Vaccination drive continuing smoothly in A&N Islands
Port Blair, Sept 17: The vaccination drive is continuing smoothly in A&N Islands. As per data available, a total of 4,01,429 beneficiaries have been vaccinated so far in A&N Islands, out of the target beneficiaries of 2,81,603 (approx.). A total of 3694 people were vaccinated yesterday in A&N Islands. A total of 61,323 eligible people in the age group of 18 to 44 years have been vaccinated till dated 16-09-2021. 2303 beneficiaries were vaccinated in South Andaman District out of which 529 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44 years. Similarly, 775 beneficiaries were vaccinated in North & Middle Andaman District out of which 81 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44. 616 beneficiaries were vaccinated in Nicobar District out of which 7 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44.

Port Blair, 17th Sep, 2021: The Member of Parliament, Shri Kuldeep Rai Sharma visited dwellers residence site near construction site of Coast Guard Air Enclave and took stock of the situation. Earlier, the parliamentarian was told by the residents that their lives and houses are under threat of disaster due to steep and unprotected earth cutting by the construction agency for construction of Coast Guard Air Enclave. Shri. Sharma was informed by a resident that the construction work of the Coast Guard Enclave at Nayagaon is being carried out without taking required preventive measures and preliminary steps to avoid any form of disaster in future due to large and deep earth cutting undertaken for basement work of the construction. Residents said that the climatic condition of the island and preventive measures to protect the dwellers of the nearby area had not been taken into account before commencement of massive earth cutting for constructions. Due to this landslide is happening leading to damage of houses and footpaths. Cracks have been developed in some houses and footpaths are no longer in existence. A notable omission

Elsa Schiaparelli, who dominated the fashion world between the two World Wars, famously said, "In difficult times, fashion is always outrageous." The Italian designer's words may have resonated with those who gathered at the Met Gala on September 13, even as the world beyond the red carpet grappled with the Covid pandemic, political and economic instability and climate emergency. Known for its mix of haute couture and weirdness, the Gala's red carpet this year featured some of the most jaw-dropping looks seen recently. Kim Kardashian's black full-body suit which covered even her face, popstar Lil Nas X's three-stage costume and singer Billie Eilish's throwback to Hollywood's Golden Era—all created an escapist fantasy.

But reality did intrude on the evening, mostly as political statements via fashion, such as politician Alexandria Ocasio-Cortez's gown, which declared "Tax the Rich". Rights for women, the LGBTQ+ community, BIPOC, animals—causes of all kinds got a shout-out. One cause, however, that got a mere whisper of support was that of the Afghan people. Humra Abedin, former aide to Hillary Clinton, wore the "memorial blue" ribbon for 9/11 with the flags of the US and Afghanistan over it, conveying her hope that "we will not forget what the people of Afghanistan are facing as they go through this monumental and uncertain time". As the theme of the evening was inward-looking—"American Independence"—it may have been too much to expect attention for the fate of the Afghans. Never mind that one of the evening's attendees and wearing a gown that demanded, in big, bold letters, "Equal Rights for Women", was politician Carolyn Maloney who, in 2001, had worn a burqa to the House of Representatives and supported the invasion of Afghanistan in the name of its women.

AUTO PLI SCHEME GIVES RIGHT IMPETUS TO THE INDUSTRY TO MOVE TOWARDS GREEN MOBILITY: EXPERTS

Over the last several months, the Narendra Modi government has announced production-linked incentive scheme across various sectors. The key aim has been to attract more investment in India and boost local production, which will in turn create more jobs and aid the overall economy. Earlier this week, the government announced a Rs 26,058 crore PLI

automotive sector covers both automobiles as well as auto component industries. The scheme is aimed at supporting the manufacturing and adoption of electric vehicle and hydrogen fuel cell vehicles and localisation of advanced technology components.

The automotive PLI scheme that will be effective next financial year aims

for the auto PLI scheme, but it has been reduced to less than half as the government has also reduced the scope with a clear focus on greener technologies only.

