"No district should be without full vaccination": Minister

New Delhi, Oct. 28 (PIB)

"Har Ghar Dastak campaign to start soon in the poor performing districts to enthuse and motivate people towards full COVID vaccination". This was stated today by Union Minister for Health and Family Welfare, Dr. Mansukh Mandaviya during the national review meeting with Health Ministers of various States held yesterday. Union Minister of State for Health and Family Welfare, Dr. Bharati Pravin Pawar was also present during the



national review meeting. State Health Ministers participated in the review meeting. The meeting was attended on behalf of A&N Administration by Secretary (Health).

Highlighting the need to accelerate the pace and coverage of vaccination, he stated

that there are more than 10.34 crore people in the country who have not taken the second dose after the prescribed interval. The Union Health Minister stated that adequate vaccine doses were available in the country, and more than 12 crore balance unutilised doses are

available with the States for administering. "No district should be without full vaccination", he exhorted the States. He further added- "Let us aim to cover all eligible with 1st dose of COVID-19 vaccine by end of November 2021".

The State Health Ministers were requested to ensure continuous oversight on progress of the national COVID-19 Vaccination Programme. Dr. Mandaviya urged the State/ to make regional and local level plans with all the stakeholders to reduce number of people with vaccination overdue. He also urged for innovative strategies to encourage them to achieve their targets to review the planning and execution of district-wise plans for

Supreme Court clears the way for declaration of NEET-UG results

New Delhi, Oct. 28

The Supreme Court on Thursday cleared the way for the National Testing Agency (NTA) to declare the results of the NEET-UG 2021 examination by staying Bombay High Court decision to conduct fresh exams for two

aspirants. The aspirants had complained in the court that they were handed question papers and answer sheets with different serial numbers.

A Bench led by Justice L. Nageswara Rao froze the High Court order, allowing the NEET

results to be declared. The Bench said it would consider the case of the two students, including what could be done for them, in detail later.

"These students cannot be left in the lurch. The invigilator has accepted

Vaccination- shield against the virus 4, 88,212 doses of vaccines administered to beneficiaries in Isles so far

Port Blair, Oct. 28

Vaccination drive to vaccinate maximum number of eligible beneficiaries of 18 above age group in the entire Island Territory is continuing and the percentage of population vaccinated so far in Isles stands at 73.37%, with 1662 eligible beneficiaries vaccinated today. So far 4, 88,212 doses have been administered to beneficiaries in A&N

Islands. The Health Department is making best efforts to cover maximum number of eligible beneficiaries by vaccinating them through its designated vaccination centres spread over the Islands to keep the corona virus at bay.

As per data available, the cumulative beneficiaries vaccinated with first dose so far is 2,93,466 (102.61%) while

cumulative beneficiaries vaccinated with second dose so far is 1,94,746 (66.36%).

Meanwhile, 1287 beneficiaries were vaccinated in South Andaman District, out of which, 73 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44 years. Similarly, 300 beneficiaries were vaccinated in North & Middle Andaman District, out of which, 8 beneficiaries were in

Food Safety Deptt. regularly conducts inspection & sampling at fruit, vegetable & fish markets

FBOs urged to refrain from using any chemicals or preservatives in food items

Port Blair, Oct. 28

The Food Safety Department under District Administration is regularly conducting inspections and sampling of all kinds of food articles like cereals, pulses, spices and condiments, edible oils, beverages, packaged drinking water, sweets and sweet meats, bakery products, savouries, milk and milk products etc.

Inspections and sampling at fruit, vegetable & fish markets besides animal slaughtering places are also being carried out regularly. The Food Safety regulators as well as technical team of Mobile Food Testing Laboratory are also conducting awareness drives among the general public as well as Food Business Operators and sensitizing all concerned regarding the adverse effects of food adulteration, use of chemicals like carbide/acetylene gas for artificial ripening of fruits and use of ammonia/formalin for preservation of fish

products etc. So far, the Department has collected 231 samples of fruits and vegetables for its analysis through NABL accredited and FSSAI notified laboratory. Out of the 231 samples, reports of 221 samples have been received and all the samples were found free from adulterants or other chemicals. The reports of 10 samples are awaited. The Clause 2.3.5 of (Prohibition & Restriction of Sales) Regulations, 2011, provides that fresh fruits may be artificially ripened by use of

ethylene gas at a concentration upto 100 ppm depending upon the crop, variety and maturity since ethylene, being a natural hormone does not pose any health hazard to consumers.

Further, clause 2.3.6 of (Prohibition & Restriction of Sales) Regulations, 2011, fresh fruits may be coated with bee wax (white and yellow) or carnauba wax or shellac wax at level not exceeding Good Manufacturing Practices under proper label declaration as provided under clause 2.4.5(44) of Food Safety and Standards (Packaging and Labeling) Regulations, 2011.

