

## Why does Nepal's aviation industry have safety issues? An expert explains

A Yeti Airlines ATR 72-500 aircraft crashed in Pokhara in central Nepal on January 15 2023, killing at least 69 people on board. The aircraft was en route from Nepal's capital Kathmandu to Pokhara, the country's second largest city, situated under the picturesque Annapurna mountain range.

While the picturesque landscape of the country appeals to tourists, it poses significant challenges to aviation operators, who need to embrace and navigate the challenging environment. The air crash on Sunday was Nepal's worst aviation disaster since 1992. The country has been working to overcome its challenges in aviation.

**A challenging landscape** Topography has gifted Nepal with picturesque landscapes, but posits unrivalled challenges to flight operations.

Nepal, situated between India and China, is home to eight of the world's 14 highest mountains, including Mount Everest or Sagarmatha. For flight op-

erations, it's an almost unrivalled, harsh environment with sudden weather changes that can make for hazardous conditions.

Airports built in mountainous regions often need to have shorter runways that can only accommodate turboprop-powered regional aircraft, rather than large jet airliners that can access larger cities in Nepal.

As a result, aviation carriers in Nepal have a variety of aircraft on their fleets. These craft vary in condition, presenting potential safety hazards.

The ATR 72 aircraft is one typical aircraft used by Nepali carriers. It is a turboprop-powered regional aircraft with a capacity between 44 and 78 passengers. These aircraft are manufactured by a joint venture of Airbus in France and Leonardo in Italy.

The aircraft involved in this crash had been in service for 15 years, a fairly typical age for an aircraft.

The final report on what happened to the tragic Yeti Airlines flight will take over a month to complete.

### A growing and fast-changing industry

Nepal has welcomed private investment into its aviation sector since 1992. Yeti Airlines is one of 20 domestic carriers. The airline, headquartered in Kathmandu, flies to ten domestic destinations using ATR 72-500 aircraft. In addition, 29 international airlines operate into Nepal's capital too.

With air travel in Nepal becoming more accessible and affordable, airport infrastructure development has remained far behind compared to the growth of air traffic. This has resulted in increasing congestion at airports, fare competition between airlines, and decreased safety records.

In fact, the country has recorded at least 350 casualties associated with aeroplanes or helicopters since 2000, which has raised questions about the effectiveness of its aviation safety regulations.

The aviation regulator in charge is the Civil Aviation Authority of Nepal, a government agency established in 1998.

## Davos 2023: Impossible for China to return to planned economy, says vice-premier



Chinese Vice-Premier Liu He told the World Economic Forum that China will support the growth of the private economy in 2023, and that it was impossible for the country's to return to a planned economy. Liu, who has been vice premier since 2018 and is considered to be China's economic tsar, said at the forum that it was impossible for China to take

the path of a planned economy as some claimed.

Liu did not specify who made the claims but his repudiation of an economic model associated with China's Maoist past comes at a time when Beijing is looking to signal to the world that economy, rather than controlling Covid, was back at the top of its agenda.

Andaman Wild Pig Meat and 02 Kgs. Spotted Deer meat inside the Bag. On hearing the sound of affray, the remaining team member also reached the spot and nabbed the accused person on the spot red handed and seized the meat from his possession. In the meantime the Range Officer, Bakultala Mr. S.P. Roy himself also reached the spot and arrested the accused

person namely Mr. Romanus Dhanwar S/o. Mr. Noas Dhanwar R/o. Kalsi. Later the accused person was produced to the Honorable Court of Chief Judicial Magistrate. Mayabunder on 15/01/2023 and sent him to judicial custody for 14 days.

## Rapido moves SC against Bombay HC order to stop operations in Maha: Report

The Supreme Court on Tuesday agreed to hear on January 23 plea of Rapido, the bike taxi and auto aggregator, challenging the Bombay High Court order which directed it to stop operation in Maharashtra immediately as it does not have a license to operate bike taxi or rickshaw services. A bench headed by Chief Justice of India DY Chandrachud agreed to list the matter for Monday after it was mentioned before it.

The Bombay High Court last week directed Roppen Transportation Services Private Limited, which operates bike taxi aggregator Rapido, to shut operations immediately as the startup is yet to receive a licence to operate from the Maharashtra government. Accordingly, the bike taxi aggregator Rapido was to



close down all its services till January 20. The High Court pulled up a Pune-based bike taxi aggregator for operating without procuring a licence from the Maharashtra government and directed it to suspend the services immediately. Roppen Transportation moved the High Court against a communication issued to it by the Maharashtra government on December 29,

2022, refusing to grant them a bike taxi aggregator licence.

The government cited the reason that there was no state policy on licensing of bike taxis and there was no fare structure policy.

The State government has told the High Court that a committee has been set up to explore the formulation of guidelines for bike taxis in the State.

## Passenger opens emergency door of IndiGo flight, DGCA orders probe

A passenger on board a Tiruchirapalli-bound IndiGo flight opened the emergency door, triggering panic among the co-passengers.

As the incident came into the light, the Directorate General of Civil Aviation (DGCA) ordered a probe into the matter.

The incident took place on December 10, 2022 when a passenger accidentally opened the emergency exit doors of IndiGo flight 6E 7339 from Chennai to Tiruchirapalli during the boarding process.

In its statement, the DGCA said, "A passenger travelling on Flight 6E 7339 from Chennai to Tiruchirapalli on Dec 10, 2022, accidentally opened the emergency exit during the boarding process.

The passenger immediately apologised for their action."

"As per SOPs, the incident was logged and the aircraft underwent mandatory engineering checks, which led to a delay in the flight's departure", the statement further said.

On January 14, an Indigo Madurai-Delhi flight was diverted to the Indore airport after a 60-year-old passenger's health deteriorated mid-air. The passenger was taken to the hospital where the doctors declared him brought dead.

A passenger named Shankar Mishra is already in 14-day judicial custody for allegedly urinating on a 70-year-old woman in an intoxicated condition in the business class of an Air India New York-New Delhi flight in November 2022.


