EMPLOYMENT NOTICE OF ENGAGEMENT OF GUEST FACULTIES / RESOURCE PERSONS AT ANCOL, PORT BLAIR

Andaman College (ANCOL), Port Blair, proposes to prepare a panel of Resource persons to engage their services as Resource Persons in the various subjects to teach U.G. courses "as and when required basis" depending upon the requirement of teaching work in the concerned subject/ department for the Academic Year 2022-2023. The Resource Persons required in the following subjects B.Com (Commerce), B.Com (Corporate Secretaryship), B.B.A, B.A (Economics), B.A (Sociology), BA (English), B.Sc (Psychology), BPA (Hindustani Vocal and Instrumentation), Library Science. Physical Education, Environmental Studies and Public Administration. The Resource person shall be paid honorarium of Rs.1,000/- (Rupees One thousand only) per lecture subject to a maximum of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty five thousand only) or as per the instructions receive from the Competent Authority as the case may be.

Educational and Other qualifications:

<u>A.</u>

A Master degree with 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a pointi) grading system is followed) wherever the concerned/relevant/allied subject from an Indian University.

Must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the ii) UGC or the CSIR or a similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET or who are or have been awarded a Ph.D Degree in accordance with the University Grant Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil/Ph.D programme prior to July 11, 2009 or 2016 and their amendments from time to time as the case may be exempted from NET/SLET/SET.

Provided, the candidates registered for the Ph.D programme prior to July11,2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the existing Ordinances/Bye-laws/Regulations of the Institution awarding the degree and such Ph.D candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/ Colleges/Institutions subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions.

a) The Ph.D Degree of the candidate has been awarded in a regular mode:

- b) The Ph.D. thesis has been awarded by at least two external examiners;
- c) c) An open Ph.D. viva voce of the candidate has been conducted;
- d) The candidate has published two research papers from his/her Ph.D. work out of which at least one is in a refereed journal;
- e) The candidate has presented at least two papers, based on his/her Ph.D. work in conferences/seminars sponsored/funded/supported by the UGC/ ICSSR/CSIR or any similar agency.

The fulfillment of these conditions is to be certified by the Registrar or the Dean (Academic Affairs) of the University concerned

Or

B. The Ph.D degree from a foreign university /institutions

Or

c) For Music and Performing Arts course in addition to the above qualification below mentioned qualification are also eligible for applying guest faculties /resource persons in the Department of B.P.A (Hindustani Vocal and Instrumentation)

A traditional or a professional artist with highly commendable professional achievement in the subject concerned having a Bachelor's degree, who has:

- i) studied under a noted/reputed traditional Master(s)/Artist(s)
- ii) Has been 'A' grade artist of AIR/Doordarshan;
- iii) Has the ability to explain, with logical reasoning the subject concerned; and
- iv) Has adequate knowledge to teach theory with illustrations in the discipline concerned.

RELAXATION CLAUSE:

- 1. The clearing of NET/SLET/SET shall not be required for candidates in such disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET has not been conducted. A minimum of 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point-scale, wherever the grading system is followed) at the Master's level shall be the essential qualification for direct recruitment of teachers and other equivalent cadres at any level.
- 2. A relaxation of 5% shall be allowed at the Bachelor's as well as at the Master's level for the candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe/Other Backward Classes (OBC)(Non-creamy Layer)/Differentlyabled ((a) Blindness and low vision; (b) Deaf and Hard of Hearing; (c) Locomotor disability including cerebral palsy, leprosy cured, dwarfism, acid-attack victims and muscular dystrophy; (d) Autism, intellectual disability, specific learning disability and mental illness; (e) Multiple disabilities from amongst persons under (a) to (d) including deaf-blindness) for the purpose of eligibility and assessing good academic record for direct recruitment.

The eligibility marks of 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever the grading system is followed) and the relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above are permissible, based only on the qualifying marks without including any grace mark procedure.

3. 3 A relaxation of 5% shall be provided, (from 55% to 50% of the marks) to the Ph.D. Degree holders who have obtained their Master's

Degree prior to 19 September, 1991.

4. A relevant grade which is regarded as equivalent of 55%, wherever the grading system is followed by a recognized university, at the Master's level shall also be considered valid.

GENERAL INFORMATION:

1. The candidates with Ph.D Degree awarded in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedures for award of Ph.D Degree) Regulations, 2009 or 2016 are required to submit a certificate from concerned university to the effect that their Ph.D Degree is compliant of 'UGC (Minimum Standards and Procedures for award of M.Phil/Ph.D Degree) Regulations '2009'.

2. The Candidates registered for the Ph.D Programme prior to July, 11, 2009, shall submit a certificate in accordance with the University Grants Commission on Minimum qualifications for appointment of Teachers and other academic staff in universities and colleges and measures for the

maintenance of Standards in Higher educations.

3. The Prescribed qualifications and experience are minimum and the mere fact that a candidate possesses the same will not entitle him / her for being selected. The Academic Score as specified in Appendix II (Table 3 B) of UGC Regulations 2018 shall be considered for preparation of merit list and the selection shall be based only on the academic scoring and no interview.

- 4. It is the responsibility of the candidate to assess his own eligibility for the post for which he /she is applying in accordance with the prescribed qualifications/ experience etc. Suppression of factual information, supply of fake documents providing false or misleading information or any other undesirable action by the candidate shall lead to cancellation of his/ her candidature.
- 5. The Panel of selected candidates will be valid for one academic year from the date of approval of Competent Authority.
- 6. In complete applications will not be considered at all.
- 7. The ANCOL (Andaman College), Port Blair has reserves the right:
 - i) To withdraw the advertisement either partly or wholly at any time without assigning any reason to this effect.
 - ii) To fill or not to fill up some of the Resource Persons posts advertised for any reasons whatsoever.
 - iii) To draw up reserves panel / waiting list(s), which will be valid for one academic year from the date of approval of the Competent Authority and may be used for engagement on as and when required basis.
 - iv) The College will not consider any applications received after last date for applying for the engagement of Resource Persons.

The ANCOL, Port Blair will not be responsible for any postal delay at any stage.

9. All the certificates shall be self attested by the candidate.

No, candidate can claim regular appointment on mere of engagement

of Resource Persons in any subject.