The Food Safety Department is also keeping a strict vigil on all food products arriving from mainland and samples are also collected for its analysis. The Commissioner Food Safety, Andaman & Nicobar Islands/Deputy Commissioner, South Andaman District has warned all the FBOs to refrain from using any

Media briefed on COVID-19

One positive case detected during test conducted on incoming flight passengers: Secretary (IP&T)

Port Blair, Oct. 28

The Secretary (IP&T), Shri Sunil Kumar Singh addressing the media briefing on COVID-19 held in the conference hall of IP&T today stated that during the RT-PCR test conducted on 491 passengers who arrived here yesterday, one positive case has been detected. Today, 8 flights with 1404 passengers arrived, out of which, 889 were vaccinated with both doses while RT-PCR test was conducted on



remaining 515 passengers and the reports are awaited. RAT was conducted on 142 passengers bound for North & Middle Andaman at Ferrargunj and no positive case has been detected. At Mohanpura Bus Terminus, test was conducted on 122 passengers and all were found negative. At

Phoenix Bay jetty RAT was conducted on 20 passengers and all were found negative.

The Secretary further stated that today till 3 pm, 486 persons were vaccinated, out of which, 451 were in the age group of 18-44 years.

The Deputy Director, GB Pant Hospital, Dr. Amitabha De informed that one patient is undergoing treatment at GB Pant Hospital and no COVID patients are there in COVID Care Centres.

Torch ginger (Etlingeraelatio) - a new addition to flower basket

Torch ginger (Etlingeraelatio) belonging to the family Zingiberaceae is a popular cut flower known for its versatility and durability. The extravagant and showy inflorescence with bright colour of the species makes it highly suitable to be used as cut flower. The clumps are vigorous, with the emission of vegetative and floral stems in the periphery and in the center of the clump. It shows robust growth, when planted in moist and shady condition. The inflorescences show colors that vary from red and pink to white, which grow directly from the rhizome. In the Island, three accessions namely red (Accession 1), pink with red tinge (Accession 2) and baby pink (Accession 3) and all the three performed well in partial shade condition. The species is commercially propagated by clumps and planted at a spacing of 1.5 to 2.0 m. Flowering is initiated one year after planting. Number of flowers per clump per year ranges from 25- 55 and maximum was observed in accession 3 (Baby pink) followed by accession 1 (Red). Flowering is not seasonal however, during summer flower production is less. The shelf life of harvested flowers ranges from 3 to 5 days and remains for about 10 days while intact with plant. The stalk length ranges from 50 to 70 cm and suitable for packing to export market. The flowers are to be harvested at fully opened stage.

Benefit: The tropical humid climate of Island is highly congenial for growing this cut flower by both amateurs and entrepreneurs. Commercial cultivation of this species can also be exploited owing to the growing tourism industry in the Island.

Surface to Surface Ballistic Missile 'Agni-5' successfully launched

A successful launch of the Surface to Surface Ballistic Missile, Agni-5, was carried out yesterday at approximately 1950 hrs from APJ Abdul Kalam Island, Odisha. The missile, which uses a three-stage solid fuelled engine, is capable of striking targets at ranges up to 5,000 kilometres with a very high degree of accuracy.



The successful test of Agni-5 is in line with India's stated policy to have 'credible minimum deterrence' that underpins the commitment to 'No First Use'.

The court reiterated that there was no reason to withhold the results because of a complaint made by two students. The future of lakhs of students was at stake. There are 16 lakhs students who are eagerly waiting for the results.

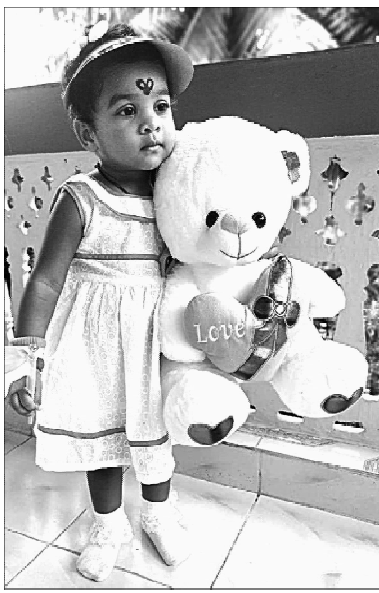

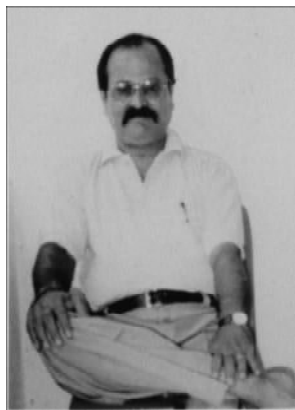

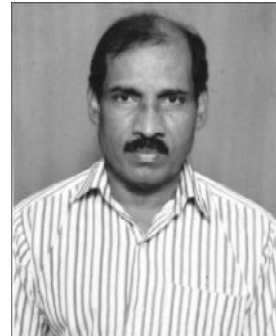
