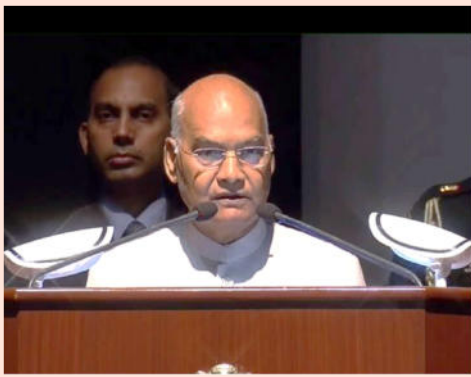


President delivers 4th Dr. APJ Abdul Kalam memorial Lecture

all COVID SOP issued by the MHA from time to time. Besides the compoundable nature of cases pending in different courts, disputes at the pre-litigation stage will also be entertained by the National Lok Adalat for disposal upon consensual settlement between the parties. Pre-

litigation disputes include NI Act cases u/s 138, Money recovery cases, Labour dispute cases, Electricity and water bills cases (excluding non-compoundable), Maintenance cases & Civil disputes.

Govt. sanctions 2,877 Electric Vehicle Charging Stations across 25 States/ UTs under FAME-II

New Delhi, July 19

The Government has sanctioned two thousand 877 Electric Vehicle Charging Stations in 68 cities across 25 States and Union Territories under Phase-2 of FAME India scheme (Faster Adoption and Manufacturing of Electric Vehicles). The Government has formulated FAME India Scheme in 2015 to improve the

infrastructure required for the large-scale use of electric vehicles. Minister of State for Heavy Industries, Shri Krishan Pal Gurjar said this in a written reply in the Lok Sabha today.

He said, one thousand five hundred seventy-six charging stations have also been sanctioned across nine expressways and 16 Highways under FAME India Scheme.

He said, under Phase-1 of FAME India Scheme, 479 charging stations have been installed as on 1st July this year. The Minister said, under Phase-2 of FAME-India Scheme one thousand crore rupees has been allocated for the development of charging infrastructure for a period of five years from 1st April 2019. Vaccination drive in A&N Islands**25,031 beneficiaries in the age group of 12 to 14 years administered both doses of vaccine**

The vaccination drive is continuing smoothly in A&N Islands. As per data available, a total of 6,84,811 doses of vaccine have been administered to beneficiaries in the age group of 18 and above so far. Similarly, 23,623 beneficiaries have been vaccinated in the age group of 15 to 18 years. 25,031 beneficiaries in the age group of 12 to 14 years have been administered both doses of vaccine. The number of beneficiaries administered

precautionary dose of vaccine so far stood at 38283.

A total of 3902 eligible beneficiaries were vaccinated in A&N Islands today. 1949 beneficiaries were vaccinated in South Andaman District, out of which, 14 were in the age group of 12-14 years. 7 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44 years and the number of beneficiaries administered precautionary dose of vaccine stood at 1895.

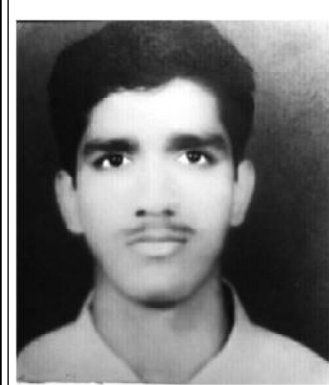

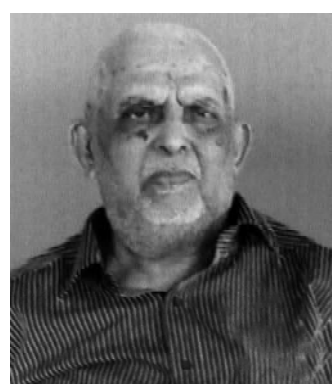

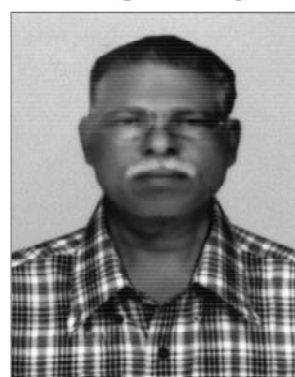
