## Education Department invites application for seats reserved for students of A&N Islands in the mainland institutions for the academic session 2022-2023

#### (1) Background:

In view of limited avenues of higher education in the Islands every year the Govt. of India and various State Govts., Universities and Institutions allocate seats for the students of A&N Islands in various Profession, Technical and Non-technical courses.

#### (2) Courses:

Applications are invited for the below mentioned seats, which are likely to be received for the students of A&N Islands in 2022-23.

#### (3) <u>Distribution Criteria</u>:

The Criteria to be followed for allotment of seats to various categories as fixed by the Government of India is as follows:-

Category-I	Tribals	20%
Category-II	Deputationist and Central Government Employees with transfer liability to serve outside the Union Territory provided the candidates in this category have studied the last two years in the islands and passed the qualifying examination from a school in the Islands.	10%
Category-III	Settlers who were settled prior to 1942 and those who were settled under various rehabilitation schemes introduced after re-occupation of the Islands.	50%

Category-V	General merit quota open to all the residents of A&N Islands irrespective of any classification. This will be subject to condition that the candidates in this category have studied the last two years in the Islands and passed the qualifying examination from a school in the islands.	Unutilized seats of Categories I, II, III & IV above.

PwD: 5% seats are reserved for PwD candidates on interlocking reservation basis i.e. horizontal reservation cuts across vertical reservation (various categories of students in A & N Islands). Since the PwD candidates have to be placed in the appropriate category viz. Category-I, Category-II, Category-III A, Category-III B and Category-IV.

## (4) Applicants are requested to go through the following <u>General Instructions</u> for filling application for the mentioned courses:

- (i) The ONLINE application will be accepted from 06/08/2022 to 26/08/2022 upto 5.00 pm.
- (ii) The candidates should submit their application ONLINE at http://collegeadmission.andaman.gov.in.
- (iii) The Candidates those who have passed +2 exam from the National Institute of Open Schooling (NIOS) or Other State Board are requested that before filing their ONLINE application, they may approach the Assistant Secretary (Hr. Edn.), A & N Administration, Secretariat, Port Blair for conversion of marks at par with CBSE.
- (iv) The candidates MUST bring the acknowledgment slip (with the seal of CSC if applied through CSC), Original Documents with self-attested photocopy of documents during the counselling session of their opted courses:

