

PM chairs 39th PRAGATI Interaction

Prime Minister stressed upon timely completion of projects to avoid cost overruns

Poshan Abhiyan should be implemented in mission mode



New Delhi, Nov. 24 (PIB)

Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi today chaired the meeting of 39th edition of PRAGATI, the ICT based multi-modal platform for Pro-Active Governance and Timely Implementation, involving Centre and State governments. In the meeting, nine agenda items were taken for review including eight projects and one scheme.

Among the eight projects, three projects were from the Ministry of Railways, two projects each were from the Ministry of Road Transport & Highways and Ministry of Power and one project was from the Ministry of

Petroleum & Natural Gas. These eight projects, having a cumulative cost of about Rs. 20,000 crores, are concerning seven States viz. Bihar, Madhya Pradesh, Rajasthan, Andhra Pradesh, Gujarat, Maharashtra and West Bengal. Prime Minister stressed upon timely completion of projects to avoid cost overruns.

During the interaction, the Prime Minister also reviewed Poshan Abhiyan. He said that Poshan Abhiyan should be



implemented in mission mode in each State with a whole of Government approach. He also talked about participation of Self-Help Groups (SHGs) and other local organizations in promoting awareness about children's health and nutrition at the grassroot level, which will help in improving the reach and uptake of the Abhiyaan. Upto the 38th editions of PRAGATI meetings, 303 projects having a total cost of Rs. 14.64 lakh crore have been reviewed.

Media briefed on COVID-19 No positive case detected during test conducted on incoming flight passengers: Director (IP&T)

Port Blair, Nov. 24

The Director (IP&T), Shri Alok Kumar while giving information on COVID-19 status stated that during the RT-PCR test conducted on 414 passengers and the test conducted on 414 passengers who arrived here yesterday, no positive case has been detected. Today, 11 flights with 1,960 passengers arrived, out of which, 1529 were vaccinated with both doses while RT-PCR test was conducted on 431 passengers and the reports are awaited. Farmers' Corner- A Knowledge Hub

Dweep - Carp Grower Feed

Andaman and Nicobar Island aquaculture are known for its huge demand for freshwater fishes. The ever-growing demand of freshwater fishes holds a great potential for the island farmers to venture into the domain of freshwater aquaculture. In freshwater aquaculture, around 60% of the operational cost is spent on feed and feeding management practices which are also considered as a critical input for the successful aquaculture practices. The extensive method of fish farming with less or no inputs and lack of knowledge on supplementary feeding is the main reason behind 8 to 10 times lower freshwater fish production in the Islands. At present, the expansion of fish culture has been severely hampered due to lack of good quality fish feeds. With this background, a small scale fish feed mill was established by ICAR-CIARI with a production capacity of 80 to 100 kg per hour and CIARI-Carp Grower Feed has been developed. The carp grower feed was formulated with 25% protein and 6% lipid content which can be fed to the Indian major carps from fingerling to adult stages.

Benefit: Proper feeding practices enables the farmers to increase the stocking density of fishes thereby enhance the unit production in existing culture system. The developed technology will be disseminated to the interested stakeholders in order to promote feed-based aquaculture in these Islands. Using the locally available feed ingredients, the farmers will be able to produce fish feed at an affordable price resulting in proper feeding of fishes which leads to increased production as well as development of aquaculture sector in the Islands.
