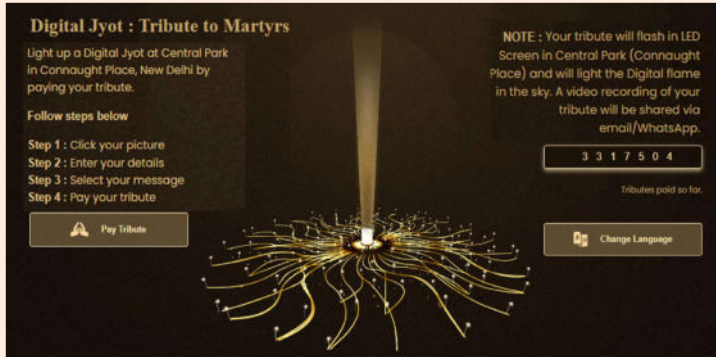

During the visit, the District Magistrate, South Andaman directed the NHIDCL authorities for repair

and renovation of the damaged patches of road immediately and N H I D C L representative were asked to send the status of roads before and after the repair works. The officials also inspected Dhanikhari bridge project proposal site and assured the NHIDCL authorities for processing the revenue land after due process.
