## **Abandoned vehicles along** roadsides, citizens demand land for establishment of Scrap Yard in city

Port Blair, Nov 15: While the Union Government recently launched the vehicle scrapping policy to phase out unfit and polluting vehicles in an environment-fiendly manner, vehicles left abandoned in different parts of the city has prompted demand for earmarking a land to establish a Scrap Yard for such vehicles in the city. With the announcement of the India's 'scrappage announcement of the India's "scrappage policy", the urban population has amplified demand for setting up a scrap y ard in the city to get rid of such obsdete vehicles. "Vehicles left abandoned in the paid parking lots in the city stands testim ony to

gross misuse of public property by private parties. In the absence of proper monitoring

parking space. Shortage of space in parking lots forces genuine motorists to park their vehicles along roadsides giving cops a tough time to manage traffic in the city particularly during rush hours. It has now become the need of the hour to get rid of abandoned vehicles because it will free up space that is generally occupied by didrusty cars on loads. For years now, the authorities did not care about the problem that such abandoned vehicles causes inconverience to people," a resident of the Juniolichat. resident of the Junglighat.

"Many private and gov ernmentv ehicles can be seen abandoned in different parts of the city. Lack of proper maintenance has left the ventices redundant and the parties prefer to discard the vehicles along the roads. Now that the government has announced the scrappage policy, the UT Administration should identify a suitable land in the city to establish at Scrap Yard to get rid of such vehicles. The surpassing its operational period should be putto scrap, which will in turn generate some revenue for the government," said another.

A scrappage policy is a government funded programme to promote the replacement ofold vehicles with modern ones. The policy dictates that all automobiles over a certain age should be off the roads in the interest of y ears old are marked for scrapping - it doesn't matter if they run on diesel or petrol — if they fail an automated fitness test. These will be deregistered; the owner can choose to scrap them, but cannot use them on the road. The government has recently come out with rules and specifications on what kind of Automated Fitness Centres should come up and who can set them up. #### Repoll Cancelled

The Chief Election Commissioner S L Shakdher ordered the cancellation of the repoll in the Garhwal ordered the cancellation of the repoll in the Garhwal parliamentary constituency, scheduled for November 22. The order came in the wake of the Utar Pradesh government's plea that it would not be in a position to hold and peaceful re-poll because of the strike by jail employees and other threatened agitations. While Shakdher said he was satisfied by the arguments put forward by the state government, the Opposition candidate H N Bahuguna said that the CEC had been led up the garden path. The Election Commission had failed its constitutional duty and succumbed to the pressure of the ruling party, he alleged. Leaders of the Opposition parties will meet President N Sanjiva Reddy to protest against the order.

# SITHARAMAN TO MEET CMS, STATE FMS; DISCUSS REFORM-FOCUSED BUSINESS CLIMATE

Union Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman will on Monday meet all chief ministers and state finance

ministers to discuss ways to create a reform-focused business climate and further facilitate investments to help



In a tweet, the finance ministry said the virtual meeting on November 15 would be attended by Minister of State for Finance Pankaj Chaudhary and Bhagwat Karad, besides secretaries of Government of India line ministries, chief secretaries and finance secretaries of states.
"Discussion to be

centred on creating an enabling ecosystem for increased pro-active increased pro-active facilitation for investments besides topics of energizing growth, reforms, augmenting investments and creating a reform-focused business the ministry tweeted. The meeting comes in the backdrop of strong economic recovery post the two COVID waves, and push

by the central government to increase capital expenditure. The Centre believes that there is scope to capitalise on the positive sentiment of the private sector, with increasing demand, amid lower non-performing assets and banks willing to lend

Union Finance Secretary T.V. Somanathan had last week said that the focus of this interaction will be on state-level issues, opportunities and challenges, which will enable us to go to a higher trajectory of investment and growth.

"There is capital expenditure from the government side, and there is a positive sentiment from the private sector side, though perhaps not fully translated capital into actual investment in big

scale. Capital market activity indicates that a lot of investment is probably on the cards," Somanathan had said.

After a slowdown in economic growth due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the first quarter of the current fiscal has seen a pickup in economic activity. Indian economy contracted 7.3 per cent in the last financial year after a 4 per cent growth in 2019-20. In the April-June quarter

of the current fiscal, the economy grew 20.1 per cent. Besides, the first four months of FY 2021-22 have witnessed Foreign Direct Investment (EDI) of \$64 billion

The IMF and World Bank peg India's GDP growth at about 9.5 per centand 8.3 per cent, respectively, projecting India as one of the fastest-growing economies.

Justices D.Y. Chandrachud and Sury a Kant had ex pressed concern over the air pollution in Delhi on Saturday.

The court suggested a two-

day lockdownon Saturday and had expressed concern about reopening of schools. The Delhi government informed the Supreme Court "no phy sical classes would be held in schools this week and government officials would work from home. Priv ate offices have also been advised to work from home. Construction sites will be shut for threedays," NDTV reported.

During the hearing on Monday, plicitor General Tushar Mehta informed the court that the contribution to Delhi's pollution from controlution to Dehir's pollution from stubble burning by farmers in adjoining states was 10 per cent. 


