The Department has urged all vehicle owners to get their vehicles tested for emission levels by Jan 11, 2022 and carry valid PUC Certificates while plying on roads.

Since the Transport Department announced that motorists plying without following pollution norms shall be penalized with fine up to Rs.10,000 as per section 190(2) of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988, people started making beepings at the Pollution Testing Centres in the city. A PUC test involves checking for air pollutants emitted by vehicles, such as carbon monoxide and hydrocarbons. The test costs between Rs 60 and Rs 100. The validity of the certificate is one year for BS IV vehicles and three months for others. Omicron effect: Centre issues revised COVID-19 clinical management guidelines for adults

Port Blair, Dec 26: With concerns rising over cases of Omicron variant, the Centre of Friday issued revised clinical management guidelines of COVID-19 in adult patients. According to the clinical guidance issued by the Health Ministry, Remdesivir has been asked to be used in patients with moderate to severe Covid-19 and those with no renal or hepatic dysfunction within 10 days of onset of any symptom. "Tocilizumab drug may be considered for use in the presence of severe disease (preferably within 24 to 48 hours of onset of severe disease/CU admission), according to the guidelines. Tocilizumab can be used in case of significantly raised inflammatory markers (CRP &/or IL-6), condition not improving despite use of steroids and no active bacterial/fungal/liberular infection," the guidelines said warning against of any symptom. 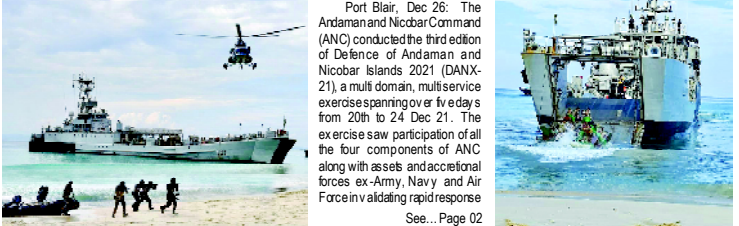

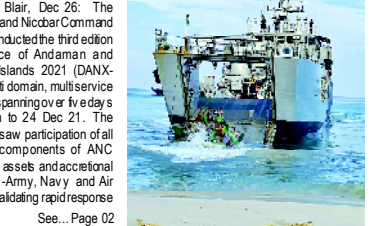

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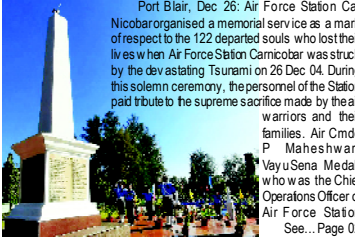

Find the plot

An investigation by this paper has shed light on several land transactions in the city of Ayodhya that raise grave questions of propriety and conflict of interest. By all accounts, land in the city has become a more attractive investment proposition after the Supreme Court 2019 verdict, and private buyers, many with links to the officialdom, have rushed in, in anticipation of windfall gains. The transactions reported in this paper involve members of the legislative assembly, and relatives of officials such as the divisional commissioner, sub-divisional magistrate, and revenue officials. Of course, buying property anticipating gains is smart consumer behaviour but a clear and disturbing pattern has emerged. At least four buyers are directly related to officials probing the seller for alleged irregularities in land transfer from Dalit residents. In other cases, the buyers are relatives of officials whose job is to authenticate these transactions.

At the heart of the issue is the nearly 21 bighas (about 52,000 sq m) of land that was acquired from Dalits in 1992, in what appears to be a violation of norms. According to the rules in the state, unless the transaction is approved by the district magistrate, the sale of agricultural land of Dalits to non-Dalits is not permitted. The Maharshi Ramayan Vidyapeeth Trust (MRTV), which holds the land, acquired it from the Dalit villagers through a Dalit employee of the trust, who subsequently donated the land to the trust in June 1996 through an unregistered donation deed. In 2019, when the trust began selling the land, one of the original sellers complained, raising questions on the legality of earlier transactions. Thereafter, a committee was set up to investigate the matter. But even as various officials accepted the committee's recommendations on taking action against the trust, relatives of officials began to purchase land from the entity under the scanner. The initial land transaction was problematic, and the subsequent set of transactions have raised even more troubling questions.

Following The Indian Express investigation, the Uttar Pradesh government has announced a probe. The government must ensure that the investigation is fair and transparent, and seen to be so too, especially since the parties concerned are government officials. However, it needs to be pointed out that such shadowy land transactions are not the exception. Land markets in India are characterised by information asymmetry and there have been many instances of the abuse of the state's discretionary power. The revelations in Ayodhya underline the need for more stringent rules of disclosure, especially by all government officials, when land is being acquired by a trust blessed by the state or private players. This will tighten the regulatory architecture, and ensure greater transparency in the process of land acquisition.

