Filled to the nines: On Supreme Court's appointment spree

It is not often that nine judges are appointed to the Supreme Court at one go. In a welcome sign of cooperation between the judiciary and the executive, the President of India has signed warrants of appointment within days of the five-member Collegium recommending eight High Court judges, including three women, and a lawyer for elevation. It is nearly two years since Supreme Court appointments were made, and some vacancies have been around for quite some time now. The latest round of appointments possibly signifies the onset of an era in which the two branches agree more and agree faster on the Collegium's recommendations. The strength of the Bench goes up to 33, in a court that has a sanctioned complement of 34 judges. The presence of three women and the fact that different High Courts are getting representation are positive features and augur well for increasing diversity on the Bench. In particular, Justice B.V. Nagarathna's elevation at this point of time means that she may become the first woman Chief Justice of India (CJI). The trend of appointing members of the Bar directly to the Supreme Court continues with the honour going this time to former Additional Solicitor-General, P.S. Narasimha, who is also in line to be Chief Justice by efflux of time. A notable candidate whose name does not figure in the list is Justice A.K. Kureshi, Chief Justice of the Tripura High Court, who is fairly high in the all-India seniority list of High Court judges. That the finalisation of the recommendations came about after the retirement of Justice Rohinton Nariman — and a change in the composition of the Collegium with it — may indicate that the names were the outcome of a compromise. It is not idle speculation to say that Justice Kureshi's candidature may have been behind stagnation in the appointment process for a long time. Two years ago, a proposal by the Collegium to name Justice Kureshi as Chief Justice of the Madhya Pradesh High Court was recalled for accommodating the Centre's sensitivities. He was later assigned to the Tripura High Court. In the larger scheme of things, the omission of individuals may not matter much, but it must not become a practice to sidestep suitable candidates without sufficient cause solely to accommodate the executive's reservations. After all, the opaque collegium system is sustained only by the belief that it is a bulwark against executive intervention. This *raison d'être* should not be lost sight of. Going forward, one would wish for fewer spells of impasse in judicial appointments, quicker processing of names, and greater consideration to social and regional representation.

batch IPS officer of AGMUT cadre, was posted to Andaman and Nicobar Islands in December last year. A former joint secretary in the ministry of home affairs, who has also served in Delhi Police, Garg was pleased to see lower crime rates but soon he faced a unique challenge when Andaman Police force turned out to be more over eight and a half times the population of the islands who are the heaviest people in the entire country. In January, the DGP conducted the first health survey of policemen in the Union territory, including IPS officers and policemen of all ranks, where he found that the Andaman Police personnel were worse off than civilians living on the island in terms of health and obesity problems. According to the fifth National Health Survey, 45 per cent men and 38 per cent women of Andaman and Nicobar were overweight or obese. "The NHS survey rang alarm bells for me and I decided to conduct a health survey for the police force. While we expect policemen to be fitter, the results were alarming," Garg told THE WEEK. He found that the policemen were worse off on all parameters when compared with the civilian population. For Garg, low crime rates and handling a small police force of 4,600 personnel, gave him time to help

the islands' policemen. Regular medical check-ups, weight-loss programmes, health awareness and fitness regimes are being monitored by the police chief. Every Saturday, Garg meets the two police constables who have the worst body mass index of over 40 for counselling. They have lost a lot of weight and have improved their health parameters. On the small islands, the duo has gained celebrity-like status for their success at weight loss. Soon, Andaman Police will be the first police force to document its study on obesity and ill health challenges facing policemen and circulate it to all police forces in the country. The study entails documenting the degree of fitness of the 4,600 policemen of Andaman; how they were tested on the basis of their height, waist, chest ratio, BMI and other parameters, comparing it with the standard requirements for policemen when they join the force. "There was a wide discrepancy. When the policemen joined the force, they were fitter," he said. "Recently, we lost two policemen to heart attack and brain haemorrhage, and both were overweight," Garg said. But the silver lining is that the two heaviest policemen are setting an example for their counterparts in other police forces who may follow suit.

