Financial assistance to 479 beneficiaries amounting to Rs.13.09 crores extended so far

ANIIDCO was notified as a Financial Institution during May 1992 by Government of India, and the Corporation started lending activity in 1996. During May 1997, GoI made certain provisions of State Financial Corporation Act (SFC), 1951 applicable to ANIIDCO with the objective of financing 'Industrial Concerns'. The Corporation provides financial assistance to industrial concerns as per IDBI/SIDBI guidelines. The Corporation has so far extended financial assistance to 479 beneficiaries amounting to Rs.13.09 crores.

Under the scheme financial assistance is



provided to industrial concerns engaged in manufacturing, preservation or processing of goods, transport for passengers/goods etc, hotels and restaurants, assembling, repairing or packing any article with the aid of machinery or power, providing engineering, technical knowledge or other service for promotion of industrial growth, providing medical health or other allied services, setting up or development of tourism related facilities etc.

The quantum of loan is maximum 75% of the total project cost upto Rs.10 lakh and minimum 66% of the total project cost exceeding Rs.10 lakh for purchase of machinery. The promoters contribution is minimum 25% for the project cost upto Rs.10 lakh and 34% for the project cost exceeding Rs.10 lakh.

The rate of interest for different loan amount is fixed based on SIDBI's prime lending rate which is at present 9.95%. Accordingly, rate of Interest calculated as per the range of finance is as under:

To set up 128 towers/ sites for providing 4G based mobile services in 85 identified uncovered villages & seamless coverage along NH-4

Port Blair, April 10

To review the progress of USOF project implementation in N&M Andaman District, the Dy. Director General & Director, Department of Telecom (DoT) visited Mayabunder on April 8 & 9. During the visit, various projects pertaining to telecom were reviewed. Under Universal Service Obligation Fund (USOF) Project, the GoI has approved a project titled 'Provision of coverage to the uncovered villages & seamless coverage along the National Highways (NH4) through 4G based Mobile Technology. M/s

Reliance Jio Infocomm Ltd is executing the project. As part of the project, 128 towers / sites are to be set up for providing 4G based mobile services in 85 identified uncovered villages and seamless coverage along NH-4 in A&N Islands.

Meanwhile, the North and Middle Andaman District is presently being served through 63 Towers and 103 BTS. There are 198 inhabited census villages in the district, 117 villages are already

The scheme of Assistance to Disabled Persons for Purchase/ Fitting of Aids/ Appliances (ADIP Scheme) is being implemented by Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities (Divyangjan), Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Govt. of India since 1981. The main objective of the scheme is to assist the needy Divyangjan in procuring durable, sophisticated and scientifically manufactured, modern, standard aids and



appliances that can promote their physical, social and psychological rehabilitation by reducing the effect of disabilities and enhance their economic potential. Under the Scheme, aids and assistive devices are given to Persons with Disabilities with an aim

to improve their independent functioning, and to arrest the extent of disability and occurrence of secondary disabilities. The scheme was modified and applicable with effect from 1st April, 2022.

A person with disabilities fulfilling the

eligibility criteria which is mentioned in the revised/ modified scheme would be eligible for assistance under ADIP Scheme viz. an Indian citizen of any age, holds a 40% Disability Certificate, his monthly income from all sources not

RBI proposes to make card-less cash withdrawal facility available across all banks, ATM networks using UPI

New Delhi, April 10

While announcing the monetary policy on Friday, the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) Governor, Shri Shaktikanta Das said RBI has proposed to make card-less cash withdrawal facility available across all banks and ATM networks using the Unified Payments Interface (UPI). RBI Governor said the absence

of need for a card to initiate cash withdrawal transactions would help in containing frauds like card skimming, card cloning, etc. However, Governor, Shri Shaktikanta Das clarified that credit & debit cards will continue. Under the cardless cash withdrawal facility, individuals can withdraw cash without using any

debit card at Automated Teller Machines (ATMs). The cardless withdrawal request can be initiated for a minimum of Rs. 100 per transaction and up to a maximum of Rs. 10,000 per day or Rs. 25,000 per month for a beneficiary while the limits are subject to change as per regulatory guidelines. falls under the 29 subjects enshrined in the 11th Schedule of the Constitution. These nine themes are poverty free and enhanced livelihood village; healthy village; child friendly village; water sufficient village; clean & green village; self-sufficient village; socially secured village; village with good governance and engendered development in village.

Article 243 B of the Constitution empowers the Gram Panchayats to prepare the plan for its social and economic development. The 17 SDGs are aligned with the three dimensions of Sustainable Development- Environmental, Social and Economical and therefore the role of Gram Panchayats in achievement of the SDGs is of greater significance.

During the programme, the State Nodal Officer (RGSA) presented the overall overview on SDGs and the need to localize the SDGs into local indicators that are practicable and realizable at the ground level. He outlined that as part of the initiative of Localization of SDGs, the Directorate of RD, PRIs and ULBs has formulated the Local Indicator Framework for each of nine thematic areas containing more than 300 indicators. The Local Indicator Framework has been prepared in line with the National and State Indicator Frameworks. The LIF will help the Gram Panchayats to build a baseline GP wise data that will ascertain the actual GP level status and enable the GPs to identify the gaps. The Localization of Sustainable Development Goals broadly calls for a Whole of Government and a Whole of Society approach involving all line Departments, NGOs and Civil Society members at State, District, Block and GP level. He expressed that the Gram Panchayats should strive hard to saturate themselves in the 9 thematic areas in a phased manner by prioritizing the themes as per the decision of Gram Sabha.