- (v) The candidates should provide all the mandatory details in the online portal with utmost care failing which the application will not be accepted by the online website.
- (vi) Candidates while filling ONLINE application should enter the marks of five subjects only according to the eligibility criteria of each course applied for.
- (vii) While filing the ONLINE application for BDS, BAMS, BHMS, MBBS & BAMS (Malayalee Origin) and B.Sc. B.Ed courses, if the result of the respective entrance exam is not declared, the candidate should provide the Application No./ Roll No. of NEET UG-2022 /CEE-2022 by selecting the option "Yes Result Awaited" in order to consider their candidature for these courses.
- (viii) All the candidates should have appeared and qualified National Eligibility cum Entrance Test-UG (NEET-UG)-2022 being conducted by National Testing Agency for allotment of Central Pool BDS, BAMS and BHMS including MBBS & BAMS (Malayalee Origin) seats reserved for the students of A&N Islands if any allocated by the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare/Ministry of AYUSH/Govt. of Kerala. Further, they are requested to submit the score card of NEET UG-2022 to the Development-IV Section (D-IV Section) of Secretariat within 3 days after declaration of result.
- (ix) The Malayalee Origin candidates, whose parent have settled in A & N Islands permanently can apply for the above seats, provided such candidates have a minimum of 10 years continuous education in these Islands. Applicants are required to submit online application and upload the copies of Xth and XIIth class Pass Certificates, Statement of marks, Birth Certificates, Migration Certificates, Duration Certificate and the certificate to the effect that he/she is of Malayalee Origin settled in these Islands, from the Revenue Authority not below the rank of Tehsildar, certificate of 10 years continuous education in these Islands from the Head of Institutions where the candidates studied for last 10 years, copy of NEET UG-2022 score card and the local certificate from the Revenue Authority.
- (x) The candidates those who are interested for allotment of B.Sc. B.Ed seats reserved at RIE, Bhubaneswar are requested to submit the copy of score card of Common Entrance Examination-2022 (CEE-2022) conducted/to be conducted by Regional Institute of Education to the Development-IV Section (D-IV Section), Secretariat within 3 days after declaration of result.
- (xi) The Merit lists will be prepared by the Administration category-wise based on the marks/merit obtained by the candidates in NEET-2022/CEE-2022/+2 qualifying exam/Degree against the allocation of seats reserved by the Govt. of India/ State Govts.
- (xii) The provisional merit lists of eligible candidates will be displayed on the Notice Board of Secretariat as well in the website of A & N Administration for information of candidates for inviting claims and objections, if any, within a specified period which will be notified in due course through All India Radio, The Daily Telegram as well as in the website of A & N Administration. The claim and objection of the candidate under his/her signature should contain the registration number of his/her application, name of course with the page number and serial number of the provisional merit list against which the claim and objection is sought for is required to be submitted to the Development- IV Section, Secretariat within the notified period of scrutiny.
- (xiii) The Administration after carefully considering all the claim and objections shall display the course-wise final merit lists in the Notice Board of Secretariat as well as in the website of A & N Administration. Intimation to this effect will be notified in the Daily Telegram/ AIR/ Website of A & N Administration.
- (xiv) Once the final merit lists are finalized, candidates shall be informed the date scheduled for counselling through The Daily Telegram/ AIR/ Website of A & N Administration. No individual communication to this effect will be given to any candidate in any category, in any manner. Candidates should attend for counselling in person along with their original certificates and other testimonials at their own cost.
- (xv) The candidates shall be called for counselling on a fixed date, which shall be notified through AIR, Port Blair and in The Daily Telegram, as well as in the website of A & N Administration. No individual communication shall be sent regarding date of counselling.
- (xvi) If any seat is surrendered by candidates of the respective category, the seat will be allotted to the candidates of said category based of final merit list of the respective category. Whereas, left-out seat of Category–I, II, III & IV will be allotted to the candidate stand in the final merit list of General Category (Category- V) on merit.
- (xvii) Nomination once accepted will be treated as final. Similarly, no request will be entertained for change of Seat/Institution/College. The Institution once selected by the candidate at the time of counselling will be final.
- (xviii) Candidate seeking allotment in Professional/ Technical/ Non- Technical courses including Malayalee Origin and B. Ed. Bhopal seats has to execute an agreement bond while the seat is being allotted on merit basis according to their eligibility as has been the practice in the previous years.

- (xix) On allotment of seats, it will be the responsibility of the candidates to make their own arrangement to reach the allotted Institutions and to complete the formalities of admission in time. The Administration will not responsible or liable in this case, in any manner.
- (xx) The Administration will not be responsible, in case any candidate is rejected by any mainland Institution/College on account of change in eligibility criteria/requirements/ policy/late reporting to the institution where seat is allotted by the Administration.
- (xxi) Candidates allotted with Degree level Engineering or Architecture seat in National Institute of Technology (NIT) under Home State Quota shall not be eligible for Administration seats i.e. they will be eligible for any one seat either NIT Home State Quota or Administration seat.
- (xxii) The seats will be finally allotted to the eligible candidates only after the receipt of confirmation to UT Administration from the Govt. of India/State Govts/ concerned Institutions.
- (xxiii) Any candidates of this UT Islands once allotted and accepted any of the seats through counselling by A & N Administration or ONLINE by JOSAA/CSAB NEUT, but not utilized/continued the course for any of the reason thereof will not be eligible for allotment of any other seat further from Administration quota.
- (XXIV) Further details in this regard, if any, can be obtained from the Assistant Secretary (Hr. Edn.) either in person or **over telephone No. 03192-231023**.

