Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi interacted with Jan Aushadhi Kendra owners and beneficiaries of the scheme today via video conferencing. Jan Aushadhi week is being celebrated across the country from 1st March to generate awareness about the usage of generic medicines and the benefits of Jan Aushadhi Pariyojana. The theme of this event is "Jan Aushadhi-Jan Upyogi". Union Minister Dr Mansukh Mandaviya was among those present on the occasion.

Interacting with the beneficiary from Patna, Ms Hilda Anthony, the Prime Minister asked how she came to know about the Jan Aushadhi medicines. He also enquired about the



quality of the medicines. She replied that she has benefited greatly from the medicines as she is able to get her monthly medicines for 250 rupees instead of 1200- 1500 rupees earlier. She said that she spends the savings on social causes.

The Prime Minister appreciated her spirit and hoped that people's faith will increase in Jan Aushadhi through people like her. He said the middle class can be a great ambassador for this scheme. He also talked about the impact of disease on the financial situation of middle and lower-middle and poor

sections of society. He called upon the literate segment of society to talk about the benefits of Jan Aushadhi.

Interacting with the divyang beneficiary Shri Suresh Chandra Behera from Bhubaneswar, the Prime Minister enquired about his experience with Jan Aushadhi Pariyojana. The Prime Minister also asked whether all medicines needed by him are available at the Jan Aushadhi store. Shri Behera said that he gets all the medicines from the store and saves 2000-2500 rupees every month as his parents also need medicines. The Prime Minister prayed to Lord Jagannath for his family's recovery and wellbeing. He praised the

No mobile phones allowed inside Counting Hall

Port Blair, Mar. 7

Elaborate arrangements have been made for smooth and speedy counting of votes for the Panchayat and Municipal Elections-2022 tomorrow (March 8) from 8 am onwards. The counting of votes for constituencies of Port Blair Panchayats will be done at Girls Senior Secondary School and the counting of votes for PBMC will be done at Jawaharlal Nehru Rajkeeya Mahavidhyalaya (JNRM), while for other Panchayats it will be done at respective Tehsils.

Adequate security arrangements have also been made to ensure the safety and sanctity of the process. The Counting Agents of contesting candidates will also be present at the time of counting and they are required to be present by 7.30 AM. Passes have also been issued to media personnel for the coverage of the entire process.

Dry day shall be observed on the day of

counting (8th March). All bars, ANIIDCO outlets, Defence & Police Canteens have been directed to ensure the same. If any violations are found, their license shall be cancelled. The Office of the Director, Panchayat and Municipal Elections has already issued instructions regarding use of mobile phones & cameras during the counting process at JNRM and Govt Girls Sr. Sec. School. Accordingly, mobile phones shall not be allowed to be taken inside the Counting Halls and shall not be used from anywhere else within the campus.

All Media Persons shall be accommodated in the Media Room. Use of mobile phones and other communication equipment shall be allowed from the Media Centre. Nobody (not even the candidate or RO/ARO etc) except the Observers and Officers appointed by the Director, Panchayat and Municipal Elections shall be allowed to carry a mobile phone

inside the Counting Hall.

A Public Communication Room at both the Counting Halls has been earmarked for safe-keeping of the mobiles etc of the candidates and their agents/representatives to make use of their mobile phones in case of any need.

No camera- still or video, of the media, except for official recording of the entire counting process, is allowed to be fixed inside any Counting Hall. No camera stand should therefore be allowed to be taken inside Counting Hall by Media and Journalists. Hand held cameras will be allowed to the authorized pass holders. Further, while taking audio video coverage of the counting process, with camera carried in hand or on shoulders by the media/press, under no circumstances, the actual votes recorded on an individual EVM or ballot papers is to be photographed or covered by audio visual coverage. The sale of 21 crore sanitary napkins shows that Jan Aushadhi Kendras have made the lives of women easy all over the country.

The Prime Minister said as of now more than 8,500 Jan Aushadhi Kendras have been opened in the country. These centres are now becoming solution centres for the common man and not just another Government store. He said that the Government has also controlled the price of more than 800 medicines required for the treatment of diseases like cancer, tuberculosis, diabetes, heart disease. The Government has also ensured that the cost of stunting and knee implants is also kept under control. He gave statistics regarding making medical care affordable for the citizens. He informed that more than 50 crore people are in the ambit of Ayushman Bharat Yojana. More than 3 crore people have taken benefit of the scheme, saving 70 thousand crore rupees of the poor and middle-class people. PM National Dialysis programme has saved 550 crore rupees. Knee implant and medicine price control saved 13 thousand crore rupees.

location, up to which the still and video camera of the media and press can move, shall be indicated by the Returning Officer in advance, marked by a line or boundary for guidance of all concerned.

Traffic arrangements have been made in connection with the counting of votes on 08.03.2022 for the Panchayat and Municipal Elections-2022 to be held at two venues i.e. Girls Senior Secondary School (For Port Blair Gram Panchayat) and JNRM (For Municipal Wards) which have been declared as Counting Centres.

The movement of vehicular traffic on ATR from Ferrargunj Junction to Ograbraj Junction will also be regulated during counting of votes on 8th March, 2022 in the following manner viz. The movement of vehicular Traffics shall be restricted from 6.30 am to the road towards Govt. Model Sr. Sec. School Ferrargunj from the ATR from either directions leading from Tushnabad & Ferrargunj Junction.

The Vehicles coming from Jirkatang shall be diverted towards Brindaban, Mathura Junction, Saitankari, Namunaghar, Mithakari and Ograbraj Junction and vehicles coming from Chouldari shall be diverted from Ograbraj Junction towards Mithakari, Namunaghar, Saitankari, Mathura Junction, Brindaban and Ferrargunj. It is further notified that the Agents of candidates will have to disperse from the Counting Hall immediately after the results of their candidates are announced. Next batch of counting agents shall be permitted into the Polling Station only after the previous agents move out of the Counting Hall, a press release from DPME said.

Govt. launches Donate-a-Pension prog. under PM-SYM pension scheme

New Delhi, Mar. 7

The Government today launched Donate-a-Pension programme. It is an initiative under the Pradhan Mantri Shram Yogi Maandhan (PM-SYM) pension scheme where citizens can donate the premium contribution of their immediate support staff including domestic workers, drivers and helpers.

Launching the scheme in New Delhi, Labour and Employment Minister, Shri Bhupender Yadav said under the programme, workers in the unorganised sector in the age group of 18 to 40 years can register themselves and deposit a minimum of 660 to 2400 rupees every year depending on their age. After they attain 60 years, they will receive the minimum assured pension of three thousand rupees per month. He said the Government is committed to provide social security to unorganised workers. The programme was launched as part of many initiatives by the Labour Ministry to be launched in the Iconic Week being celebrated by from 7th to 13th of this month.

The Minister also launched e SHRAM on the UMANG app. Over 25 crore informal sector workers involved in 400 different occupations have registered on the e-Shram portal in the country. 


