

India achieves landmark milestone with over 75000 start-ups recognised so far

New Delhi, Aug. 3
India has crossed 75 thousand recognised Start Ups. Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT) has recognized more than 75 thousand startups which is a milestone coinciding with 75th

year of independence. Ministry of Commerce and Industry said in a tweet that the Indian startup ecosystem continues to be fueled by innovation, and enthusiasm, and entrepreneurial spirit. During the Independence Day

speech in 2015, Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi had envisioned a new India which taps on the entrepreneurial potential of its people. On 16th January 2016, the date which has now been declared as the National Startup Day, a program was

initiated to lay out an action plan to build a strong ecosystem for nurturing innovation and startups in the country. Six years later, the action plan has successfully turned India into the 3rd largest start up ecosystem. The initial

ten thousand startups were recognized in 808 days, whereas the latest ten thousand were achieved in only 156 days. Commerce Ministry said more than 80 Startups are getting recognized per day. (Source: india.gov.in)

India wins 2 gold and 2 silver medals on day 5 of CWG 2022

After Lawn Bowls historic gold, India clinches gold in men's table tennis, silver in badminton mixed and silver in weightlifting men's 96kg



New Delhi, Aug. 3
India won 4 medals on day 5 of Commonwealth Games 2022 at Birmingham. After historic gold of Lawn Bowls team in women's fours the men's table tennis team clinched the second gold medal of the day after beating Singapore 3-1 in the final. After that Weightlifter Vikas Thakur won a silver medal in the men's 96kg final and badminton mixed team won a silver medal after losing to Malaysia in the final. India's medal tally reaches 13 with 5 golds, 5 silvers and 3 bronze medals.

CWG 2022: Lovepreet Singh clinches bronze medal in men's 109kg category

Birmingham, Aug. 3
On Day 6 of the Commonwealth Games in Birmingham, Lovepreet Singh bagged a bronze medal in men's 109kg weightlifting while setting a national record in the clean and jerk round. Indian Women beat Canada 3-2 to qualify for the Hockey semi-final.



Tulika Maan has reached the final of judo women's 78kg category. She has defeated Sydnee Andrews of New Zealand in the semi-final. In Boxing, Nitu Singh enters the semi-finals by defeating Nicole Clyde in the quarter-final of women's 45kg-48kg.

Boxer Hussam Uddin Mohammed entered the semi-final of the featherweight category by defeating Tryagain Morning of Namibia. He is now assured of a bronze medal at least.

In the medals tally, India is placed at the 6th spot, with a total of 14 medals comprising five golds, five silvers and four bronzes.

Vaccination drive in A&N Islands 118603 beneficiaries administered precautionary dose of vaccine in Isles

Port Blair, Aug. 3
The vaccination drive is continuing smoothly in A&N Islands. As per data available, a total of 6,93,199 doses of vaccine have been administered to beneficiaries in the age group of 18 and above so far. Similarly, 23,913 beneficiaries have been vaccinated in the age group of 15 to 18 years. 26,926 beneficiaries in the age group of 12 to 14 years have been administered both doses of vaccine. The number of beneficiaries administered precautionary dose of vaccine so far stood at 118603. A total of 6752 eligible beneficiaries were vaccinated in A&N Islands today. 4025 beneficiaries were vaccinated in South Andaman District, out of which, 9 beneficiaries were in the age group of 12 to 14 years, 11 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18 to 44 years and the number of beneficiaries administered precautionary dose of vaccine stood at 3958. In North & Middle Andaman District 2294 beneficiaries were vaccinated and the number of beneficiaries administered precautionary dose of vaccine stood at 2284. In Nicobar District, 433 beneficiaries were vaccinated, out of which, 2 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18 to 44 and the number of beneficiaries administered precautionary dose of vaccine stood at 429, a press release from DHS said.

power, providing engineering, technical knowledge or other service for promotion of industrial growth, providing medical health or other allied service, setting up or development of tourism related facilities etc.
The quantum of loan is maximum 75% of the total project cost upto Rs. 10 lakh and 66% of the total project cost exceeding Rs. 10 lakh for purchase of machinery, construction of building etc. The promoters contribution is minimum 25% for the project cost upto Rs. 10 lakh and 34% for the project cost exceeding Rs. 10 lakh.
The rate of interest for different loan amount is fixed based on SIDBI's prime lending rate, accordingly rate of Interest calculated as per the range of finance is as under:

Upto Rs. 50,000	7.95%
Above Rs. 50,000/- to Rs. 2,00,000	8.95%

Interest rate is subject to change as per changes in the SIDBI Prime Lending Rate (PLR). A rebate of 1% is provided for prompt payment and 2% lower rate is admissible for industrial concerns engaged in tourism, horticulture, fisheries, food-processing and environment friendly projects like recycling of waste etc. A maximum repayment period of 10 years with a moratorium period of 6 months to 2 years depending on the project is provided.