GUJARAT TOPS, UP SHOWS 'INCREMENTAL GROWTH' IN GOOD GOVERNANCE INDEX 2021

New Delhi, 26th Dec, 2021: Gujarat has topped the composite ranking in the Good Governance Index (GGI), followed by Maharashtra and Goa while Uttar Pradesh showed an incremental growth of 8.9 percent in the indicators launched by Union Home Minister Amit Shah on the occasion of the Good Governance Day on Saturday (December 25, 2021).

As many as 20 states have improved their composite GGI scores in 2021, according to the index. Gujarat topped the composite ranking in the 58 indicators index followed by Maharashtra and Goa. Uttar Pradesh has registered an 8.9 per cent improvement in the GGI indicators in the period 2019 to 2021 which Jammu and Kashmir registered an improvement of 3.7 per cent in the same period, it said.

Delhi has topped the union territories category composite ranking. Shah released the GGI 2021 prepared by the Department of Administration Reforms and Public Grievances (DARPG) on Good Governance Day at Vigyan Bhawan here. On this occasion, Minister of State for Personnel Jitendra Singh said that the GGI would help assess the status of governance in states and union territories.

The objectives of GGI are to provide quantifiable data to compare

the state of governance in all states and union territories, enable them to formulate and implement suitable strategies for improving governance and shift to result-oriented approaches and administration.

December 25 is observed as the good governance day to commemorate the birth anniversary of former prime minister Atal Bihari Vajpayee. The GGI-

some time depending on how they are placed on the queue. I was handed the list by the person who got his two-wheeler checked before me. I will pass it on to the next person," said a resident of Janglithat. I came at the testing centre at Janglithat yesterday and all slots were filled. I returned today, they tested my two-wheeler by 4 pm after waiting in the queue since 10 am. At the testing centre here, arguments and scuffle between motorists be witnessed despite the first come first served policy in place. This is because people don't wish to pay such hefty fine for violation of pollution norms, said another. "Around 8828 vehicles were registered in these islands in 2015-16 which includes 6298 two-wheelers, 246 three-wheelers, 1895 LMVs, 35 buses, 92 trucks and 262 other motor vehicles. The numbers further escalated in 2016-17 with registration of 10430 vehicles (7304 two-wheelers, 232 autos, 2763 LMVs, 14 buses, 99

trucks and 18 others), while in 2017-18, the automobile fleet grew by 9580 with the registration of 6130 new two-wheelers, 299 autos, 3003 LMVs, 13 buses, 105 trucks and 303 other vehicles. The number of registered vehicles has increased rapidly with addition of around 9000 vehicles every year. In view of the situation, the Transport Department should have accorded some time to motorists before announcing a crackdown on motorists violating pollution norms. There are just three pollution testing centres in the city to cater to such huge numbers of vehicles. To prevent chaos the testing centres, the Transport Department should accord a time-limit to vehicle owners to get their vehicles tested for emissions before enforcing the norm," said some vehicle owners.

During RAT conducted on 198 passengers bound for North & Middle Andaman at Farranguri no positive case has been detected. At Mohanpur Bus Terminus, test was conducted on 117 passengers and all were found negative. At Phoenix Bay Jetty, 142 passengers were tested with RAT and all were found negative. At Helipad, test was conducted on 14 passengers and all were found negative.

Telecom dept launches PM-WANI Wi-Fi access scheme in isles

Wifi hotspots to be set up across isles

As part of Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav celebrations, the Department of Telecommunication, A&N Islands has launched PM-WANI Wi-Fi access scheme in the Andaman and Nicobar Islands for the proliferation of public Wi-Fi networks across the islands. The initiative aims to elevate wireless internet connectivity in the islands. This would entail a complete framework involving multiple elements Public Data Office (PDO), Public Data Office Aggregators and App providers. No license, no registration, and no fee would be applicable for the PDOs, which would be small shops or even Common Service Centers," said Mr. KP Mohan, Dy. Director General, DoT, A&N Islands while addressing media persons at Kendriy Sadan, Ranchi Basti, Lamballine on Friday. After the launch of this scheme, internet connectivity will be provided through Public Data Offices (PDOs), which will boost the "ease of doing" business as the scheme would enable small shopkeepers to provide Wi-Fi services to the mobile users. Mr. Atul Kumar Kereliya, Director

