Port Blair, May 17

Hon'ble Lt Governor, A&N Islands and Vice Chairman, Islands Development Agency, Admiral D K Joshi, PVSM, AVSM, YSM, NM, VSM (Retd.) today led the Islanders in paying rich tributes to Great Andamanese who were killed in the Battle of Aberdeen fought on 17th May, 1859 between the British colonial rulers and the Great Andamanese.

A solemn function was organized by the Department of Art & Culture at the 'Memorial of Battle of Aberdeen' at Water Sports Complex wherein the Lt Governor placed wreath at the memorial to pay tribute to Great Andamanese. This was followed by paying of floral tributes by the Member of Parliament, Shri Kuldeep Rai Sharma, the Chief Secretary, A&N Administration, Shri Jitendra Narain, Adhyaksha ZPSA, Smti. Pramila Kumari, DGP, Shri Neeraj Thakur, Senior Officers of A&N Administration, Great Andamanese Tribe and general public.

Gurumurthy's leg was severed and had to be amputated immediately. Shri Gurumurthy who has been referred to mainland for urgent surgery to prevent gangrene has departed for mainland

along with his family members today. The health condition of Shri Nookaraj is reported to be stable. The medical evacuation of the patient was only possible with the intervention of the

Chairman of PMB (Chief Secretary, A & N Administration), Shri Jitendra Narain who directed a Commercial Flight to embark the patient despite inclement weather. Only with great efforts put together jointly by the medical and PMB staff, the patient could be evacuated today to mainland for

'Zero Tolerance against hoarding of Essential Supplies' Chief Secretary orders to conduct raids on black marketeers & hoarders and initiate stringent action

Multiple raids being conducted in city; 18 premises raided when the report last came in 14,000 kgs of Potatoes & 2530 kgs of Onions seized from five Godowns

Port Blair, May 17

In the wake of complaints received from general public, it has come to the notice of the Chief Secretary, A & N Administration, Shri Jitendra Narain that some wholesalers and retailers have started hoarding and black marketing of essential commodities like potato, tomato and onion etc. and are also overcharging consumers in Port Blair, indicating scarcity of commodities. Taking pro-active action on the issue, the Chief Secretary directed the Deputy Commissioner, South Andaman and SP (SA) to take stringent action by constituting a team comprising of Revenue Department, Police and Civil Supplies and conduct raids at various locations against illegal black marketing and hoarding by traders.

The Chief Secretary ordered that any premises belonging to anybody found with hoarded goods for black marketing, action should be taken upon them. The public have



been requested to bring to notice such black marketeers and hoarders because such rich and powerful black marketeers and hoarders who are profit seekers must not be allowed to exploit the poor people and so any powerful and rich hoarder and black marketer whether he is supplying to civilians or defence people should not be spared. Public have been requested to give information on such black marketeers and hoarders and action will be taken against them under the provisions of



the Prevention of Black Marketing and Maintenance of Supplies of Essential Commodities Act, 1980.

Accordingly, the Deputy Commissioner convened a meeting and constituted 12 teams of officials to conduct surprise raids at various places in the city to check the availability and price situation of essential commodities across the city. Besides, it was also emphasized by the Deputy Commissioner, South Andaman in the meeting to ensure that prices of the

essential supplies are not increased and they are available at fair prices to customers besides, creating awareness, so as to mitigate 'panic buying' of essential commodities. He further added that public interest is the paramount interest of the Administration and the traders indulging in black marketing and hoarding and are found cheating consumers shall not be spared.

On the direction of Chief Secretary, DC(SA) requested Directorate of Shipping Services personnel to share the details of civil and defence suppliers who are bringing essential commodities and where they are storing them, so as to check any future black marketing and hoardings. PMB has also been directed to keep track on hoarding and black marketing.

As part of the drive and adopting 'Zero Tolerance against Hoarding of Essential Supplies', 8 teams headed by Executive Magistrates went for the raid and raided 18

premises in different parts of the city. During the drive, the teams raided several warehouses and major wholesale markets and seized 14,000 kgs of Potatoes and 2530 kgs of Onions from five godowns. One godown had potatoes while other four had onions.

Raids are still being conducted over night by the Enforcement Teams consisting of senior Officers of Administration at various godowns, containers at harbours when the report last came in and is reported to continue till the morning of May 18. Traffic police have been directed to monitor the movement of trucks and cargo carrying essential commodities.

First Incredible India International Cruise Conference 2022 concludes Andaman has the potential to become another Singapore: Tourism Minister

Port Blair, May 17
Union Minister for Culture, Tourism and Ministry of Development of North Eastern Region (DoNER), Shri G. Kishan Reddy stressed upon the vast potential of cruise industry in the country. Addressing the 1st Incredible India International Cruise Conference (IIICC) in Mumbai on May 15, Shri Reddy invited domestic and international tourists to 'Come, Cruise in India.'

The number of beneficiaries administered precautionary dose of vaccine so far stood at 22682.

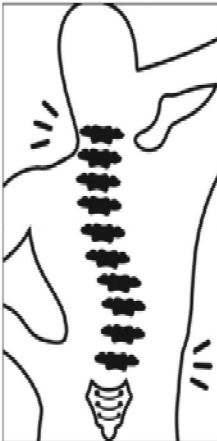
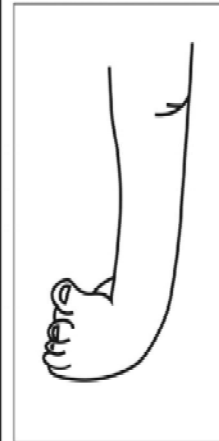
