पोर्ट ब्लेयर । पिछले दिनो अंडमान-निकोबार द्वीप समूह मे यूट्यूब पर NEWS ANI के द्वारा सोशल मिडिया पर एक समाचार प्रसारित किया गया था जिस मे दो लोग मोबाइल के माध्यम से बात चीत कर रहे है और बीच बीच मे अभ्रद भाषा का भी प्रयोग कर रहे है ।

आज तीसरी कक्षा में पढ़ने वाले विधार्थी के साथ साथ हर आयु के लोगो के पास मोबाईल फोन होता है और हर व्यक्ति सोशल मिडिया से जुड़ा हुआ है ।

अक्सर राष्ट्रीय चौनलो मे किसी भी समाचार को प्रसारित करने से पहले उस विडियो मे अगर अभ्रद भाषा का प्रयोग किया गया है तो उस जगह पर बीप-बीप की आवाज डाल दिया जाता है तथा चित्र को घुंघला कर दिया जाता है ।

आर एन आई के दिशा अनुसार किसी भी अभ्रद भाषा यह समाज को विचलित करने वाला ओडियो और विडियो को किसी भी चौनलो मे नही दिखाया जा सकता है । अंडमान–निकोबार द्वीप समूह स्थित यूट्यूब के माध् यम से चलाये जा रहे एक न्यूज चौनल NEWSANI के द्वारा CHAPTER 2 नाम से यहाँ के सोशल मिडिया (व्टसप ग्रूप) मे एक समाचार दिखाया गया था जिसमे दो व्यक्तियों के बीच बात चीत को बिना ऐडिट किया प्रसारित कर दिया गया था जो कि आर एन आई के द्वारा जारी किये गये दिशा र्निदेश का खुला उल्लघंन है और अंडमान—निकोबार पुलिस पूरी तरह से इस बात से बेखबर है ।

NEWS ANI के द्वारा दिखाया गया समाचार को अंडमान-निकोबार पुलिस अपने संज्ञान मे लेते हुए तुरंत ही इस यूट्यूब समाचार चौनल पर कानूनी कारवाही करे ताकि सोशल मिडिया का दुरुपयोग ना हो ।

यहां पर रहने वाले लोगो के अनुसार दक्षिण अंडमान तथा मध्य उत्तर अंडमान मे बार लाईसेंस जारी तथा नवीनीकरण मामले मे बहुत ही ऊंचे स्तर पर लाखो रुपयों मे लेन—देन होने की खबर है मगर यह पता नही चला है की लेन-देन सीघे होता है यह फिर बिचौलियों के माध्यम से होता है । दोनो ही जिलो मे ऐसे कई बार है जो बन कर तैयार है तथा कई

बारो का नवीनीकरण होना है मगर लेन—देन मे की ऊंची बोली की वजह से लाईसेंस तथा नवीनीकरण मे देरी हो रहा है ।

आम लोगो का कहना है की आज अंडमान–निकोबार द्वीप समूह शराब की खपत मे देश मे पहले स्थान पर पहुंच गया है और आबादी का 35% पुरुष तथा 9% महिलाएं शराब के आदि हो गये है और 23% आबादी ऐसी है जो बिना शराब के रह नही सकते है और सबसे अर्श्चय चिकत करने वाली बात यहां पर यह है कि 14 साल के उम्र मे ही बच्चे शराब पीने लगते है जोकि आने वाले दिनों में खतरे का बड़ा संकेत है ।

क्या शराब के बढ़ते कारोबार को देखते हुए बार का लाईसेंस तथा नवीनीकरण के लिए संबधित विभागो के द्वारा बिचौलियों के माध्यम से ऊंची बोली लगाया जा रहा है । अगर इस बात मे सच्चाई है तो इस मामले की एक उच्च स्तरीय जांच होनी चहिए क्यूंकि बार के मालिक अपना रुपया निकालने के लिए बहुत ही घटिया किस्म का शराब मंहगे बोतलो में भरकर ग्राहकों को पिलायेंगे जोकि उनकी स्वस्थ्य के लिए बहुत ही हानिकारक होगा ।

नियामक से अनुमति मांगी है. हैदराबाद की कंपनी ने 29 अप्रैल को भारत के औषधि महानियंत्रक (DCGI) के समक्ष आवेदन करके कोवैक्सीन की बूस्टर खुराक के दो से 18 वर्ष के बच्चों पर परीक्षण की अनुमति मांगी है.'' यह अध ययन अखिल भारतीय आयुर्विज्ञान संस्थान (AHMS), दिल्ली और पटना सहित 6 स्थानों पर किया जाएगा.

नई दिल्लीः भारत बायोटेक ने 2 वर्ष से 18 वर्ष आयु वर्ग के बच्चों पर कोवैक्सीन की बूस्टर खुराक (Covaxin Booster Dose) संबंधी दूसरे/ तीसरे चरण के परीक्षण के लिए औषधि नियामक से अनुमति मांगी है. सूत्रों ने 'पीटीआई—भाषा' को यह जानकारी दी. फिलहाल कोवैक्सीन और कोविशील्ड की एहतियाती खुराक 18 वर्ष और उससे अधिक आयु के वैसे लोगों को दी जाती है, जिन्हें दूसरी खुराक लिये हुए 9 महीने पूरे हो चुके हैं.

इस घटनाक्रम की जानकारी रखने वाले एक सूत्र ने पीटीआई—भाषा को बताया, ''हैदराबाद की कंपनी ने 29 अप्रैल को भारत के औषधि महानियंत्रक (DCGI) के समक्ष आवेदन करके कोवैक्सीन की बूस्टर खुराक के दो से 18 वर्ष के बच्चों पर परीक्षण की अनुमित मांगी है." यह अध्ययन अखिल भारतीय आयुर्विज्ञान संस्थान (AHMS), दिल्ली और पटना सहित 6 स्थानों पर किया जाएगा.

सावधान! कोरोना वायरस हवा में भी फैल सकता है, अध्ययन से हुई पुष्टि भारत ने गत 10 अप्रैल को 18 वर्ष की आयु के ऊपर के सभी व्यक्तियों के लिए निजी टीका केंद्रों में एहतियाती खुराक की अनुमति दी थी. फिलहाल कोरोना वायरस से बचाव के लिए कोर्बेवैक्स वैक्सीन 12 से 14 वर्ष की आयू वाले बच्चों को लगाई जा रही है.