Telecom and Mr. Raja Ram Mohan, CGM BSNL were also present on the occasion. The potential user who wants to access Broadband through public Wi-Fi will need to download the relevant App, get authenticated and, thereafter, access Broadband at any public Wi-Fi Hotspot. When the user reaches a public Wi-Fi Hotspots, the App on the mobile phone will show various available networks. The users can then choose the public Wi-Fi network of choice, pay an amount either online or through voucher and use the network till the balance is exhausted. With the Public Wi-Fi Broadband, availability of internet, the user experience and quality of service for Broadband will improve significantly and provide a host of benefits. This service will be especially useful in rural areas where Public Wi-Fi Hotspots are also being created under BharatNet and bridge the digital divide in the country. Proliferation of Public Wi-Fi Hotspots will lead to increased employment for small and micro entrepreneurs, and provide them with an additional source of income. The telecom and internet service providers will also benefit due to the share of bandwidth to PDOs, said the Dy. Director General, DoT. Reliance JIO has been awarded a USOF funded project at the cost of Rs 125.9 Cr for covering uncovered villages and seamless mobile coverage in the NH-4 with 4G Technology by installing 128 towers in 18 months' time. Presently, in Andaman and Nicobar Islands, three Telecom service operators BSNL, Airtel and Vodafone are operating while RIL is about to launch services. The total wireless subscriber base in the islands is 33,029 while wireless subscribers are 6,10,757. The total broadband subscribers are 3,35,293. The Dy. DG further informed that a USOF funded project called BharatNet project costing about Rs 31.3 Cr for establishing high speed broadband connectivity between Block Headquarters and Gram Panchayats is being executed by BSNL. The BharatNet project will be executed in 70 Gram Panchayats and 40 Tribal Council. Out of this, the service for 25 Gram Panchayat is ready.

The decision of precaution dose will strengthen confidence of healthcare and frontline workers. The Prime Minister also announced that option of precaution dose will be available for senior citizens above 60 years of age with co-morbidities on the advice of their doctors from 10th January, 2022.

The Prime Minister said that the global experience of fighting the pandemic has told that following all guidelines is the biggest weapons in the fight against Corona. Second weapon is vaccination.

What is a booster shot? A booster shot is a normal part of the existing covid vaccination programme. It is just an extra dose of a vaccine after the (original or

third) covid vaccine dose is called booster shot world-wide. This has been done in the light of the amount of time that the frontline workers and health care workers spend in the service of Covid patients. What is 'precaution dose'? For now, there is no exact definition for 'precaution dose'. But as per the advisories given by the technical team on Covid vaccination, the third dose of covid vaccine should be of a vaccine based on a platform different from that of the first two doses.

In India, the people who come under precaution dose category are the ones who have got their two doses of vaccine a 5 to 6 months

The third dose of vaccine, called the booster shot was recommended by the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention that moderately to severely immunocompromised individuals who received the two-dose series of either Pfizer or Moderna get a third dose of the vaccine 28 days after receiving their second dose. With the original dose, the immune system will be able to produce antibodies against the virus and a booster shot is given to remind the body's immune system about the virus it needs to defend against. This third shot, given after a month's interval improves or gives the immune system a boost.

DELHI GOVT TO ASK AGGREGATORS TO COMPLETELY SWITCH TO ELECTRIC VEHICLES

The Delhi government is going to ask e-commerce companies, food delivery services and cab aggregators to completely switch to electric vehicles as it aims to increase the EV share in total vehicle sales to 25 percent by 2024 to check air pollution, according to officials.

It is also going to ask dealers and petrol pumps to not give fuel to vehicles without a pollution-under-check (PUC) certificate.

Vehicle emissions account for around 40 percent of the city's air pollution.

Asked if a deadline will be given to aggregators to switch to EVs, a senior official in the transport department said, "It will be done in a phased manner. We will soon publish the draft guidelines."

Apart from ramping up the electric charging infrastructure, the transport department is likely to initiate discussion on having a battery swapping infrastructure in private space.

Only Flipkart (by 2030) and FedEx (by 2040) have established worldwide targets for converting their last-mile delivery fleets to electric vehicles, while DHL has set a 60 percent electrification target for its fleet.

In October, the city government launched a massive drive to check PUC certificates and deployed around 500 teams at petrol pumps for this purpose.

Under Section 190(2) of the Motor Vehicle Act, 1933, vehicle owners not having a valid PUC can be fined up to Rs 10,000, or imprisoned for up to six months or both.

The owners are required to get their vehicles tested to ascertain if they meet emission standards for pollutants such as carbon monoxide, nitrous oxides, carbon dioxide.

There are around 1,000 authorised pollution checking centres set up at petrol pumps and workshops in the city.

