the core objectives of Western nations imposing sanctions.

The most egregious example of the futility of sanctions are the series of efforts initiated by the US on Iran since 1979. None of the sanctions have had a meaningful impact on Iranian foreign policy. Ironically, as the American media reported, Iranian drones used by the Russian military have sourced critical components from both Europe and the US. Clearly, none of the sanctions have prevented Iran from developing its armament capabilities while they have hurt countries such as India that sourced crude oil from there. Given this background, India did well to ramp up purchases this year of discounted Russian crude. Russia is now India's third largest crude supplier from being practically irrelevant a year ago as a source of supply.

The new price cap has enough loopholes to keep Russian oil exports going. However, using Western dominance on the global financial system to squeeze seaborne Russian oil supplies will end up hurting a country like Bangladesh, which handled the pandemic without serious economic disruption but finds itself facing a tough balance of payments situation because of an energy shock. Finally, the meaningless nature of the current price cap is reflected in the Ukrainian government's view that it just won't achieve its core aim of deterring Russia. Just what good are sanctions?

Govt holds all party meeting in New Delhi ahead of Winter Session of Parliament

All party meeting was held in Parliament Complex in New Delhi ahead of the Winter Session of Parliament, which is scheduled to begin from tomorrow.

WORLD CUP BETTING DOWN IN LAS VEGAS BUT HIGHER THAN EXPECTED

The World Cup may be the globe's biggest sporting event, yet in the United States in the fall, it competes with a full sports betting calendar.

Las Vegas sportsbook directors weren't overly optimistic the betting would be higher than the 2018 World Cup, which was played in the more usual summer months in Russia. And, they were correct about the Qatar event.

Even in the U.S. in November and December, however, the World Cup still makes a notable impact, and it was larger than expected in Las Vegas, the hub of domestic sports betting.

Jay Kornegay, vice president of race and sports operations at Westgate Las Vegas, compared World Cup matches during a more typical time of the year being bet on the same level as NFL games. This year's are more comparable to college basketball.

We knew going into this World Cup and it taking place during the fall and sharing that main stage with football, basketball and hockey was going to take some of that limelight away from the World Cup, Kornegay said. Normally, it has the main stage all to itself in the summer. This year, it's different and it's definitely

showing.

Adam Pullen, Caesars Sportsbook assistant director of trading, said it's difficult to know exactly what the difference is between 2018 and 2022 largely because many more states have legalized sports betting. Just on sheer numbers, the betting handle nationally could be up, but how that translates by percentage per market is unknown.

It's comparing apples to oranges, but at least we'll see how it does compare and how drastic a difference it is, Pullen said. I've been pleased. I think soccer over the years keeps getting bigger and bigger.

Kornegay and Pullen said they expected the betting to increase as the knockout stage reaches its conclusion, even though the U.S. was eliminated in the round of 16 and Mexico, another betting favorite, didn't get out of the group stage.

I don't know if it will reach the height of past years, but we do anticipate the pickup in the next couple weeks, Kornegay said.

As for why the World Cup has overperformed expectations, Kornegay said the heavy media coverage has played a major role in getting American bettors excited.

The U.S. team playing well

enough to advance out of the group stage, Kornegay and Pullen said, was another factor.

It brings the casual fan in, the patriotic fan, Pullen said. If they know the U.S. is playing, then they're more likely to place a bet on another match. It's always good for the U.S. to be involved, but you have people who are dedicated followers of the sport and they're going to bet not only the World Cup, but after the World Cup is over they'll be back betting the Premier League, the German and Italian leagues.

Kornegay and Pullen said they haven't seen any kind of unusual bets that would garner headlines, but it's not like all bettors are limiting

their wagers to \$100, either.

One bettor, Pullen said, put six figures on Iran to cover the half goal it was getting against the U.S. The U.S. won that group-stage match 1-0. The business has changed so much, Pullen said. Years ago, a six-figure bet jumps off the page. Now, they're just routine. We've taken a lot of six-figure bets on some of these matches, and it will only increase as we go along.

The group stage was littered with notable upsets, which usually is good news for bookmakers because the betting public often puts its money on favorites. Professionals tend to seek bargains with underdogs.