Also, important to note is that this PLI scheme is in addition to the earlier Rs 18,100 crore PLI scheme for advanced chemistry cells and the Rs 10,000 crore FAME (Faster Adoption of Manufacturing of Electric Vehicles) scheme.

"The revised focus of PLI scheme on alternative fuels, electric vehicles and utilisation of advanced technological innovation, will help the industry move faster towards the future technologies. There is a sense of haste in developing these technologies in India and this scheme gives the right impetus to the industry to move rapidly in that direction," said Venu Srinivasan, chairman of TVS Motor Co.

To qualify for the scheme, the original equipment manufacturers' (OEM) global group revenues will need to be at least Rs 10,000 crore and investments of Rs 3,000 crore in fixed assets; auto component manufacturers would need to have revenues of Rs 500 crore and investment of Rs 150 crore. For new non-automotive investors, global net worth needs to be more than Rs 1,000 crore. Vpin Sondhi, the MD and CEO of truck maker Ashok Leyland, said

the scheme provides incentives for incremental performance by the OEMs, as manufacturers move towards making India a strong hub for electric mobility while also looking at harnessing the potential of hydrogen energy for automotive applications, and other advanced technologies.

"PLI has the potential to substantially increase volumes and will provide a huge opportunity for exports to grow. This scheme is being announced at an opportune time for India as the auto industry realigns its supply chain globally. India can therefore capitalise on this changing scenario, to become an integral manufacturing base for the world," said Sondhi, who is also the vice president of Society of Indian Automobile Manufacturers (SIAM).

The Automotive Component Manufacturers Association has also welcomed the PLI scheme, stating it will incentivise investments in new automotive technologies such as automatic transmission assembly, electronic power steering system, sensors, super capacitors, electronic control units, EV parts, hydrogen fuel cells and its parts, among other components that go into automobiles.

Thrust on incentivising new technologies will facilitate creation of a state-of-the-art automotive value chain in the country and give a much-needed impetus to manufacturing of

cutting edge automotive products in India. Further, with global economies de-risking their supply chains, the PLI will aid India in developing into an attractive alternative source of high-end auto components," said Sunjay Kapur, president of ACMA.

Analysts say the PLI scheme provides a clear direction that policy makers remain focussed on promoting new energy vehicles over traditional petrol and diesel counterparts.

"While the incentives offered under the Auto PLI scheme are lower than the originally planned incentive, it is well-directed to improve competitiveness in the nascent segment. Unlike the draft scheme, which focused on exports, this scheme is focused on the localisation of advanced technologies," said analysts at Mollat Oswal Financial Services.

Among the two-wheeler companies, Bajaj Auto and TVS Motor are likely to benefit from the PLI scheme on their e-scooters front, while in the passenger vehicle side, Tata Motors, which has already gained traction in EVs, and Mahindra & Mahindra, which has plans to launch a range of EVs in the next few years, should get a boost.

Auto component companies like Bosch, Minda Industries, Wabco and Sonacomsar among others are also expected to gain from the Auto PLI scheme.

own direction which gradually affects the underground soil of the existing house buildings which will lead to a great disaster and ultimately loss of life and property. A resident told Shri. Sharma that all inhabitants of the area are in panic of the future disaster.

Residents told parliamentarian that they submitted several petitions to Garrison Engineer (P) North, Minnie Bay, Port Blair requesting

remedial measures to ensure safety of houses of the dwellers residing nearby the construction site. But no action was taken by the authorities.

Shri. Kuldeep Rai Sharma, MP gave patient listening to the

concerns of residents and assessed the situation. He commented that measures for protection of life and property should have been taken before commencement of such construction. He assured residents

that he will take up the matter with UT Administration and Coast Guard authorities to do the needful for protection of life and property of dwellers residing near the construction site.

How can vertical landing of rockets benefit ISRO?

The Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) is presently conducting research and studies and is also conducting projects to enable the vertical landing of rockets—primarily the GSLV Mk-III—is expected to benefit ISRO immensely as per space experts. Experts observe that for GSLV Mk-II and Mk-III being medium to heavy class launch vehicles, reusability will be a key technology to demonstrate, so that cost can be drastically brought down and ISRO can be more competitive in the global landscape.

Currently, ISRO's rockets are expendable and the rocket stages separate from the launch vehicle and fall into the sea after their burn time. Reusability can lead in reusing the rocket's stages at sea or on land by vertical landing and then bring them back for refuelling, refurbishing, servicing and testing them.

ISRO already has an ongoing programme to firstly try a technology demonstrator to recover the L40 strap-on boosters from GSLV Mk-II. "The technology involved is complex—it's just like shooting an arrow aiming at the bullseye a few hundred kilometres, the main difference being the bulls eye is not stationary, as the earth is rotating. The prerequisites in terms of inertial navigation and guidance is something ISRO already has an expertise in. It is only a matter of decision making and iterations to enable reuse of launch vehicles," Rohan M. Ganapathy, CEO and CTO of Bellatrix Aerospace told THE WEEK.

This expert further explained that rockets are complex things to produce as when one sees a rocket launch, one sees it as a single piece going upwards. However, it has millions

of components that have to work in synchronisation. "There are millions of rocket components that take time to manufacture and it is not like in the automobile industry where it can be rolled down. The production line cannot be speeded up very quickly. When there is so much demand for regular launches, reuse is the best option, similar to airplanes. If one orders an airplane, it takes two to three years for delivery. Building rockets is similar. Since we reuse airplanes, we are able to meet passenger traffic and budgets.

Experts observe that GSLV Mk-III is little different from other rockets in the sense that first stage boosters use solid propellants and for the second stage, ISRO could try landing similar to Falcon 9 by reigniting the engine with spare fuel. However, solid rocket boosters are simple metal shells in which the solid propellant is loaded, but since they are massive structures, they could be recovered using parachutes, similar to how space shuttle boosters were recovered. The second stage has a semi cryogenic engine. To reuse this, ISRO has to first demonstrate entry, descent and landing (EDL) first with the L40 boosters of Mk-II and once established, can be mastered on Mk-III. Together, GSLV Mk-II and Mk-III will cater to the medium to heavy launch market. "By increasing the launch vehicle frequency, we can aim at becoming more cost competitive than SpaceX considering our economics and approach to engineering. It is not just Mk-II and Mk-III—ISRO is also looking one step further for their Single Stage to Orbit vehicle, Avatar programme, which will enable more efficient access to orbit," said Ganapathy.

Since GSLV Mk-III is one of ISRO's most advanced and capable launch vehicles, particularly used for sending heavy weight communication satellites, interplanetary missions, and soon human missions reusability can be a very significant factor. "SpaceX, Falcon 9's staging is simple since it is a two stage vehicle whereas Mk-III is a complex vehicle with two boosters and a liquid core engine and cryogenic engine. It might be comparatively more complex to land than Falcon 9 if we are also thinking about recovering the boosters, but it would be a great technological improvement. Since India has its own Navigation Satellite System NavIC, it might add additional benefits in navigating the rocket back to the location and achieve a higher accuracy landing. We think that capabilities like this would not just help us in reducing the cost and overall economy of the launches but also make us technologically advanced and help in practising landing which we need to do when we are doing interplanetary missions, it would also be an immensely proud moment for the country," pointed out Sriniyasa Kesan, the founder and CEO of Space Kidz India. Many space experts also feel that reuse is the future of all heavy lift launch vehicles and will help reduce costs and also push the boundaries of reliability resulting in safer missions. "There will be a pay load penalty which can be addressed through right augmentation. SpaceX of the USA has achieved 90 per cent successful landings of orbital vehicle stages and China and Russia are aggressively pursuing reusable vehicles," said Pawan Kumar Chandana, co-founder and CEO, Skyroot Aerospace.