Also, in compliance with the National Green Tribunal's directions, the Delhi government will deregister all diesel vehicles which will complete 10 years on January 1, 2022 and issue a no-object certificate (NOC) so that they can be re-registered in other places.

However, no NOC will be issued for diesel vehicles that have completed 15 years or more on the date of applying for it, according to an order issued earlier this month.

Delhi is the most polluted capital in the world and one of the fastest expanding cities in terms of population, according to Swiss air technology company, IQAir.

According to a study conducted by the Automotive Research Association of India and The Energy and Resources Institute in 2018, vehicles contribute to about 40 percent of PM 2.5 emissions in Delhi.



"The government is going to take two major steps to check vehicular pollution - we will ask all aggregators including Zomato, Swiggy, Ola, Uber, etc. to completely switch to electric vehicles. These services account for 30 percent of the registered vehicles in Delhi," an official told PTI.

"We are also considering directing dealers and petrol pumps not to supply fuel to vehicles without a (valid) PUC certificate," he said. Directions under the Environment (Protection) Act in this regard are expedited

James Webb launch: Ariane-5 takes world's most-advanced telescope to space

Humanity is set to upgrade its eyes in outer space, with the launch of the James Webb Space Telescope—the most advanced space telescope ever built and one of the flagship scientific missions of the 21st century. If you were impressed by the images taken by Hubble—which include the iconic "Eye of God" photo—Webb, 100 times more powerful, will take mankind's sight to space another level. At for the handy sum of \$10 billion.

From Kourou in French Guiana, the European Space Agency had the honour of launching the JWST on board the Ariane-5 rocket. At around 17:50 IST, the Ariane-5 rocket took off. Moving at nearly 0.6 km/s, the rocket reached

84 km before separating its solid rocket boosters. Over three minutes after launch, the fairing was shed as the rocket left Earth's atmosphere. With a million miles to go before it reaches its final orbit, the telescope's deployment includes dozens of sequences from the deployment of its solar array after the rocket's upper stage separates to a mid-course correction burn and a host of manoeuvres. Webb has 344 single-point-of-failure—if any one of these components fails, it would severely impact the telescope's mission.

The telescope weighs 6,200 kg and has a lifetime of ten years. This is much shorter than that of Hubble, which continues to operate over 30 years after its

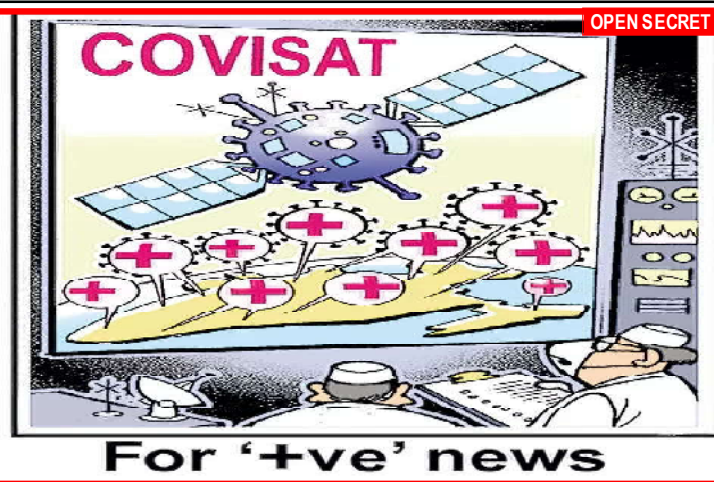
launch (thanks to regular maintenance by astronauts). But the JWST will be much further out into space than Hubble, with a perch at Lagrangian point 2 (L2), a location where both the Earth and Sun's gravity cancel each other out, allowing it to orbit the sun with the Earth behind it at all times. The shorter lifespan is due to the telescope's ability to study infrared and ultraviolet light, putting it at constant exposure to dangerous light from the sun, reducing its lifespan.

To protect itself, the telescope will deploy a sunshield the size of a tennis field that will guard it from the sun. Webb will use a 6.5-m-wide golden mirror to study the cosmos, with a capability of detecting light emitted from the first stars to be born

in the universe, over 13.5 billion years ago. "They will be just little red specks," NASA senior project scientist and Nobel Prize winner John Mather told the BBC.

The telescope will study every phase of cosmic history, from the origin of the first stars to studying distant worlds in our solar system, searching for habitable exoplanets that could harbour liquid water.

Webb is an international collaboration between NASA and its partners, ESA (European Space Agency) and the Canadian Space Agency. Thousands of engineers and hundreds of scientists worked to make Webb a reality, along with over 300 universities, organizations, and companies from 29 U.S. states and 14 countries.