#### (5) ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR THE COURSES:

#### (a) B.D.S, BAMS & BHMS

Candidates should have appeared and qualified National Eligibility cum Entrance Test-UG (NEET-UG)-2022 for allotment of Central Pool BDS, BAMS & BHMS seats reserved for the students of A&N Islands. The said seats under Central Pool quota will be allotted category-wise to only those candidates who qualify in NEET-UG-2022 as per the Qualifying criteria described in the Information Bulletin of NEET-UG 2022 will be considered for admission to BDS, BAMS & BHMS Course. The NEET-UG 2022 score card copy is to be submitted to the Development-IV Section (D-IV) of Secretariat after declaration of result by National Testing Agency.

#### (b) Hotel Management

For the above course, the candidates should have passed the 10+2 stage examination or equivalent examination in any stream with English as a compulsory subject with at least 50% marks in aggregate, relaxable upto 5% in case of ST candidates. Candidate should not be more than 25 years of age as on 01/07/2022, relaxable upto 28 years for ST candidates.

#### (c) Printing Technology/ Photography

Candidates must have passed 10th Std/ SSC examination with at least 35% marks at qualifying examination and candidate should not be born after 01.07.2007.

#### (d) (i) Diploma - 1 (Textile Process and Cinematography)

XII<sup>th</sup> pass (AISSCE) with 50% marks in Maths separately and 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry and Maths put together.

#### (ii) Diploma - 2 (Diploma Pharmacy)

XIIth Passed (AISSCE) with 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry and Biology (aggregate).

## (iii) Diploma - 3 (Production, Electronics & Communication, Man-made Fibre Technology, Electronics & Telecommunication and Architecture)

Xth pass with 50% marks in Maths and 50% marks in General Science and Maths put together on the basis of marks obtained/ Grade Points.

#### (e) B.Sc. B.Ed.

For B.Sc B.Ed course, the candidates should have registered as well as appeared in the Common Entrance Exam-2022 (CEE-2022) conducted by Regional Institute of Education and should have passed in +2 Science stream with minimum 50% marks in aggregate, relaxable upto 5% in case of ST candidates. The candidates should have either the subject combination of (a) Maths, Physics and Chemistry or (b) Biology, Physics and Chemistry at +2 level candidates should have passed +2 Examinations in science stream. Candidates who have passed +2 exams before 2020 will not be considered for admission. The copy of score card of CEE-2022 being conducted by Regional Institute of Education is to be submitted in the Development-IV Section (D-IV Section), Secretariat after declaration of result.

#### (f) BL Integrated Course

For the above course, the Candidates should have passed the qualifying examination in (10+2) courses for schooling and have secured not less than 45% marks in the aggregate in case of General candidates (40% in case of ST candidates). Candidate should not have completed 20 years age as on 01/07/2022 (3 years relaxation for ST candidates).

#### (g) General Nursing (Female)

- (i) The eligibility requirement in Bangalore, the candidate must be 10+2 passed preferably science (PCB) and English with aggregate of 40% (for ST 35%). Arts and Commerce students are also eligible for the course. The candidate should have completed 17 years as on 01.09.2022 and not exceed 35 years.
- (ii) The eligibility requirement in Kolkata, the candidate should have passed 10+2 examination with 40% marks in aggregate and 40% marks in English. Candidate age must be in between 17 years-35 years as on 31.12.2022.
- (iii) The eligibility requirement in Kerala, candidates for admission to the course should have passed the Plus-2/equivalent examination conducted by the Government of Kerala or by any of the Universities in Kerala with Physics, Chemistry and Biology as optional subjects and English with 40% aggregate marks. 10+2, ANM course from the schools recognized by INC is also eligible for admission. Candidate should have completed the age of 17 years on 31.12.2022 and should not be above the age of 35 years on the date. There is no age bar for ANM candidates.

#### (h) B.Sc. (Nursing) (Female unmarried)

- (i) Kolkata Candidates should have passed 10+2 examination from a recognized board, and must have aggregate 45% marks in the subjects Physics, Chemistry & Biology (PCB) in case of General Candidate (40% in case of ST candidates). The minimum age of the candidates should be completed 17 years as on 31/12/2022 and maximum age limit is 35 years.
- (ii) Kerala Candidates should have passed 10+2 examination from a recognized board with 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English (PCBE) put together. In case of ST candidate, 40% aggregate marks in PCBE. Candidate should have completed 17 years of age as on 31/12/2022.

