New Delhi, Nov. 25 (PIB)

The nation will celebrate Constitution Day tomorrow (Nov. 26) to commemorate the adoption of the Constitution of India by the Constituent Assembly in 1949. The observation of Constitution Day started in 2015, based on the vision of the Prime Minister to give due recognition to the significance of this historic date. The

roots of this vision can also be traced back to the 'Samvidhan Gaurav Yatra' organised by the then Gujarat Chief Minister, Shri Narendra Modi in 2010.

As part of Constitution Day celebrations this year, Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi will participate in the programmes being organised in Parliament and

Vigyan Bhawan on 26<sup>th</sup> November, 2021.

The programme organized in Parliament will begin at 11 AM and will be held in the Central Hall of Parliament. It will be addressed by the Hon'ble President, Vice President, Prime Minister and Lok Sabha Speaker. After the speech of the Hon'ble President, the nation will join him Live, in reading the Preamble of the

Constitution. Hon'ble President will also release the digital version of two day Constitution Debates, digital version of 5:30 PM in Plenary Hall, Vigyan Bhawan, New Delhi. ## 82,393 persons insured under Pradhan Mantri Suraksha Bima Yojana in A&N Islands so far

### 5 claims settled with disbursement of Rs. 10 lakhs

Port Blair, Nov. 25

The Pradhan Mantri Suraksha Bima Yojana (PMSBY), a social security scheme is being implemented by all the Public Sector Undertaking Banks, Private & A&N Cooperative Bank functioning in A&N Islands. This social security scheme has been started by the Ministry of Finance in the year 2015 to provide insurance in case of disability or death. As per the data provided by Lead Bank Port Blair, altogether, 82,393 persons have been enrolled under



Pradhan Mantri Suraksha Bima Yojana in these Islands so far. A total of 5 claims were settled and Rs. 10 lakhs were disbursed (Rs. 2 lakh for each claim).

The premiums fixed under the scheme are low i.e. Rs. 12 per annum in order to ensure that the policyholder is given the benefits at the earliest. It is an accident insurance scheme launched by

the Govt. of India with an aim to bring the uninsured population under insurance cover. This accident insurance scheme offers a one-year accidental death and disability cover, which can be renewed annually.

People in the age group 18 to 70 years having a bank account can give their consent to join/enable auto-debit on or before 31<sup>st</sup> May for the coverage period 1<sup>st</sup> June to 31<sup>st</sup> May on an annual renewal basis. Aadhaar would be the primary Know

1,577 passengers arrived, out of which, 1289 were vaccinated with both doses while RT-PCR test was conducted on 288 passengers and the reports are awaited. During RAT conducted on 86 passengers bound for North & Middle Andaman at Ferrargunj, no

## Farmers' Corner- A Knowledge Hub

### Live bearer ornamental fish culture

Live-bearer fishes directly give birth to young ones upon reaching adulthood, and the new born fries immediately start feeding like the adult forms. These fishes can be easily bred and can be cultivated in mass scale even in a limited space of 10 x10 m2. Popular ornamental species include Guppy, Molly, Platy, and Swordtail. There are more than a thousand varieties among this species and are widely cultured in India and other foreign countries for the aquarium hobby and for exhibiting in public aquarium, office place, school campus, hospitals etc. Each varieties cost as per the color and pattern of finnage, and the price starts from 5 to 1000 Rs/each. These fishes are very much hardy and can thrive even in 9 ppt salinity and in neutral or alkaline pH of 7.0 to 8.3. In Andaman Islands, tourism industry is booming and there is a heavy demand for ornamental fishes in hotel, resort and restaurant beautification projects. With a minimum investment of 1 Lakh INR, breeding of live bearers can be initiated with good turnover by just utilizing the front or backyard space at home. Adult live bearer fishes breeds rapidly (4-8times/year) and the young ones attain maturity in 6 months, and easily attain a marketable size in 2 months. Package of practices for faster growth, production of colorful strains, and better survivability is available with ICAR-CIARI and can be easily taken up by unemployed youths, women's self-help groups and other interested stakeholders.

**Benefits: Breeding of live bearer fishes can be achieved easily with minimum input and maximum profit. The use of old tubs, buckets can be employed for growing out the fries and rearing broodstocks. Feeds formulated at home can be fed, which are very much simpler to formulate using home equipment's. ## 1<sup>st</sup> Test: India 258-4 at stumps on day one against New Zealand

Kanpur, Nov. 25

In the first cricket test match at Green Park in Kanpur, India were 258 for the loss of four wickets in their first innings against New Zealand on the opening day. Debutant Shreyas Iyer on 75 and Ravindra Jadeja on 50 were at the crease when the stumps were drawn.

Opting to bat first, India lost opener Mayank Agarwal before the hosts reached 82 for one at lunch, courtesy a 61-run stand between Cheteshwar Pujara and Shubman Gill. In the second session, India lost Gill who scored 52 runs, Pujara added 26 and Skipper Ajinkya Rahane 35 - all three failing to score big. However, Iyer and Jadeja then took India to a strong position.

For the visitors, fast bowler Kyle Jamieson troubled the Indian batters with his pace and scalped three wickets while Tim Southee claimed the remaining one.



## More than 119 crore 38 lakh COVID vaccine doses administered so far

New Delhi, Nov. 25

More than 119 crore 38 lakh COVID vaccine doses have been administered in the country so far under Nationwide Vaccination Drive. Health Ministry said, more than 90 lakh 27 thousand doses were administered in the last 24 hours. The Ministry said that a total of 9 thousand 119 new cases were reported in the last 24 hours.

India's Active caseload stands at one lakh 9 thousand 940, the lowest in 539 days. The active cases account for less than one per cent of total cases and is currently at 0.32 per cent, the lowest since March 2020. The recovery rate is currently at 98.33 per cent, the highest since March, 2020. A total of 10 thousand 264 people recovered in the last 24 hours and total recoveries touched over three crore 39 lakh and 67 thousand. The weekly positivity rate currently stands at 0.90 per cent which is less than two per cent for the last 62 days. Daily positivity rate is at 0.79 per cent which is less than two per cent for last 52 days. Over 63 crore 59 lakh COVID tests have been conducted in the country so far. In the last 24 hours, more than 11 lakh 50 thousand tests were conducted. (Source: india.gov.in)

The premium of Rs.12 per annum is deducted from the account holder's bank account through 'auto-debit' facility in one instalment, as per the consent given on enrolment. Members may also give one-time mandate for auto-debit every year till the scheme is in force, subject to re-calibration that may be deemed necessary on review of experience of the scheme.

In case of a joint account, all holders of the said account can join the scheme provided they satisfy the eligibility criteria and pay the premium at the rate of Rs.12 per person per annum through auto-debit.