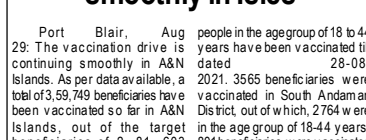
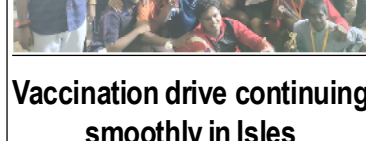

"Facts Not Brought To Notice": Court Raps Jail Officials In Rape Case

The Delhi High Court has asked the prison authorities to file an affidavit stating why the correct facts relating to a man's conviction being modified from gang rape to the offence of rape were not placed before the Sentence Review Board (SRB). The court directed the Delhi Prisons director general to file the affidavit also indicating the reasons why the SRB was

informed that the case was for the offences of gang rape and robbery. "In view of the fact that complete and correct facts were not brought to the notice of the SRB, Director General Prisons is directed to ensure that while putting up the case of the petitioner before the SRB in its next meeting, the judgment of conviction passed by the trial court as also the judgment of this court

appeal, whereby, the petitioner has been convicted only for the offence punishable under section 376 IPC and the gist thereof will be placed before the committee," Justice Mukta Gupta said. He further said the man's conduct in prison was exemplary, and he has not misused the concession granted to him in the form of parole and furlough.

NHIDCL hopeful to complete 'Humphrey Strait Bridge' by mid-September

Port Blair, Aug 29: The National Highways and Infrastructure Development Corporation (NHIDCL) is hoping to complete the Humphrey Strait Bridge, on the two crucial and under construction bridges of Andaman Trunk Road, by September 15 next. According to the DGM of NHIDCL in Andaman, Sunil Kumar the bridge will be inaugurated on September 15 and hence works are on full swing. As per details due to heavy rain workers are facing huge difficulties in completing the works that is why even senior staffs of NHIDCL are reaching the site at Kadambala, Middle Andaman from Mayabunder to make sure the works are completed on time. However, it is still not clear who will inaugurate the bridge. Once ready, the Humphrey Strait Bridge will be the longest bridge in Andaman and Nicobar Islands.

According to details, the total length of the bridge (including approach road) is 1450 meter while the width of the bridge is 14.8 meter having 1.5 meter (total 3 meter) pedestrian footpath at both sides. The height of the bridge has been designed in such way to enable the smaller vessels to pass through underneath the bridge and is 22 meters from the high tide level. As per details, the Ministry of Road Transport & Highways has sanctioned an amount of Rs. 277.17 crores for this project, the work for which started in the month of April 2017. After completion, Humphrey Strait Bridge will not only fulfill the long pending demands of the people of North & Middle Andaman but also ease the connectivity between South Andaman & Middle & North Andaman.

Tokyo Paralympics: Bhavina Patel creates history, becomes the first Indian para-paddler to win silver

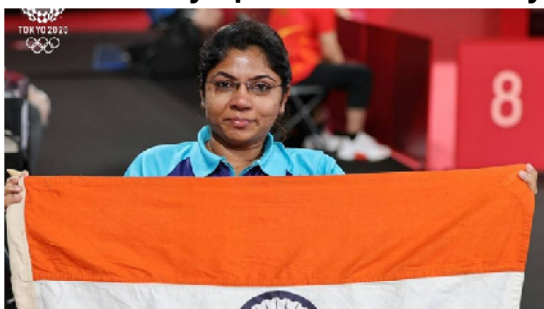
Bhavinaben Patel signed off with a historic silver medal in her maiden Paralympic Games on Sunday.

Patel had suffered a loss to Zhou in her first group stage match earlier in the week.

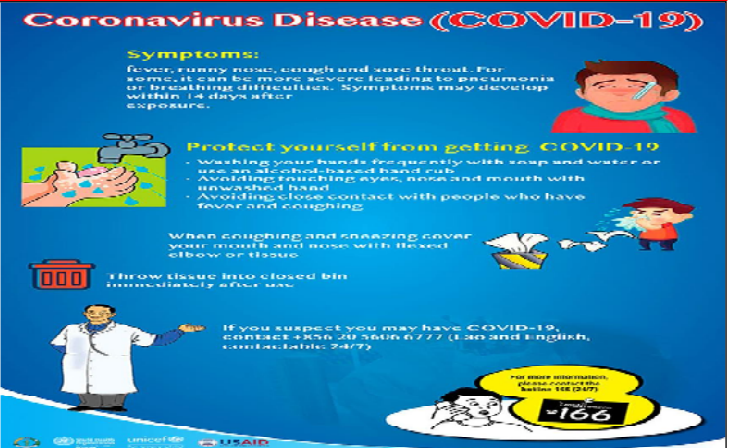
Up against an opponent who has five Paralympic medals to her name including gold medals in singles at Beijing and London, Patel seemed to struggle as she couldn't execute her