## (i) Para Medical Courses (Medical Lab Technology, Radiological Assistant, Ophthalmic Assistant, Dental Mechanic and Diploma Pharmacy)

The Candidates who proposes for any of the above course should have passed the  $\pm 2/$ Higher Secondary/Pre-degree or equivalent examination with Physics, Chemistry and Biology as optional subjects for admission provided that they have secured an aggregate of 40% marks in optional subjects. Relaxation of 5% marks will be allowed to candidate of ST. Applicant should be within the age of 17 to 35 years as on 31.12.2022.

#### (j) B.Sc (Agriculture)

The candidates proposes for the above course should have passed in the AISSCE (10+2) with 55% aggregate in any of the combination of four subjects:-

- (i) Maths, Physics, Chemistry, Biology
- (ii) Physics, Chemistry, Botany, Zoology
- (iii) Physics, Chemistry, Biology with any one of the fourth (elective) subject viz., Biotechnology/Microbiology/Biochemistry/Computer Science/Home Science/Agriculture/Horticulture/Environmental Science.

For ST candidates, a pass in qualifying examination with four required subjects.

**NB:-** Candidates should not have completed the age of 21 years as on 01.07.2022. For ST candidates, there is no age limit.

#### (k) B.Sc (Horticulture)

The candidates proposes for the above course should have passed in the AISSCE (10+2) with 55% aggregate in any of the combination of four subjects:-

- (i) Maths, Physics, Chemistry, Biology
- (ii) Physics, Chemistry, Botany, Zoology
- (iii) Physics, Chemistry, Biology with any one of the fourth (elective) subject viz., Biotechnology/Microbiology/Biochemistry/Computer Science/Home Science/Agriculture/Horticulture/Environmental Science.

For ST candidates, a pass in qualifying examination with four required subjects

**NB:-** Candidates should not have completed the age of 21 years as on 01.07.2022. For ST candidates, there is no age limit.

#### (i) **B.F.Sc.**

The candidates should have passed in the Higher Secondary Course in 10+2 (State Board / CBSE / any other examination recognized as equivalent thereto) and fulfilling the following requirements are eligible:

#### (m) B.Ed

- (i) The candidates should have passed B.A. /B. Sc./M.Com examination with 50% aggregate from a recognized University and has offered subject relating to school education at the first or second degree level.
- (ii) Equal preference will be given to the candidates who have acquired degree from the colleges of A&N Islands as well as at Mainland subject to the condition that the candidates are belong to one of the five categories laid down in the Govt. of India, Ministry of Home Affairs order No. U-14040/5/96/ANL dated 30/5/1996.
- (iii) The Administration will not be responsible, in case any candidature is rejected by the host Institute on account of change of eligibility criteria /requirement or policy or late reporting to the Institution.
- (iv) The candidate who has already been considered for B. Ed course in Govt. Tagore College of Education, Port Blair will not be nominated for B. Ed course in Institute of Advanced Study in Education (Govt. College of Education), Bhopal.

#### (n) MBBS & BAMS (Malayalee Origin)

Candidates who have passed Higher Secondary examination of the Board of Higher Secondary Education, Kerala, or examinations recognised equivalent thereto, with 50% marks in Biology/Biotechnology separately, and 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry and Biology/Biotechnology put together, are eligible. Only those candidates who qualify in NEET-UG-2022 as per the Qualifying criteria described in the Information Bulletin of NEET-UG-2022 will be considered for admission to MBBS & BAMS Course (Malayalee Origin).

#### (o) B.Sc. Agriculture (Malayalee Origin)

Candidates, who have passed pre-degree or any other examination recognized by the Universities in Kerala State as equivalent thereto with 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry and Biology put together, are eligible.

- NB:- 1. Eligibility criteria for some courses as defined above are based on the last year allocation (2021-22) the same is subject to change as per revised criteria of the Institutions/Colleges, if any.
  - 2. The marks obtained by the student in +2 practical examination will not be counted while preparing Merit list for allotment of reserved seats in professional, technical and non-technical courses on the mainland institutions/colleges.
