Interviewer: Can you elaborate on the goals and Department checks the quality of meters of autorickshaws objectives of State Transport Department?

cretary (Transport): The State Transport Department's focus is to provide reliable, comfortable and sustainable transport to the general public of A&N Islands and action plan is prepared & implemented based on these merits. Various initiatives are being taken by the Department in varied angles. The Department has given more focus on Green Mobility in South Andaman as well as Swaraj Dweep. The NITI Aavog has recognised our entire process of Green Initiatives as the best practices in India.

Interviewer: What are the services provided by your **Department?**

Secretary (Transport): Our main service is to provide better transport service to the people of A&N Islands. The Transport Department has the responsibility to regulate the legal norms of the MV Act for the private vehicle owners, four & twowheelers and commercial vehicles.

Interviewer: Can you elaborate on the concessions given to the passengers?

Secretary (Transport): Public Transport is a subsidized facility world over which is devised keeping in mind the people of lower strata in the society. That is why, the fare of the Public Transport is subsidized. There are different types of facilities for the general public for different types of services.

Interviewer: What is Bharat Series vehicle registration and who can avail this facility?

Secretary (Transport): The Ministry of Road Transport & Highways has brought a common registration number for vehicles in India which was implemented all over India. The RTOs all over India has the authority to grant this number. People who are on all India postings apply for this registration. This registration is done as per the guidelines issued by the Ministry of Road Transport & Highways.

Interviewer: Brief about the functions of State Transport **Authority?**

ecretary (Transport): The STA under MV Act, regulates grant of permit and related vehicles of different categories having different norms. STA has multifarious roles. STA is the authority which acts as the regulator for the private vehicle ownership in the Transportation Sector. The Act has given the power to STA and its decisions are final. The STA provides the clearance for all the commercial vehicles plying on the road viz. Govt. vehicles, contract carriage, goods carriage. The vital role of STA is to implement the provisions of MV Act. Weights & Measures

while the STA grants the permits.

Interviewer: Why there is need for a separate Motor Vehicle

Division? Secretary (Transport): This is a specialized nature of work and very voluminous too. The Transport Department's substantial chunk of work is related to implementation of MV Act and this Division acts as the Secretariat of the STA. The GoI's different information as well as the portal viz. VAHAN & SARATHI is manned by the employees of MV Division. This Division is the backbone for regulation of Transportation Services. The best talented JEs of Transport Department are engaged in this division for its better implementation.

Interviewer: What is the current strength of your fleet in all the three Districts and what is being done to augment the fleet? Secretary (Transport): Around 325 buses are there in our fleet and 14 new buses have been purchased which will be inaugurated after the completion of all required formalities. These 14 buses have been purchased against condemnation of old buses. In the month of January 2023, a new notification by MoRTH has been received under which it has been informed to replace the old buses. The Department has taken up with the Ministry for exemption so that the Department can run the old buses and after completing all the clauses of the notification we will go for the fleet replacement. It is expected that within three to four years time, STS fleet modernization will be completed in the A&N Islands.

Interviewer: Pollution level is increasing and how much thrust

is being given to Electric buses? Secretary (Transport): A&N Islands should be proud of that fact that it has been awarded Green Mobility award for the three consecutive years. The NITI Aayog has recognised our entire process of Green Initiatives as the best practices in India. At Port Blair, the Department has provided the services of 35 e-buses while at Swaraj Dweep, the services of 5 e-buses are available, which is a successful & sustainable electric model for mass rapid transit. The transit of passengers in these ebuses are very comfortable, reliable and safe. As far as Port Blair is concerned, e-buses are mapped adequately in Port Blair as of now. The Department is not able to ply these buses in congested areas and for which we have pressed services of mini buses which can make a turn in small diameter. By adopting a comprehensive & eclectic approach, the Transport

and inter-district bus services. A liberal approach has been made for Pollution norms & Centres and if any person applies for Pollution Centres approval is given at faster mode.