OLA ELECTRIC SCOOTERS SALES CROSSED RS1,100 CRORE IN 2 DAYS: CEO

Ola co-founder Bhavish Aggarwal on Friday said sales of its S1 electric scooters crossed Rs 1,100 crore in two days.

The executive noted that while the company has stopped the buying process now, the purchase window will re-open on November 1, just in time for Diwali. On Wednesday, Ola Electric had commenced the sale process of its electric scooter, which comes in two trims: Ola S1 and S1 Pro. On day one, the company sold scooters worth Rs 600 crore. "Day 2 of EV era was even better than Day 1! Crossed? 1100Cr in sales in 2 days! Purchase window will reopen on Nov 1 so reserve now if you haven't already," Aggarwal said in a tweet. In a blogpost, Aggarwal said the excitement and enthusiasm customers showed for the products remained high throughout.

"In total over 2 days, we have done over Rs 1,100 crores in sales! This is unprecedented not just in the automotive industry but in one of the highest sales in a day (by value) for a single product in Indian e-commerce history! We truly are living in a digital India," he said.

While the sale of the e-scooter was to start on September 8, it was postponed by a week to September 15, as the company faced "technical difficulties" in making the website for purchases live for customers. The e-scooter is available for purchase on the Ola App only currently, and not on the website.

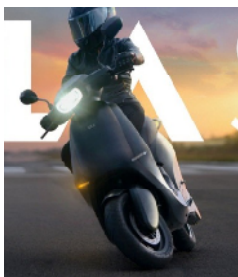
Deliveries will start from October 2021. Buyers will be notified of estimated tentative delivery dates within 72 hours of purchase.

On August 15, the company unveiled its Ola S1 electric scooter in the two variants, S1 and S1 Pro at Rs 99,999 and Rs 1,29,999, respectively (ex-showroom including FAME II subsidy and excluding state subsidies).

Ola Electric had opened pre-launch bookings of its electric scooters in July for Rs 499 and had received 1 lakh orders in just 24 hours. However, the company has not disclosed how many orders it has received so far.

Ola is setting up a manufacturing plant, spread across 500 acres, in Tamil Nadu with an investment of Rs 2,400 crore.

The company had stated that it would initially start with 10 lakh annual production capacity and then scale it up to 20 lakh, in line with market demand, in the



First phase, Ola Electric had claimed that its plant—when fully completed—would have an annual capacity of one crore units, "that is 15 per cent of the world's entire total two-wheeler production".

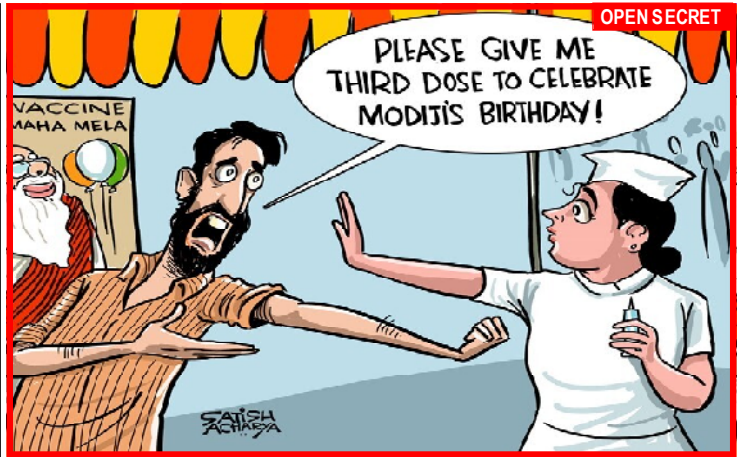

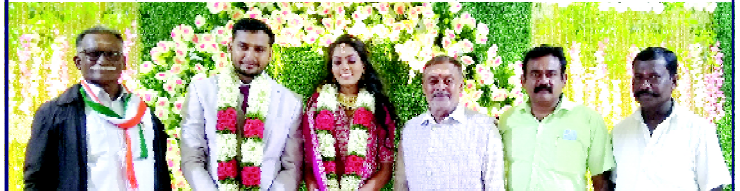
