

'Atmanirbhar India' will only be possible if our cities become productive: MoHUA Minister

Swachh Bharat Mission becomes a Jan-Andolan and will be launching SBM 2.0

New Delhi, Sept. 13 (PIB)

Minister of Housing and Urban Affairs and Petroleum and Natural Gas, Shri Hardeep Singh Puri said that an 'Atmanirbhar India' will only be possible if our cities become productive. The Minister while addressing the inaugural session of 'Connect Karo 2021 - Towards Equitable, Sustainable Indian Cities' event here today said that there can be no doubt that India's cities-enabled by citizen-centric infrastructure and transformational technology-will be the key to achieving the nation's development objectives. The five day (from 13-17th September, 2021) event is being organized by



the World Resources Institute (WRI) through video conferencing.

Shri Hardeep Singh Puri said that by 2030, almost 70% of the national GDP will come from our cities as rapid urbanisation facilitates efficiencies of agglomerations. The best-performing cities globally contribute five times more to national GDP than comparable Indian cities. We need to generate a similar density of economic activity from our cities to answer the calls of our Honourable Prime

Minister in becoming a five-trillion-dollar economy. He said that even as cities become the engines of our country's economy, it is equally important to address the infrastructure deficits that will arise from rapid urbanisation and complex migrant flows. By 2030, the urban population in India will almost double to 630 million. If we are to facilitate this level of growth, we will need to upgrade our urban infrastructure considerably and horrific impact of COVID-19 on our cities has made this even more significant, he said. Speaking on the adverse impact of growth of urbanization, Minister said that realising the

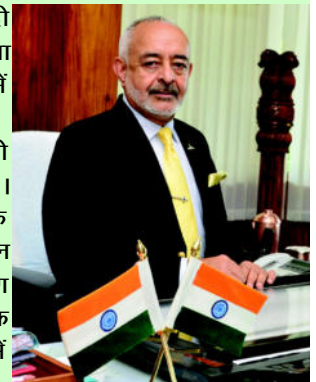

Adoption registration being done through CARINGS; illegal adoption will attract legal action

Port Blair, Sept. 13

The State Adoption Resource Agency (SARA) under Directorate of Social Welfare is functioning in these Islands as a unit to coordinate, monitor and develop the work of adoption program, disseminating

information and awareness on adoption process. The adoption registration is done through 'Child Adoption Resource Information and Guidance System' (CARINGS) which is a centralized software containing database of children and registration

of parents. Parents can also adopt through relative adoption or children of spouse from earlier marriage as step-parents adoption.

The parents willing to adopt can register themselves by logging in as PAPs (Prospective

Farmers' Corner- A Knowledge Hub

CARI Annapurna- A promising coconut variety

The variety was developed through selection from exotic accession IND 099 introduced by ICAR-CPCRI from Fiji as NiuLeka Dwarf and conserved at World Coconut Germplasm Centre at Sipighat farm, ICAR-CIARI, Port Blair. It is a dual-purpose variety suitable for copra making as well as for tender coconuts. The palms of this variety take about 4 years for first flowering. It is recommended by Group Meeting of All India Coordinated Research Projects on Palms during 2013 for cultivation in coconut growing tracts of Andaman and Nicobar Islands ecosystems. The palms are dwarf with compact canopy, erect leaf tip, stout stem with prominent but closely arranged leaf-scars over the stem. The palms are cross pollinated unlike other dwarf varieties. The fruits are green, large-sized, oval shaped, average fruit weight of over 1500g with copra content of over 240g having oil content of about 64%. The palms take about 65 months for first flowering after planting. The tender nut water content is 470ml. Unlike, most other dwarf varieties, this variety performs well under rainfed conditions also. The variety has not recorded any major pests under field conditions but moderately susceptible to scales and inflorescence moth. It recorded an average of 52 nuts per palm per year under rainfed conditions with copra yield of about 13kg per palm per year. The potential yield was estimated to be over 110 nuts per palm per year with copra yield of over 25kg per palm per year.

Benefit: Owing to the compact canopy it could be planted at closer spacing of 6 x 6 m also. Due to its compact canopy, dwarfness with strong and stout stem, it is considered as tolerant to heavy winds.

US Open : Daniil Medvedev stuns Novak Djokovic to win Maiden Grand Slam title

New York, Sept. 13

Daniil Medvedev of Russia lifted his first Grand Slam trophy after beating Novak Djokovic 6-4, 6-4, 6-4 in the US Open men's singles final at the Arthur Ashe Stadium in New York last night. The second seed Medvedev ended Djokovic's bid for a calendar slam and a 21st major by dominating from start to finish.

While Djokovic failed to become the third man after Don Budge and Rod Laver to sweep all four majors in the same year, Medvedev capped off a stellar US Open outing with a memorable win.

Medvedev broke in the first game of the contest and from there, he remained in control throughout.

