

PM Modi holds bilateral talks with British PM Boris Johnson

Both leaders review Comprehensive Strategic Partnership

New Delhi, April 22

Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi today said, they reviewed the progress made in the Roadmap and also set some goals for the future. He said, they also discussed the comprehensive reforms going on in India, the infrastructure modernization plan, and the National Infrastructure Pipeline. He welcomed the growing investment in India by UK companies. He said, they decided to deepen the climate and energy partnership and invited the UK to join India's National Hydrogen Mission.

Shri Modi said, the conclusion of the implementation arrangements of the Global Innovation Partnership today will prove to be a very important initiative. This will further strengthen development partnerships with other countries.



Both leaders also discussed the developments taking place at the regional and global levels. Prime Minister, Shri Modi said, they emphasized maintaining the Indo-Pacific region based on free, open, inclusive, and rules-based order. He welcomed UK's decision to join Indo-Pacific Oceans Initiative.

Shri Modi said, they stressed

dialogue and diplomacy in Ukraine for an immediate ceasefire and resolution of the problem. They also reiterated the importance of respect for the territorial integrity and sovereignty of all countries.

In his statement, the visiting Prime Minister, Mr. Johnson said the partnership between India and Britain is one of the defining

friendships of the times. He pointed out that since last year, the threats of autocratic coercion have grown even further and it is vital to deepen cooperation including a shared interest in keeping the Indo-Pacific open and free. Two agreements were also exchanged following the bilateral talks.

Mr Johnson arrived in India on a two-day visit yesterday. He was accorded a ceremonial reception at Rashtrapati Bhavan this morning. Talking to the media, Mr Johnson called it a very auspicious moment in the relationship and friendship between India and UK. He said, the bilateral ties have never been as good or as strong as they are today.

Mr Johnson also visited Rajghat and laid a wreath at the Samadhi of Mahatma Gandhi. This is his maiden visit to India as Prime Minister of the United Kingdom. (Source: india.gov.in)

Facilitating onboarding of MSMEs, eligible establishments & registration of aspirational candidates under National Apprenticeship Training Scheme

'Industry Drive & Apprenticeship Mela' to be held at ITI Dollygunj, ITI Arong & VTI Bakultala on April 26

Port Blair, April 22

The Apprentices Act, 1961 was enacted with an objective to provide training to the apprentices in the industry by utilizing the facilities available therein. The Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE), GoI is the administrative Ministry responsible for the implementation of the Act for skill-based trade apprenticeship with the assistance of State/UT Governments.

Apprenticeship training is one of the most efficient way to develop skilled manpower for the industry by using training facilities available in the establishments without putting any extra burden on the exchequer to set up training infrastructure. The unemployed youth, after undergoing apprenticeship training can easily adapt to the industrial environment at the time of regular

employment. The other advantages of apprenticeship training are that, it is one of the most important schemes in terms of quality of training, experiential learning and the enhanced employability that it provides and it is also the most promising skills delivery vehicle in the industrial/training ecosystem of the country. It also extended structured and rigorous training programme which

helps apprentices becomes skilled and stimulates apprentices a real chance to put skills into practice and helps them to gain confidence in a working environment.

The establishments can engage 2.5 to 15% apprentices of their overall sanctioned strength including contractual staff. A prescribed stipend has to be paid for engaged apprentices. However, the reimbursement of

25% of prescribed stipend, subject to a maximum of Rs. 1500/- per month per apprentice shall be paid by the Government of India (GoI) to all registered establishments who engage apprentices under 'National Apprenticeship Promotion Scheme (NPAS)'. The employers having 4 or more workers shall only be eligible to engage apprentices. However, it is mandatory for an establishment to engage apprentices, who have 30 or more number of workers as per the Apprenticeship Act.

As the GoI is promoting the said scheme in a large way, it shall be obligatory to engage apprentices in every Department/Establishment, so as to provide a platform for unemployed youths for their gainful employment. In this regard, a one day 'Industry Drive and Apprenticeship Mela' will be organized on April 26 from 9.30 am to 5 pm at ITI, Dollygunj, ITI, Arong and VTI, Bakultala with a view to facilitate onboard of the MSMEs, Industries, PSUs, Govt. Departments, other eligible establishments and registration of aspirational candidates under the National Apprenticeship Training Scheme. This Mela shall give a comprehensive knowledge session on National Apprenticeship Training Scheme for all the stakeholders alongwith new guidelines, increased understanding and clarity on the system, process, roles and structure of implementation helping stakeholders in their outreach and support and key recommendation to plug the gaps in portal, policy performance system to the industry.

cycle of trees like figs, jamun, etc. many animals, particularly the birds and bats, most of which are endemic to these Islands, congregate for feeding. The cacophony and jostling amongst the birds for the fruits is a pleasant diversion from the mundane life for any person who can take out some time to marvel at the nature and its bounty.

However, during such fruiting cycles, many miscreants have been apprehended in the act of hunting these birds and bats, which, being wild, is prohibited under the Wildlife (Protection) Act, 1972. It is seen that a range of tools and equipment are used for hunting, like stones, catapults and the more precise air-guns and rifles. Glue traps have also been recovered from various areas where decoy bird is put up to lure the wild birds into the traps.

Birds like pigeons, teals, doves, parakeets, hill mynas, fruitbats, etc. are covered under various schedules of the Act and therefore, hunting of these wildlife amounts to grave violations, punishable with fines and at times even imprisonment depending upon the schedule.

Responding to the call of conservation earlier, many nature-loving and aware citizens have come forward to surrender their air-guns and many have pledged their support for conservation of the wild.

This time too, the Department of Environment & Forests, A&N Administration has fervently appealed to the citizenry to come forward and join hands with the Administration for voluntarily surrendering air-rifles/air-guns, motivate others, discourage the use of air-rifles/air-guns and take a pledge to conserve the wildlife of these Islands, whose rarity and diversity is a matter of pride for each and every Indian. For surrendering of air-guns, any of the nearest Forest Office may be approached.

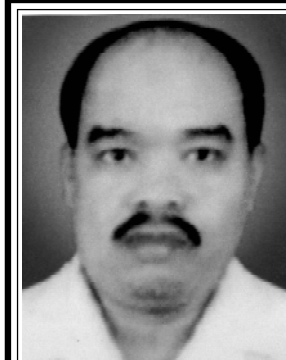
