New Delhi, Oct. 21

Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) plans to launch Chandrayaan-3, its third mission to the moon, in June next year. Interacting with media personnel on the sidelines of an event in Delhi, ISRO Chairman, Shri S. Somnath said C-3 is ready now.

ISRO has made Launch Vehicle Mark-3 (LVM3)



more robust so that it does not have any problems. He added that the space agency has also lined up the first test flight of the 'abort mission' for Gaganyaan, the country's first human spaceflight, early next year.

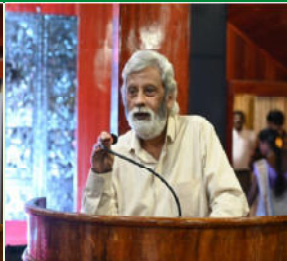

Commemoration of anniversary of establishment of Provisional Govt. of Azad Hind (PGI)

Speakers highlight contribution of Subhas Chandra Bose in freedom struggle

Port Blair, Oct. 21

As part of week-long activities to commemorate the anniversary of the establishment of Provisional Govt. of Azad Hind (PGI) from Oct.17 to 23, 2022, a programme was held today at the historic Andaman Club in which the eminent historians highlighted the immense contribution of Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose in the freedom struggle. Terming Subhash Chandra Bose as a great son of mother India, the speakers remarked that he was widely regarded as the

most powerful freedom fighter, who played a pivotal role in instilling the feeling of patriotism and motivating the Indian masses towards attaining freedom. The programme was organized by the Department of Art & Culture as part of commemoration of Anniversary of the establishment of Provisional Govt. of Azad Hind (PGI).

Eminent historian, Shri Gauri Shankar Pandey while speaking on the occasion highlighted the significance of A&N Islands in India's freedom movement. He narrated

the historical importance of Viper Island & Cellular Jail where freedom fighters were imprisoned. Shri Gauri Shankar also enlightened the gathering about the visit of Netaji to A&N Islands and the hoisting of the National Flag on Dec. 30, 1943, declaring A&N Islands, first Indian Territory to be liberated from the clutches of the British rulers.

In his address, Shri Mukeshwar Lal, eminent historian and owner of Kalapani Museum spoke about the history of freedom struggle with special reference to A&N Islands. He also

mentioned about the great escape of Netaji, establishment of Provisional Govt. of free India and Netaji's visit to A&N Islands as the Supreme Commander of Provisional Govt. of Azad Hind.

Speaking on the occasion, the Secretary, Art & Culture, Shri Hari Kallikkat, IAS stated that the younger generation should draw inspiration from the sacrifices of the great freedom fighters who fought for liberating the country from the shackles of Britishers. He said that 6 surviving members of

Hon'ble Supreme Court directions on crackers

Crackers with reduced emission and green crackers with QR code will only be permitted to be sold

Port Blair, Oct. 21

In pursuance of order passed by Hon'ble Supreme Court of India on 29-10-2021 in the matter of I.A. No. 44727/2021 in Writ Petition (Civil) No.728 of 2015 titled as Arjun Gopal and others -vs- Union of India and others (Firecrackers case), the directions issued by

Hon'ble Supreme Court are reiterated below for compliance by the general public:

> The crackers with reduced emission (improved crackers) and green crackers with QR code would be permitted to be manufactured and sold. > The manufacture, sale and

use of joined firecrackers (series crackers or laris) is hereby banned as the same causes huge air, noise and solid waste problems.

> No e-commerce websites, including Flipkart, Amazon, etc., shall accept any online orders and effect online sales. Any such e-

commerce companies found selling crackers online will be hauled up for contempt of court and the Court may also pass, in that eventuality, orders of monetary penalties as well.

> Firecrackers with Barium salts is banned.

Two-time champions West Indies were knocked out of T20 World Cup after losing to Ireland in their final Group B clash of the ongoing tournament on Friday. Ireland defeated West Indies by 9 wickets in the game at Bellerive Oval in Hobart. Chasing 147 runs, Ireland reached home in 17.3 overs. Paul Stirling's 66

not out and Lorcan Tucker's unbeaten 45 made the chase easy for Ireland. Earlier, Brandon King played an unbeaten knock of 62 runs as West Indies posted 146 for 5 in 20 overs. For Ireland, Gareth Delany returned with three wickets. Windies skipper Nicholas Pooran had won the toss and opted to bat

first. Qualifier matches have now concluded, with four teams advancing to the Super 12 round. Final Super 12 teams in Group 1 are Australia, New Zealand, Afghanistan, England, Sri Lanka, Ireland and in Group 2 are India, Pakistan, Bangladesh, South Africa, Netherlands, and Zimbabwe.

Low pressure over Andaman Sea & adjoining Southeast Bay of Bengal; fishermen advised not to venture into sea till Oct. 23

Port Blair, Oct. 21

Heavy rain (07-11 cm) is likely to occur at one or two places over Andaman Islands on Oct. 22 & 23. Due to the low pressure area over Andaman Sea and adjoining Southeast Bay of Bengal and likely intensification of the system, fishermen have been advised not to venture into the sea till 23rd October, 2022. For