Thereafter, the Domain Experts of the State Panchayat Resource Centre (SPRC) held technical session detailing the nine thematic areas focusing on the Local Indicator Framework and the State wise status, a press release from DC (SA) said

elected PRIs as well as general public and prospective entrepreneurs on various schemes being implemented by A&NI KVIB, Govt. covered. Government of India has planned through USOF (Universal Service Obligation Fund) Project to install 52 mobile towers to provide 4G Mobile coverage to approximately 53 uncovered villages and another 34 towers to provide seamless mobile coverage on NH-04 falling in North & Middle district during this FY 2022-23. Survey for 74 sites in N&M Andaman district has been completed. This will enable both voice and high speed internet access in these villages and bridge the digital divide and provide mobile service at par with urban area.

Under Bharat Net Project, Optical Fiber connectivity to all the 7 Block HQs (BHQs) and 70 Gram Panchayats (GPs) in Andaman & Nicobar Islands is also being executed. In North & Middle Andaman district Mayabunder, Rangat Block HQs and 8 Gram Panchayats (Kishorinagar, Diglipur, Mayabunder, Rampur, Pokadera, Rangat, Parnashala, Long Island work have been completed and for the remaining target, it is expected to be completed by June 2022. This will enable provision of high speed internet access in Gram Panchayat Office/ other Government Offices and public Wi-Fi hotspots in these Gram Panchayat areas.

Another important project which is being implemented by DOT is PM-WANI Project (Prime Minister Wi-Fi Access Network Interface) to proliferate Public Wi-Fi hotspot across the country and the same has been introduced in A&N Islands on 24th December, 2021. After launch of PM-WANI scheme in A&N Islands, first PDO (Public Data Office) was commissioned at Chidiyatapu and thereafter total 30 PDOs/ Public Wi-Fi hot spots have been made operational and expected to increase multi fold with more and more public participation in A&N Islands.

In North and Middle Andaman, total 15 PM-WANI PDOs (Public Data Offices) i.e. Wi-Fi hotspots have been made operational. Small Shop owners / Entrepreneurs have been requested to make use of this opportunity and come forward to become part of this project and install more and more PDO Wi-Fi hotspots and provide high speed internet services in their locality and start earning by sale of data plan vouchers, a press release from Department of Telecom A&N Unit WB LSA said.

exceeding Rs. 30,000/- per month. In case of dependents, the income of parents/guardians should not exceed Rs. 30,000/- per month and the beneficiary should not have received assistance during last 3 years for the same purpose from any source. However, for children below 12 years of age, the minimum time of assistance is one year. It is also to mention that Income Certificate of beneficiaries staying in Orphanages and half-way homes etc. will be accepted on certification of District Collector or Head of the Organization concerned.

The documents required for availing the benefits under ADIP Scheme are recent colour passport size photograph (2 Nos), Disability Certificate (photo copy) and original for verification and entry purpose, Ration Card/Voter ID/Driving License (any one photo copy)- (of Parents/beneficiaries), Aadhaar Card (photo copy) for (beneficiaries/ parents), valid mobile number (for beneficiaries/ parents) and photocopy of Income Certificate. The Income Certificate should be valid as on date of distribution camp.

The quantum of assistance under the scheme are income upto Rs. 22,500/- per month will be provided full cost of Aid/appliance and income from Rs. 22,501/- to Rs. 30,000/- per month will be provided 50% of the cost of Aid/Appliance.

The aids & assistive devices provided under ADIP Scheme for Locomotor Disability are Tricycle, Wheel Chair (Adult), Wheel Chair (child), Auxiliary Crutch (Large), Auxiliary Crutch (Medium), Elbow Crutch (Large), Rollator (Child), Walking Stick, CP Wheel Chair and Corner Chair. For hearing impairment, Hearing Aids are provided including Mild Class (BTE), Moderate Class (BTE) and Extra Strong Class (BTE). For visual impairment, the devices provided are Smart Cane, Universal Braille Slate, Braille Slate, Tylors Frame, Abacus, Hand Magnifier, Cricket Ball, Daisy Player & Android Tablet.

Under intellectual disability, the aids provided are Teaching Learning Material (TLM) for 0-3 years, Teaching Learning Material (TLM) for 4-6 years, Teaching Learning Material (TLM) for 7-11 years and Teaching Learning Material (TLM) for 12-18 years.

Composite Regional Centre (CRC), A&N Islands is implementing ADIP Scheme in this UT. So far, 191 beneficiaries were assisted during 2019-2020, 2020-21 and 2021-2022 year and no target has been fixed by the MoSJ&E. The Centre has facilities for providing speech therapy, physiotherapy, vocational training, prosthetic and orthotic assessment, special education assessment and intellectual assessment.

Eligible and interested Divyangjan are requested to contact Directorate of Social Welfare, Goalghar or CRC, Brookshabad.
