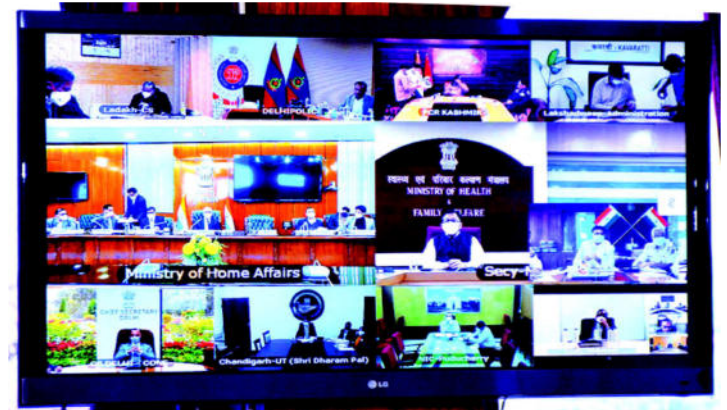
Mashaal from the Eternal Flame at the National War Memorial. He had also lit four flames that were to traverse along different directions. During the Homage

The Department of Agriculture is providing fertilizer @20% cost subsidy and 100% transport subsidy to the farmers under UT Plan Scheme. The fertilizer is being sold from 48 Sub-Depots of Department of Agriculture situated in different locations. It is to mention that during September, 2020, 749.97 MT of Neem Coated Urea and during August, 2021, 1489.80 MT of Di Ammonium Phosphate (DAP) were procured by



the Department and were sold to the farmers. Under the supervision and guidance of the Chief Secretary, A&N Administration and effort of Secretary

(Agriculture) and officers of Agriculture Department, the consignment of 700.0 MT of Murate of Potash (MOP) procured by the Department has now

Pradhan Mantri Kisan Samman Nidhi scheme 17376 farmers of A & N Islands registered in the ambitious scheme so far

10th installment to be released to eligible farmers shortly

Port Blair, Dec. 16

The tenth installment under Pradhan Mantri Kisan Samman Nidhi (PM-KISAN) Scheme is to be released by GoI for the farmers shortly. Approximately, 15000 farmers of A & N Islands will be eligible to receive the tenth installment @ Rs. 2000/- per trimester per farmer. The total amount of tenth installment to be released by DBT mechanism will be to

the tune of Rs. 3 Crores (Approx.). The PM-KISAN programme is a Central sector programme with full funding for small and marginal farmers. It came into force on December 1, 2018.

In Andaman & Nicobar Islands, as on date, 17376 farmers have been registered in the ambitious scheme of Government of India- PM-KISAN and a total of Rs. 28.0524 crores

disbursed through DBT to PM-KISAN beneficiaries account.

The scheme aims to supplement the financial needs of the farmers in procuring various inputs to ensure proper crop health and appropriate yields, commensurate with the

anticipated farm income.

Under the scheme, financial benefit of Rs, 6000/- per year is provided to all farmer families irrespective of the size of their land holdings, subject to certain exclusion factors like serving or retired

Government Servants, Pensioners, Income Tax Payee, holding any constitutional posts and professionals.

The Farm families are identified as beneficiaries for the programme. The definition of family

Vaccination- shield against the virus 5,82,471 doses of vaccines administered to beneficiaries in Isles so far

Port Blair, Dec. 16

The vaccination drive is continuing smoothly in A&N Islands. As per data available, a total of 5,82,471 doses of vaccines have been administered to beneficiaries so far in A&N Islands, out of the target beneficiaries of 2, 86, 600 (approx.).

A total of 2423 people were vaccinated today. 2322 beneficiaries were vaccinated in South Andaman District, out of which, 67 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44 years. Similarly, 93 beneficiaries were vaccinated in North & Middle Andaman District, out of which, 2

beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44. 8 beneficiaries were vaccinated in Nicobar District, out of which, 2 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44. A total of 1,77,081 eligible people in the age group of 18 to 44 years have been vaccinated till date.