Interviewer: Do you have any proposal to introduce quality night bus service to North and Middle **Andaman District?**

Secretary (Transport): ATR buses are plying to N&M Andaman, which are better than the fleet available in North & Middle Andaman. The Department is going to induct four more new buses which will be long distance buses. We expect a quality improvement after the induction of new buses. Apart from this, four new buses will be provided to Diglipur Sub-Division which will feed the feeder route of ATR. Two buses one each at Mayabunder and Rangat for additional routes. One more bus will be deployed in Baratang. A plan has already prepared to cover all the feeder routes in ATR, deployment orders have been issued and as soon as the services of new buses are launched, it will be deployed in these areas. There are no plans to introduce night AC buses by the Department in North & Middle Andaman as of now. However, the Chief Secretary has directed to take quotes of the AC night buses so that we can introduce such services in future.

Interviewer: Do you have any proposal to introduce Bus service from different Ports to Bus terminus during the arrival of vessels?

Secretary (Transport): Last year, the Transport Department in tandem with the DSS has prepared a schedule to provide bus services to the passengers from Port Blair Port viz. Phoenix Bay, Chatham and Haddo. A synchronization of buses crossing these areas were also done, the response of which was very good especially at Phoenix Bay, where it was seen that commuters are availing STS e-buses as compared to the Pvt. Buses. Efforts will be made for a minute-to-minute further synchronizing of buses with boat timings, which will not only enhance the revenue but it will also provide better facilities to the commuters.

Interviewer: What is being done to improve the facilities of Bus terminus across the Islands?

Secretary (Transport): The Bus Terminus at Mohanpura is equipped with all facilities. Last time, the Department focused on passenger centric works in Mohapura Terminus. Now, focus is on staff centric work where space for drivers /conductors are created in the newly created canteen, so that they get good food, ramps have been created to maintain cleanliness in buses, parking areas have been earmarked etc. Facilities for Departmental staff are also being upgraded. During inspection, it was found that passenger centric facilities are there while the facilities for our staff was lacking. To overcome these, the Department is working on that and better facilities will be provided to the staff too. I have personally visited the bus terminuses in North & Middle Andamans. There are shortages in facilities but through intervention & monitoring facilities have improved in different STS Units. As an example, let me tell you the incident of Diglipur, there was a bus terminus at Subhash Gram in Diglipur and during my visit there, it was found that the bathroom was locked and there was no adequate furniture in that building. Within 20 days, all the required facilities for citizens were put in place by the staff of our Department through centralised procurement. At Rangat Bus Terminus, the facility of a canteen has been made available recently. The STS Workshop at Mayabunder needs improvement and this work has been included in this year's plan. Proper monitoring of the assets will pave the way for its gradual improvement.

Interviewer: Can you explain in detail about the staff welfare measures undertaken by the Department? Secretary (Transport): All the Governmental provisions are being followed for the staff welfare at Centralised level from the Directorate. The rights of the women and all the statutory provisions are being provided to the staff as well as the retired employees. Apart from this, some steps have been taken within the Department under which, we all contributed and started a canteen in the Directorate of State Transport Services. The drivers and bus conductors (both gents & ladies) some of them are single mothers, DRM drivers are being provided lunch @ of Rs. 30 and nutritious protein-rich breakfast @ of Rs. 10. To provide breakfast and lunch to the staff at cheap rate & minimum cost was decided at a staff interaction meet when they informed about the high rate of foods outside. We are running this facility in a co-operative manner. Interviewer: What is being done to improve safety of women in public transport system?

Secretary (Transport): Safety of women is ensured at all level in A&N Islands and there are many lady bus conductors in the Transport Department and they are the best performers. Complaints are minimal in public transport of A&N Islands with regard to the safety aspects of women travellers. There is always scope for improvements at all level and the Department with the help of police, team of our Department officials and electronic surveillance monitoring is carried out effectively as all the buses have been fitted

Interviewer: Do you provide Health care facilities to drivers of public transport service?

Secretary (Transport): The Department organizes camps for the health check up of our staff from time to time. A Road Safety Wing is functioning in our Department where we not only take care of health of our drivers and staff but the health check up of commercial vehicle operators such as auto drivers, taxi drivers, bus drivers are done on a regular basis by organizing camps. This is done as part of the instructions of the Supreme Court and by conducting such camps, not only our roads remain safe for us, but they are also benefitted out of it.

