Defence Research and Development Organisation, DRDO and Indian Air Force, IAF team on Friday jointly flight tested indigenously developed Long-Range Bomb successfully from an aerial platform. The Long-Range Bomb after release from the IAF fighter aircraft, guided to a land-based target at a long range with accuracy within specified limits. All the mission objectives were successfully met. The flight of the bomb and the performance was monitored by a number of

## Facilitating unorganized workers to get themselves registered on e-SHRAM Portal

### Labour Department sets up Facilitation Centre at its Office at Supply Line

Port Blair, Oct. 29

The Ministry of Labour & Employment, New Delhi has launched a registration module/portal i.e. e-SHRAM for creation of a comprehensive National Database of Unorganized Workers (NDUW) for all types of Unorganized Workers such as Construction Workers, Migrant Workers, Domestic Workers, Agricultural Labourers, MGNREGA Workers, GIG Workers, Self-Employed Workers, Street Vendors, Shop Keepers, ASHA Workers, Anganwadi Workers, Fishermen, Unorganized Plantation Workers, Milkmen and similar other sub-group of Unorganized Workers.

Now, the Labour Department has set up



Facilitation Centre in the Office of Labour Commissioner, Supply Line so as to facilitate the Unorganized Workers to get themselves registered on e-SHRAM Portal. In this context, it is appealed to all Unorganized Workers (those who aged between 16-59 years, not a member in EPF/ESI and not an Income Tax Payee) to get themselves registered

at e-SHRAM Portal. They can now approach the Facilitation Centre functioning at Office of the Labour Commissioner, Dept. of Labour, Supply Line, Port Blair during office working hours along with a copy of Aadhaar Card, Bank A/c number, IFSC Code and Aadhaar Linked mobile number.

All Unorganized Workers have been once again requested to avail the facility of registration on e-SHRAM Portal without fail. e-SHRAM card received after registration will be accepted across the country; Accidental insurance coverage through PMSBY for a year; Rs. 2 lakhs in case of accidental death and permanent disability and Rs. 1 lakh in case of partial disability;

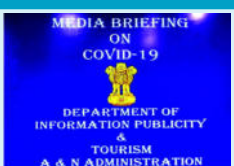

## ICAR-CIARI reports outbreak of immature amphistomiasis in goat farm at Mithakhari

Port Blair, Oct. 29

ICAR-CIARI for the first time has reported the outbreak of immature amphistomiasis along with its aetiological agent in an organized goat farm situated in Mithakhari of South Andaman District during September, 2021. The animals were reared in semi intensive system since they were regularly allowed to graze in the nearby water logged marshy land since the climate was wet

throughout this month. From the middle of the month, the farmer reported mortality of the goats (average 2-3 per day) showing the

symptoms of abdominal pain, bloat/distension of abdomen, abnormal accumulation of clear oedema fluid under the

### Farmers' Corner- A Knowledge Hub

## Heliconialatispatha commonly known as Expanded Lobster claw

*Heliconialatispatha* is a herbaceous perennial and is native to Tropical America. The leaves are simple, alternate, longpetioled with lanceolate leaf blade. The relatively inconspicuous flowers emerge from gaudy, claw-shaped, reddish-orange floral bracts. The floral bracts are arranged spirally in upright position ranging in colours of orange, red and yellow. There are four varieties of this species are maintained at ICAR-CIARI and are *H. latispatha* Cv. Scarlet Orange, *H. latispatha* Cv. Scarlet Orange Kairo, *H. latispatha* Cv. Distans, *H. latispatha* Cv. Big Yellow and *H. latispatha* Cv. Yellow. The height of the plant ranges from 1.5 -2.0 m and is suitable for landscape horticulture and also a potted plant. It prefers to grow in moist condition and fully shaded condition interrupts the flowering frequency of the species. The species is commonly propagated through rhizomes. Flowering initiated in 125 -140 days after planting of rhizomes. The species yields 10-15 flowering spikes per clump per year. The flowering season of this species is April to September. The spike length ranges from 32- 41 cm. The stalk length of flower is 50 cm. The vase life of flowers ranges from 5 -7 days.

**Benefit:** *Heliconialatispatha* species have great potential to be used as cut flower due to their beauty, rusticity and in general good postharvest longevity. It can be utilized as specimen plant, backdrop plants and group planting for giving mass effect. This species is highly adapted to tropical humid climatic condition of Andaman and Nicobar Islands.

skin of the lower jaw (bottle jaw), profuse watery diarrhoea followed by death. Within 14 days, the mortality reached to 38.46%. After visiting the place of outbreak, post-mortem examination of the goats were done. Examination of abdomen revealed accumulation of colourless fluid in the peritoneal cavity and there was distension of gall bladder. After opening the intestine, in the duodenum region numerous immature flukes could be detected along with patches of haemorrhages as they were embedded in the mucosa and are reported to be plug feeders by drawing pieces of mucosa in the suckers.

In the abomasum there were ulcerative changes along with presence of few numbers of fluke. Ultimately numerous worms were isolated from rumen of the affected animal. On the basis of colour and microscopic examination, the worms were indistinguishable from Paramphistomum cervi. Based on the post-mortem findings and clinical symptoms, the farmer was advised to start with treatment against amphistomiasis by using single dose of oxcyclonazide along with supportive iron therapy for consecutive five days and further advised to be stall fed.

After onset of the therapy, only three severely affected animals died within two days and after five days no mortality was observed. Hence, it is recommend that treatment of the goats with flukicidal medicines before the onset of rainy season available in different combinations with other anthelmintics like rafoxanide + ivermectin or combinations of levamisole hydrochloride, oxcyclonazide, anhydrous copper sulphate and cobalt sulphate or closantel sodium dehydrate may be done under the supervision of qualified Veterinary practitioner, a press release from CIARI said.

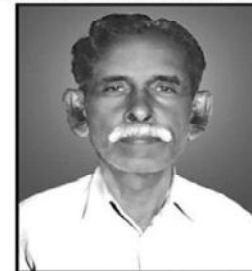