Two positive cases detected during test conducted on Heli passengers

Port Blair, Dec. 16

During the RT-PCR test conducted on 406 passengers who arrived here yesterday, no positive case has been detected. Today, 12 flights with 2121 passengers arrived, out of which, 1703 were vaccinated with both doses while RT-PCR test was conducted on 409 passengers (includes 58 international travellers) and the reports are awaited.

During RAT conducted on 86 passengers bound for North & Middle Andaman at Ferrargunj, no positive case has been detected. At Mohanpura Bus Terminus, test was conducted on 48 passengers and all were found negative. At Phoenix Bay Jetty, 30 passengers were tested with RAT and all were found negative. During RAT conducted on 1 passengers at Helipad, no positive case has been detected. Apart from this, RT-PCR test was conducted on 14 crew members of MV Rangat and 19 crew member of MV Kamorta and the reports are awaited. Two positive cases have been detected during test conducted on Heli passengers yesterday.

Today, till 3 pm, 264 eligible beneficiaries were vaccinated, out of which, 231 were in the age group of 18-44, a press release from the Directorate of IP&T said.

credible information was received by HC Mintu Kumar Dey I/c JPP Tirur No.4 that few fishermen had sighted Myanmarse dinghy near Hiren Tikrey. Immediately, a search team comprising of ASI Muthu Kannan, HC.V. Henthoo, PCs Pabitra Sikari, Pabitra Bepari, Davidson, HG, Sukhdev Biswas with arms & ammunition and other assets. 2 staff from AAJVS and 3 Staff from Forest Department was constituted under the supervision of SDPO (Bambooflat) to conduct anti poaching operation.

The team was briefed by SHO PS Ograbraj T. Dilla Rao about the search operation and thereafter the team left Tirur in AAJVS boat and wooden dinghy of Forest Department and started patrolling in the sea area near Bada Balu and kept strict surveillance throughout the night. On Dec.15, the anti poaching team at about 0500 hrs sighted a fishing dinghy near Bada Balu, Jarawa Reserve area upon which the joint team swung into action and chased the poacher's boat. On seeing patrolling party, the Burmese dinghy tried to escape into the creeks but after 10-15 minutes of chase, the said dinghy was intercepted by the patrolling party and thereby apprehended 10 Myanmarse National. Upon interrogation, they disclosed that they left from Mayanmar on Dec.1 and reached Bada Bhalu on Dec. 4, since then they were halting over there and poaching sea cucumber.

Meanwhile, the general public have been requested to pass on credible information regarding any kind of anti-social activity in their locality or any kind of crime to Police at 100, 112 & 03192-233077. Identity of the informer will be kept secret, a press release from SP (SA) said.

The benefit is provided in 3 equal installments of Rs. 2000/- each in a period of every four months in a financial year directly in the bank account of the beneficiaries. The Agriculture Department is designated as the Nodal Department in A&N Islands for implementation of PM-KISAN scheme. The Department of Agriculture in coordination with the Department of Rural Development worked together in all Zones of A&N Islands continuously from the day of launch and conducted door to door visits in all village level along with the co-ordination of concerned PRI's to inform, motivate and support the farmers for availing the benefits of PM's flagship programme. Apart from these, the field officials conducted awareness programme at village level, conducted Special Gram Sabha's and camps to bring the farmers under PM-KISAN scheme.

Being an income Benefit Scheme for the farmers, the left out farmers who have not yet enrolled under the scheme have been requested to come forward and enroll themselves through PM-KISAN Portal/PM-KISAN App./ CSCs/ approach the nearest Agriculture Office along with land records and other necessary documents, a press release from Agriculture Deptt. said.

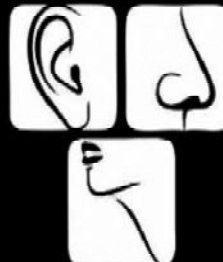

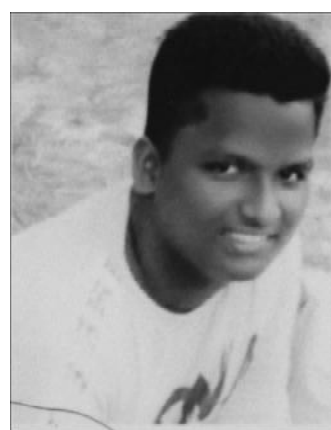
