

Ban on identified Single Use Plastic Items from 1st July National and State level Control Rooms to be set up for checking illegal manufacture, import, stocking, distribution, sale and use of banned single use plastic items

Success of the ban possible only through effective engagement and concerted actions by all stakeholders

Public Participation critical to banning SUPs

New Delhi, June 28 (PIB)

In line with the clarion call given by Hon'ble Prime Minister of India, Shri Narendra Modi, to phase out single use plastic items by 2022, Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, Government of India notified the Plastic Waste Management Amendment Rules, 2021, on 12th August, 2021. Carrying forward the spirit of 'Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsava', a defining step to curb pollution caused by littered and unmanaged plastic waste is being taken by the country. India will ban manufacture, import, stocking, distribution, sale and use of identified single use plastic items, which have low utility and high littering potential, all across the country from July 1, 2022.

The adverse impacts of littered single use plastic items on both terrestrial and aquatic ecosystems, including in marine environment are globally recognized. Addressing pollution due to single use plastic items has become an important environmental challenge confronting all countries.

In the 4th United Nations Environment Assembly held in 2019, India had piloted a resolution on



addressing single-use plastic products pollution, recognizing the urgent need for the global community to focus on this very important issue. The adoption of this resolution at UNEA 4 was a significant step. In the recently concluded 5th session of United Nations Environment Assembly in March, 2022, India engaged constructively with all member States to develop consensus on the resolution for driving global action on plastic pollution.

The Government of India has taken resolute steps for mitigation of pollution caused by littered Single Use Plastics. The list of banned items

includes -ear buds with plastic sticks, plastic sticks for balloons, plastic flags, candy sticks, ice-cream sticks, polystyrene (Thermocol) for decoration, plastic plates, cups, glasses, cutlery such as forks, spoons, knives, straw, trays, wrapping or packing films around sweet boxes, invitation cards, cigarette packets, plastic or PVC banners less than 100 micron, stirrers.

The Plastic Waste Management Amendment Rules, 2021, also prohibit manufacture, import, stocking, distribution, sale and use of plastic carry bags having thickness less than seventy five microns with effect from 30th September, 2021, and having thickness less than thickness of one hundred and twenty microns with effect from the 31st December, 2022.

The Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change has also notified the Guidelines on Extended Producers Responsibility on plastic packaging as Plastic Waste Management Amendment Rules, 2022 on 16th February, 2022. Extended Producer Responsibility (EPR) is responsibility of a producer for the

Six airbags to be made mandatory in eight-seater vehicles: Transport Minister

New Delhi, June 28

Road Transport and Highways Minister, Shri Nitin Gadkari has said that the Government will make it mandatory for carmakers to provide a minimum of six airbags in motor vehicles that can carry upto eight passengers.

Addressing 'Intel India's Safety Pioneers Conference 2022', Shri Gadkari said that every year, around 1.5 lakh people are killed in five lakh accidents across

the country. An airbag is a vehicle occupant-restraint system which interferes between the driver and the vehicle's dashboard during a collision, thereby preventing serious injuries. Shri Gadkari said, we need cooperation from all stakeholders including automobile industry. In January, Ministry of Road Transport and Highways had said that to enhance the safety of occupants of motor

Providing weighing machines for consumers to weigh LPG cylinder during distribution mandatory: Deptt. of CS&CA

Port Blair, June 28

It is for the information of all LPG consumers and the authorized LPG distributors of this UT that as per the Legal Metrology (Packaged Commodities) Rules, 2011 framed under the Legal Metrology Act, 2009, it is mandatory for all the authorized LPG distributors to provide to their delivery man a

check weigher or non-automatic weighing instrument to measure or weigh the quantity of the LPG cylinder at the time of delivery.

The consumers have the right to demand weighing of LPG cylinders at the time of delivery, so as to ensure exact quantity being delivered to them. The weight of a domestic

LPG cylinder is weight of empty cylinder + 14.2 kg of LPG filled in it with a maximum permissible error of 150 gm. Similarly, the weight of a 19 kg commercial LPG cylinder is weight of empty cylinder + 19 kg of LPG filled in it with a maximum permissible error of 1% and that for a 5 kg commercial LPG

24358, beneficiaries in the age group of 12-14 years administered both doses of vaccine till date, out of which 13,272 beneficiaries have been vaccinated with first dose while 11086 have been administered second dose. The number of

beneficiaries administered vaccine so far stood at 27,378.

environmentally sound management of the product until the end of its life. The Guidelines will provide framework to strengthen circular economy of plastic packaging waste, promote development of new alternatives to plastic packaging and provide next steps for moving towards sustainable plastic packaging by businesses.

Capacity building workshops are being organized for MSME units to provide them technical assistance for manufacturing of alternatives to banned single use plastic items with the involvement of CPCB/SPCBs/PCCs along with Ministry of Small Micro and Medium Enterprises and Central Institute of Petrochemicals Engineering (CIPET) and their State Centres. Provisions have also been made to support such enterprises in transitioning away from banned single use plastics.

The Government of India has also taken steps to promote innovation and provide an ecosystem for accelerated penetration and availability of alternatives all across the country.

For effective enforcement of ban on identified SUP items from 1st July, 2022, National and State Level Control Rooms will be set up and Special Enforcement Teams will be formed for checking illegal manufacture, import, stocking, distribution, sale and use of banned single use plastic items. States and Union Territories have been asked to set up border check points to stop inter-State movement of any banned single use plastic items.

CPCB Grievance Redressal App has been launched to empower citizens to help curb plastic menace. For wider public outreach, PRAKRITI - mascot was also launched on 5th April.

The Government has been taking measures for awareness generation towards elimination of single use plastics. The awareness campaign has brought together entrepreneurs and startups, industry, Central, State and Local Governments, regulatory bodies, experts, citizens organizations, R& D and academic institutions. The success of the ban will only be possible through effective engagement and concerted actions by all stakeholders and enthusiastic public participation, believes the Ministry.

cylinder is weight of empty cylinder + 5 kg of LPG filled in it with a maximum permissible error of 1.5%. The empty weight of LPG cylinder is printed on the body of the cylinder.

The distributor shall get the weighing machine duly verified and stamped from the Legal Metrology Section functioning in the Directorate of Civil Supplies & Consumer Affairs prior to using it for any commercial transaction.

All the authorized LPG distributors have been informed to strictly comply with the Rules and make necessary arrangements for weighing of LPG cylinders during delivery latest by 30th June, 2022, failing which, strict action as per law shall be initiated against the distributor.

The Department of Civil Supplies & Consumer Affairs has been relentlessly working towards safeguarding the interest of the consumers. All the consumers have been advised that any malpractice by any person/shop/establishment may be brought to the notice of the Department of CS&CA over Toll Free No. 1800-345-3197 or Telephone No. 03192-230337, a press release from Directorate of CS&CA said.