Interviewer: Considering the congestion in Port Blair city, do you have any proposal to relocate Bus Terminus at Port Blair to the outskirts of the city?

Secretary (Transport): Earlier, there was a proposal under consideration but at present there is no proposal to shift the Mohanpura Bus Terminus. However, there are District Road Safety Committees in all the 3 Districts which meets under the Chairmanship of Deputy Commissioner and at UT level there is Road Safety Council which works under the Chairmanship of the Chief Secretary. Decongestion is also one of the many aspects which these committees deal with. During the recent meeting of the Road Safety Council held under the Chairmanship of the Chief Secretary, in which the Chief Secretary directed to identify more parking places to set up multiple parkings sites to decongest the city area at Port Blair.

Interviewer: How would you evaluate your experience with 'Go Go Bus' service?

Secretary (Transport): Go Go Bus service is a tourist centric bus service which was introduced to fulfill the needs of the tourists. This facility was inaugurated by the Hon'ble Home Minister, Shri Amit Shah during his visit to these Islands. We have not been able to reach to its potential level due to the fact that the tourism in Port Blair city is done through tour operators. There is no coordination between Go-Go bus service and operators with their private taxis. However, the situation is different at Swaraj Dweep as tourism at that place is a beach Centric. There are only two sites i.e. Radhanagar and Kalapather at Swaraj Dweep and Go-Go Bus service is successful there. To improve the Go-Go bus service with regard to the revenue perspective, a dialogue will have to be arranged with the main tourism operators of the Port Blair City to make a win-win situation, as this bus service is a very good service. With only Rs.150/- per ticket, one can visit all the tourist spots of the city. A massive awareness needs to be made among the masses about the benefits of this service to the Islanders as well as tourists.

Interviewer: Administration is conducting recruitment drive. How many vacancies are likely to be filled up in your Department during this drive?

Secretary (Transport): The Department is taking three steps for filling-up the vacant posts. The recruitment of all the Group D-Matric level posts in the Department is being done by the Personnel Wing of the Administration, 400 posts will be filled up, the exam for which will be conducted on July 9 in which the posts of drivers and conductors will also be filled. Apart from this, a separate exam to fill the post of Chargeman and Transport Officer will be scheduled in the last week of June. This will be a computerbased examination. There are some graduate level post such as Commercial Accountant Exam and Station Inspector etc. the exam for which will be conducted separately on July 16. The deficit of staff in the Department will be covered as soon as the recruitment process is completed and by October, the Department will be adequate in staff strength.

Interviewer: What are the future projects in the pipeline?

Secretary (Transport): The future projects can be classified under capital head of augmentation of infrastructure. Under this, a major Bus Terminus is coming up in Diglipur and Car Nicobar which has been sanctioned by SFC and the Lt. Governor has granted final approval. Both these projects are under tender stage. Bus Terminus at Swaraj Dweep and Campbell Bay is almost completed which will be inaugurated shortly. Apart from this, ICAT Automated testing Centre will be set up at Port Blair as per the instructions of the GoI. This will be a three -lane set up which will pave the way for carrying out smooth fitness test of vehicles. Our effort is to complete the technical part of this project by March 2024 and office part will be taken up at a later stage. Transit Accommodations are being created for the staff residing in distant places like Swaraj Dweep, Chidiyatapu and Wandoor. These are the broad action plan of the Department for the next year.

Interviewer: Is there any grievance redressal mechanism in place?

Secretary (Transport): The Department is having a dedicated Grievance Redressal Portal at CS and LG level. Apart from this, at Department level, there is complaint boxes, Grievance Redressal Officers are there and I personally used to meet the general public.

Interviewer: What are your expectations from the commuters?

Secretary (Transport): I wish to convey to the general public that STS is their assets and they should shoulder the responsibility to look after it the way they look after their own vehicles. The Department is committed to provide comfortable and reliable service to the people of these Islands.