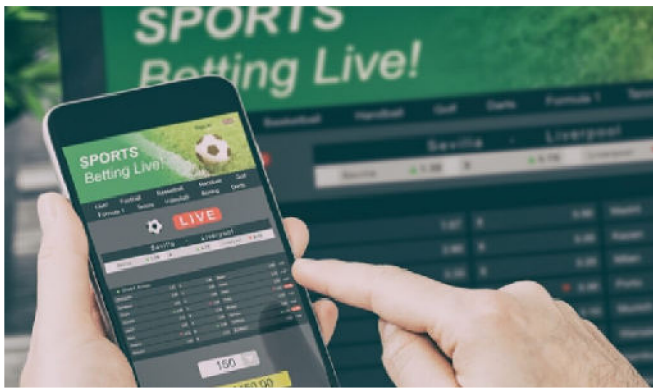
But the bookmakers also take a big-picture look at the tournament and not so much the individual matches.

You had some teams that were upset early, and that's usually not good for the handle as some of the popular teams, Kornegay said. But those teams still advanced. Like Argentina, one of the more popular teams, despite their first-round loss in group play, they advanced and look very good at this point.

Six of the eight quarterfinal teams have been decided. Spain plays Morocco and Portugal meets Switzerland on Tuesday to fill the other two slots. The final is Dec. 18.

Brazil is a +200 favorite to win the tournament, according to FanDuel, with France next at +490 and Argentina at +550.

No one's a bigger fan of the underdog than me, but when it comes down to it, Brazil's going to drive betting handle not South Korea, or Spain's going to drive handle, not necessarily Morocco, Pullen said. As the big teams progress and you get those mouth-watering quarterfinals, semifinals and the final matchup, that's going to drive handle more so than the upstart teams. - Source : Thewee

Delhi HC rules mother's choice is ultimate in termination of pregnancy

The Delhi High Court today ruled that ultimate choice in pregnancy cases involving fetal abnormalities is of the mother and emphasised that the medical boards in such cases must give qualitative reports.

The High Court said this in a ruling, while allowing a 26-year-old married woman's plea seeking medical termination of her fetus of over 33 weeks suffering from cerebral abnormalities.

The High Court said that the medical board ought to interact with the woman in a congenial manner, assess her physical and mental condition. It said that the opinion should briefly mention as to what are the risks for the woman in either continuing the pregnancy or undergoing termination. This right gives a woman the ultimate choice as to whether to give birth to the child that she has conceived

Agricultural Education Day observed by KVK

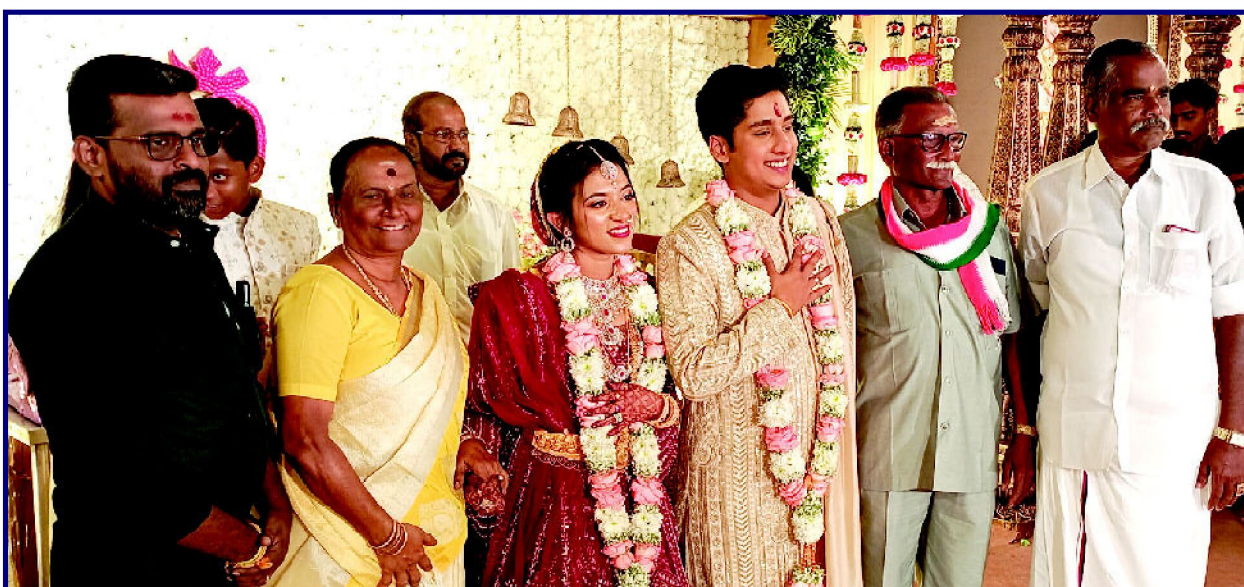
