Port Blair, Oct 25: Resentment is running high among 37 contract employees of the National Rural Health Mission (NRHM) in North and Middle Andaman Dis-

trict as they haven't got their salary incentives and increment since last March 2022.

National Health Mission (NHM) employees have been suffering heavily due to non-payment of incentive and increment since last March.

A sizable number of

medical professionals was employed under NRHM in the Health Service of Andaman and Nicobar Islands and as per report, there are about 41 doctors, 88 ANMs, 98 CHOs and paramedical staffs are working in different CHCs & PHSc.

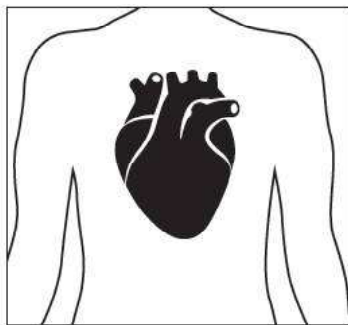

Special Campaign-2.0-Swachhata Abhiyan and Traditional hut of Nicobarese tribe to be installed, in Museum Campus



Port Blair, Oct 25: Under the Special Campaign 2.0 of the Swachhata Abhiyan, Andaman & Nicobar Regional Centre, Port Blair carried out a series of cleanliness activities in and around the office and museum building from 2-19 October, 2022. Special cleanliness drive was carried out by clearing the bushes and garbage behind the office cum library building (on 2 October), behind the administrative cum Museum building (10 October), at the entrance gate of Zonal Anthropological Museum (ZAM) on 17 October 2022. All the staff of ANRC, Port Blair participated actively by cleaning the area and disposed of all the accumulated garbage and weeding out the grasses from the garden to create a visitors friendly ambience at the entrance gate of the museum building.

Special drive towards utilization of unused museum campus and lying as dump yard for years has been initiated after clearing

the bushy, non timber plants, wild grasses and traditional dwelling unit/hut of Nicobarese tribe of Nicobar island will be raised/constructed with the natural materials available from the habitat of the tribe to maintain the indignity and with the involvement of tribal leader/captain of Tribal Council as well as assistance of other local people.

As the tourists to Andaman are restricted to travel to Nicobar group of Islands (as declared the whole Nicobar Archipelago as tribal reserve area due to its tribal dominated locale) the display of traditional Nicobarese hut will be a place of tourist's attraction. Moreover, our museum in Port Blair is an important tourist centre and situated in the heart of the town this live size Nicobarese hut will add value to the Museum as well as the Port Blair town. In the year 2004, due to catastrophic natural disaster caused by Tsunami, most of the traditional bee-

hive dwellings had submerged due to high sea waves. As a part of reviving such traditional hut and for showcasing to the public, ANRC, Port Blair is initiating the work for installation with the active participation of the community members.

Under this special campaign 2.0, other initiatives are being planned to portray the tribal culture of Andaman and Nicobar Islands, the traditional dwelling unit /hut of the particularly Vulnerable Tribal groups like Jarawa, and Shompen will be raised/constructed in the museum premises in collaboration with AAJVS & Tribal Welfare department. The Bushy backyard of the Office cum Auditorium building will be made a cultural landscape by planting flower saplings, medicinal plants (used by the tribal as well as local) and other ornamental plants towards beautifying the office premises in collaboration with CIARI, and a place of tourist attraction.

Implementation of Prime Minister's Formalization of Micro Food Processing Enterprise

Port Blair, Oct. 25: The Department of Industries is implementing a Centrally Sponsored Scheme 'Prime Minister's Formalization of Micro Food Processing Enterprise (PM FME)' launched by Ministry of Food Processing Industries, Govt. of India under Atmanirbhar Bharat Abhiyaan with the objective to strengthen backward/ forward linkages, common infrastructure, packaging, branding & marketing of products pertaining to micro food processing enterprises. Under this scheme, financial assistance in the form of credit-linked subsidy @ 35% of the eligible project cost with a maximum ceiling of Rs. 10.00 lakh per unit would be provided to Individual Entrepreneurs/ Proprietorship Firms/ Partnership Firms/ Farmer Producers Organization (FPOs)/ NGOs/ SHGs/ Co-operatives/ Pvt. Talking to Andaman Sheekha Daily, a few of these Staffs (Community Health Officer (CHO) and Mid-Level Health Provider (MLHP) who were appointed batch wise as 1st Batch, 2nd and 3rd batch) working in CHCs & PHSc in North and Middle Andaman and who do not want their name to be quoted said that it has been eight months since they got no increment in their salary or any type of incentives. And it has also been observed that, they usually get their salary after a gap of 2-3 months and which put them in undesirable difficulties, they alleged.

NRHM Employees claimed that whenever the matter was taken up to the knowledge of the higher authority, each time they were told that their payment was under process. Expressing their dissatisfaction on the reportedly delay in their payment and increment, they further said that they continued to perform their

duty in the hardest conditions and they showed great perseverance in the face of difficulty and still these staff are continuing their normal work to protect the interest of the people. Now, the concerned authority should consider upon their problem and take necessary steps/measures to clear the payment due from the month of March 2022, the NRHM employees said.

Andaman Sheekha tried to contact the official of NHM to know the reason behind this delay, but contact couldn't be established with the Officials. On the other hand, National Health Mission (NHM) employees alleged that this is not the first time when their salary has been delayed, they faced the same problems earlier several times.

"We are hopeful that the Government of India will intervene in this matter and resolve this issue on priority", the aggrieved health workers (NRHM) further said.

No Covid Cases Detected

eligible to appear in NMMSS Examination. The students of Kendriya Vidyalayas, Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalayas and Residential Schools run by State Government and Private unaided Schools are not eligible for scholarship under the National Means-cum-Merit Scholarship Scheme (NMMSS). For NMMSS examinations, students have to produce mark statements of the qualifying examinations (i.e. Mark statement of class -VII for NMMSS examination). To appear in the

NMMSS Examination students should produce parental income certificates issued from Revenue Authority not below the rank of Tehsildar concerned with their application forms. Category certificate are also to be produced by the candidates who come under reserved categories.
