File pertaining to transfer was initiated after completion of the enureof the employees posted in the hard areas, but final approval and issuance was put on hold due to the outbreak of the COVID-19 pandemic and VVPs visits this year. Port Blair, 28<sup>th</sup> Dec, 2021: People above 60 y ears of age with comorbidities do not need to upload or provide a medical certificate fo eligibility for the "precautionary dose" of Covid-19 vaccine, the

Centre said on Tuesday.
The decision was taken after a
meeting of the Union Health Secretary with states on Tuesday.In the meeting, it was decided that those above 60 years of age can av ail "precautionary" dose without a certificate from the doctor However, they must consult with their physicians before taking the jab.

#### No war pact

India has made it clear to Pakistan that a no-war pact between them could be in continuation and recognition of all elements of the Simla Agreement. The two countries could sign a no-war agreement provided Pakistan accepts the seven principles stipulated by India in an aide memoire to Pakistan. One of the important elements suggested by India for a no-war pact is that Pakistan should revert to bilateralism in all issues as provided for in the Simla Pact. Also Pakistan should take all steps to avert an arms race in the subcontinent. Adherence to non-alignment, respect for each other's Authentice to Thomasignment, tespect to each Other's territorial integrity and settlement of all issues bilaterally were other key points of India's missive. India is awaiting word from Pakistan about the dates of foreign minister Agha Shahi's visit to Delhi.

The Congress (S) President Sharad Pawar has suspended the Kerala Pradesh Congress (S) committee (KPCC-S) chief A K Antony, the party working committee member Vyalar Ravi and their supporters from the primary membership of the party for joining hands with the Congress (I) to form a minister in the state. Pawa also said that he had suspended the entire KPCC (S) The decision on formation of a new KPCC (S) would be taken at the working committee meeting on January 7.

# AMID STANDOFF WITH CHINA, INDIA STRENGTHENS BORDER INFRASTRUCTU

along the Line of Actual Control (LAC) in Eastern Ladakh is nowhere close to end, India has strengthened the border infrastructure for faster movement of its troops to meet any

On Tuesday, three roads and 24 bridges built by the Border Roads Organisation (BRO), many of them close to the China border, were



Minister Rajnath Singh said, keeping in view the security needs of the priority to infrastructure dev elopment in border areas, just as the focus has been on strengthening the interior parts

"Recently in the northern sector, we were able to face the adversary with determination. It could not have been possible without proper infras tructural dev elopment." Singh said. Strong infrastructure in borde areas is essential in today's "uncertain times" as it strengthens strategic capabilities. "As we move forward in the

direction of strengthening our borde infrastructure, we have to bolster ou surveillance systems as well," the defence minister said.

The new projects were completed at a cost of Rs 2,245 crore. Of the 24 bridges, nine are in Jammu Himachal Pradesh, three in Uttarakhand and one each in Sikkim and Aruna chal Pradesh. Of the three roads, two are in Ladakh and one is in West Bengal.

The main highlight was the inauguration of India's first indigenous Class 70140-feet Double-Lane Modular Bridge, built at a height of 11,000 feet at Flag HII Dokala, Sikkim and Chisumle-Demchok road at Umling La Pass at over 19 000 feet in Ladakh which also holds the Guinness World Record of world's highest motorable road.

"They will play an importantrole in strengthening the country," said Singh. He stated that the new projects will add "many new links" to BRO's "chain of records". The problems of infiltration, skirmishes, illegal trade and smuggling, etc persist inborder areas. In view of this, the government had started a Comprehensive Integrated

Border Management System sometime

One of the most important roads dedicated to the nation today is the Chisumle-Demchok Road in eastern Ladakh. hdia and Chira have notbeen able to resolve friction points in Demchok, despite multiple rounds of military and diplomatic negotiations since May 2020

"This road built at an altitude of more than 19,000 feet, on the Umling La pass in southern Ladakh, has now become the world's highestmotorable road," Singh said. "It will not only enable faster movement of armed forces to the region but will also boost tourism and improve the socioeconomic condition of the local people in the region." The Union gov emment has taken a number of steps in the last six-seven years to strengthen the BRO, including increasing their budget by three to fourtimes.

CoWN's move to add school ID cards as an identity document comes days after Prime Minister Modium eiled significant additions to India's vaccination plan amidst the Omicron variant scare. PM Modi saidthat healthcare, frontline workers and senior citizens and workers and senior citizens aged above 60 with comorbidites will be eligible to receive a third precautionary dose of vaccine from January 10th, 2022. He also said children aged 15-18 will be eligible to receive a jab starting January 3,

By some estimates, there are three crore healthcare workers, hree crore frontline workers, and sixseven crore children who will be eligible in this leg of India's v accination driv e. The gap between the second and the third dose will he atleast nine months

"Amedical certificate for senior citizens with comorbidities will be required. The new vaccination certificate after the third dose will be generated real time with a QR code, and will be verifiable. This will have details of all three doses of

vaccination and the brands used We will also be sending out SMSes to healthcare, frontline w orkers and senior citizens who will be and senior cluzens who will be eigble for vaccinaton. We willhave no challenges related to supply of vaccines," Sharma said. While it is still unclear if the

Government will go for mix ing of vaccines, wherein it may recommend a different vaccine for the third dose compared to the previous two, CoWIN is prepared to handle this scenario

"I am not sure about that, whether the thirddose will have to be different. But it should be very easy to configure in our system. The policy data file and the APIs are separate. We will be able to

Vaccination has gathered pace in India in recent months, with the country crossing the one billion or 100 crore milestone in October. While 90 percent of India's 900 million adult population have received at least one dose of vaccine, over 60 percent are fully vaccinated, with two doses of

Sharma said while the last 10 percent is always a challenge, he expected the 60 percent to reach 90 percent though he did not specify a timeline. The gov emment originally targeted full vaccination for adult by the end of 2021.