Adoptive Parents) through www.cara.nic.in or CARINGS 3.1. Documents such as family photographs, birth certificate, income and address proof, medical certificate along with marriage/divorce certificate have to be uploaded on the portal. After registration, Home Study Report will be prepared by social worker of Adoption Agency after which parents will be shifted to a centralized seniority list. Parents will get reference of three legally free children on the basis of seniority and preference of child as entered on CARINGS portal.

It is for the information of general public that no illegal adoptions may be encouraged failing which legal action as per Section 32, 33, 34 of Juvenile Justice (Care & Protection of Children) Act, 2015 or 6 months imprisonment or a fine of Rs.10,000/- or both will be imposed. SARA appeals to the general public to report any cases of illegal adoptions.

As regards, adoption details/queries in the adoption processes to be carried out, the same can be obtained from the State Adoption Resource Agency (SARA) which is functional in the Directorate of Social Welfare (Room No. 308), Ph. 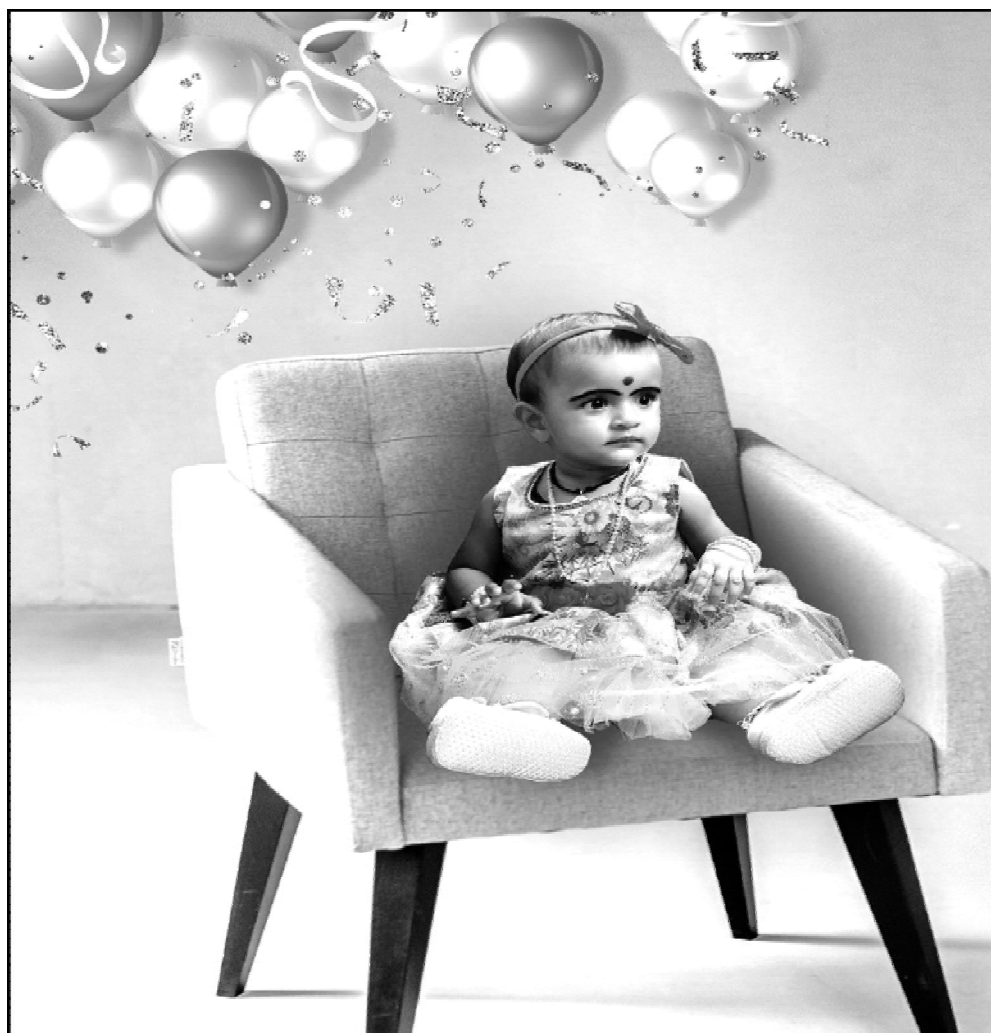

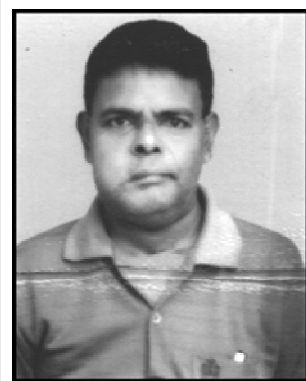

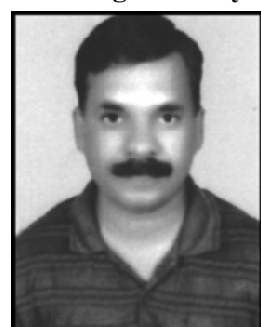
