AUTO PLI SCHEME GIVES RIGHT IMPETUS TO THE INDUSTRY TO MOVE TOWARDS GREEN MOBILITY: EXPERTS

Over the last several months the Narendra Modi government has amounced production-linked incentive scheme across various sectors. The key aim has been to attract more key aim has been to attract more investment in India and boost local production, which will in turn create more jobs and aid the overall economy. Earlier this week, the government announced a Rs 26,058 crore PLI automotive sector covers both automotive sector covers both automobile as well as autocomponent industries. The scheme is aimed at supporting the manufacturing and adoption of electric vehicle and hydrogen fuel cell vehicles and localisation of advanced technology components.

The automotive PLI scheme that will be effective next financial year aims

The Automotive Component Manufacturers Association has also welcomed the PLI scheme, staling it will necritivise investments in rew age automotive technologies such as automatic transmission assembly, electronic power steering system, sensors, super capacitors, electronic control units. How can vertical landing of rockets benefit ISRO?

The Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) is presently conducting research and studies and is also conducting projects to enable the vertical landing of its rockets—primarily the GSLV Mk-III is expected to benefit ISRO immensely as per space experts. Experts observ e that for GSLV Mk-II and Mk-III being observe trait or GSLV MK-II and MK-III being medium to heavy class launch vehicles, reusability will be a key technology to demonstrate, so that cost can be drastically brought down and ISRO can be more

competitive in the global landscape.

Currently, ISRO's rockets are expendable Currenty, ISRO's rockets areex pendable and the rocket stages separate from the launch v ehicle and fall into the sea after their burn time. Reusability can help in recovering the rocket's stages at sea α on hand by v ertical landing and then bring hem back forthy ing after refurbishing, servicing and testing hem.

ISRO already has an ongoing programme tofirst try atechnology demonstrator to recover the L40 strap-on boosters from GSLV Mk-II. the L4U strap-on boosters from GSLV MK-II.
"The technology involve dis somplex – it's just like shooting an arrow aiming at the bullsey e a few hundred kilo metres, the main difference being the bulls eye is not stationary, as the earth is rotating. The prerequisities in terms of control political politic inertial navigation and guidance is something ISRO already has an expertise in. It is only a matter of decision making and iterations to enable reuse of launch vehicles." Rohan M. Ganapathy, CEO and CTO of Bellatrix

Garlapatry, Ceb and CTHE WEEK.
This expert further explained that rockets are complex things to produce as when one sees a rocket launch, one sees it as a single piece going upwards. However, it has millions

of components that have to work in synchrorisation. "There are millions of rocker components that take time to manufacture and it is not like in the automobile industry where it can be rolled down. The production line cannot canbe roled down. The production line cannot be speeded up very quickly. When three is so much demand for regularlaunches, ieuse is the best option, similar to airplanes. If one orders an airplane, it takes two to three years for delivery. Building rockets is similar. Since we reuse airplanes, we are able to meet passenger traffic and budgets.

Experts observe that GSLV Mk-III is little different from other rockets in the sense that first stage boosters use solid propellants and for the second stage, ISRO could try landing similar to Falcon 9 by reignifing the engine with spare fuel. However, solid rocket boosters are simple metal shells in w hich the solid propellant is loaded, but since they are massive structures. they could be recovered using parachutes similar to how space shuttle boosters were similar to now space shuttle boossers were recovered. The second stage has a semi cry ogenic engine. To reuse this, ISRO has to first demonstrate entry, de scent and I anding (EDL) first with the L40 boos ters of Mk-II and once established, can be mastered on Mk-III. Together, GSLV Mk-II and Mk-III will cater to the medium to heavy launch market. "By increasing the launch vehicle frequency, we increasing the launch vehicle trequency, we can aim at becoming more cost competitive than SpaceX considering our economics and approach to engineering. It is not just Mk-III and Mk-III—ISRO is also looking one step further for their Single Stage to Orbit vehicle, Av atar programme, which will enable more efficient access to nothil" said Canapathy. access to orbit," said Ganapathy.

It might be comparatively more complex to land than Edward 1. Falcon 9 if we are also thinking about recovering the boosters, but it would be a great technological improvement. Since India has its own improvement. We think that capabilities like this would not just help us in reducing the cost and overall economy of the launches but also and overall ectionary or in let alurities to utalso make us befunologically adv anced and helpus inpracticing landing which we need to do when we are doing interplanetary missions, it would also be an immensely proud moment for the country," pointed out Srimathy Kesan, the founder and CEO of Space Kidz India. 
