'Urjapay Portal' - hassle free payment of electricity bill

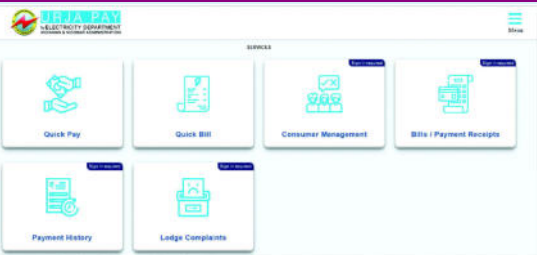
Online portal extended to consumers of N&M District; monthly energy bills to be issued through SMS

The digital payment facility of electricity bill through <https://urjapay.andaman.gov.in> anytime anywhere has become a boon for islanders residing in Port Blair particularly during this pandemic period. After the successful launch of the facility in South Andaman, now the facility has been extended to the consumers of N&M Andaman too. The consumers can avail the facility at urjapay.andaman.gov.in. Further, the monthly energy bills to all the consumers of North & Middle Andaman will also be issued through SMS following the concept of 'paperless billing' henceforth.

It may be recalled that the



launch of 'Urjapay Portal' has facilitated people to pay their bills without queuing up at the billing centres for hours. The Digital India initiative of A&N Administration has made life much easier for people as access to facilities are just a click away. This is evident from the number of users registered. As on Oct. 30, 2021, a total of 11362 users have been registered under the portal in South Andaman District, while a total of 124008 consumers had carried out online payment of bills. A total transaction amount of

Rs. 125219818/- has been made through this facility.

Consumers have been once again urged to make use of this facility by visiting the website <https://urjapay.andaman.gov.in>. The consumers have two options for making the payment viz. by registering themselves on the website- The registered user can add multiple accounts besides they will be provided with a dashboard to view the details of previous transactions of all accounts including the due amount and make payment and by using quick pay option- the consumers can now make the payment by entering the consumer number.

New Delhi, Oct. 31

In pursuit, a National Strategic Plan 2017-25 was developed, and significant progress has been made in achieving the objectives laid down in the Plan. Many States/ UTs have also developed State/ UT specific strategic plans to achieve TB

elimination by 2025. However, TB elimination by 2025 requires formulation of State Specific Strategic Plans and a commitment from all the States in this regard. In order to strengthen the fight against TB, the two day National Consultative Workshop on State Strategic plans for ending TB by 2025 was organized at New

Pilot scale farming of commercially viable seaweed at Hathi Tapu

'Kappaphycus Alvarezaa' having wide commercial application shows progressive growth in waters of A&N Islands

Ministry sets of target of 10,000 MT seaweeds production in A&N Islands by 2024-2025

Port Blair, Oct. 31

The cultivation sites for project on pre-feasibility study and establishment of pilot scale farming of commercially viable seaweed at Hathi Tapu was inspected by Shri. Vinay Kumar Jindal, Joint Secretary (Fisheries) along with Dr. Utpal Kumar Sar, Director of Fisheries and other officials of Department of Fisheries yesterday to assess the progress of implementation and growth rate achieved by various species of seaweeds under cultivation. The Joint



Secretary (Fisheries) interacted with project personnel of CSIR-CSMCRI, Gujarat who are placed in Hathi Tapu for installation of rafts, its maintenance and for further studies

related to seaweed cultivation in the islands.

The CSIR-CSMCRI has already completed deployment of 51 nos of seeded rafts along the bay of Hathi Tapu

which includes 36 Gracillaria edulis, 9 K a p p a h y c u s alvarezaa, 2 Gracillaria salicornia and 4 Gracillaria debilis. Another 40 rafts are kept ready for seeding

also. The project personnel demonstrated the different rafts of various stage of its growth and the harvested seaweeds species. He informed that Kappaphycus Alvarezaa which is having wide commercial application has shown progressive growth in the waters of A&N Islands compared to other species. Overall growth of seaweeds in the Hathi Tapu area has shown encouraging results.

Farmers' Corner- A Knowledge Hub

Heliconia chartacea commonly known as Flamingo

Heliconia chartacea is an evergreen perennial, rhizomatous herbaceous species reaching a height of 3-4 m. The plant possess oblong leaves and leaf lamina is subdivided perpendicular to rachis in numerous sections having different breadth. The leaf length ranges from 2.5 to 3.0 m with 25 to 30 cm breadth. The leaves and inflorescence have waxy coating. The inflorescence are drooping nature with robust peduncle which grows to a length of 1.5 m. The colour of bract varies from pink to scarlet red and the number of bracts per inflorescence ranges from 12-24. This species is more ornamental in the genus Heliconia which have numerous varieties among which the most famous and diffused are the Pink and Scarlet which are maintained at ICAR-CIARI. This species can be cultivated in humid tropical region in organic enriched soil. It is adapted to partially shaded condition. Under sub-tropical condition, the species is grown as a potted plant. The inflorescence are long lasting and have shelf life of two weeks. Flowering will be initiated one year after planting of rhizomes. About 22-24 spikes can be harvested per clump per year.

Benefit: *Heliconia chartacea* have huge ornamental potential and can be exploited for cut flower purpose and specimen plant in landscape horticulture.

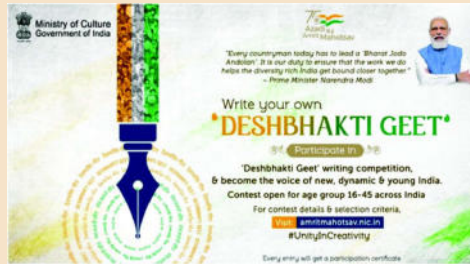

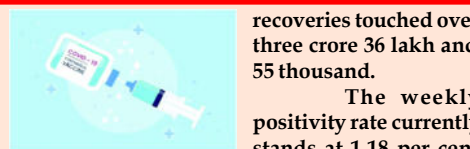

Around 106 crore 18 lakh Covid vaccine doses have been administered in the country so far under nationwide vaccination drive. Health Ministry said more than 68 lakh doses were administered in the last 24 hours. The Ministry said that a total of 12 thousand 830 new cases were reported in the last 24 hours. India's Active caseload stands at one lakh 59 thousand 272 which is the lowest in



recoveries touched over three crore 36 lakh and 55 thousand. The weekly positivity rate currently stands at 1.18 per cent which is less than two per cent for the last 37 days. Daily positivity rate is at 1.13 per cent which is less than two per cent for last 27 days. Over 60 crore 83 lakh COVID tests have been conducted in the country so far. In the last 24 hours more than 11 lakh 35 thousand tests were conducted.

deployment of rafts is underway in North & Middle Andaman District also. Deployment of 11 seeded rafts in Mayabunder has been taken up, out of which, 6 has already been completed.

The Joint Secretary (Fisheries) directed the staff of CSMCRI for regular cleaning to avoid any unnecessary growth in the rope and to monitor and analyze the growth rate of different species of seaweed on regular basis. He also directed to complete the seeding of 40 remaining rafts within a span of one month. During the visit, he reminded the Department officials to work closely with CSIR-CSMCRI and to review the progress regularly for gaining maximum output of the project due to its national importance.

Earlier, on 16/10/2021 the Hon'ble Minister of Home Affairs has launched the seaweed cultivation project under Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana (PMMSY) during his visit to A&N Islands. This project targeted for making seed bank facility of various species of seaweed and also for training of 200 Nos. of beneficiaries to take up this activities by availing assistance under PMMSY. The Ministry of Fisheries Animal Husbandry & Dairying, Govt. of India has proposed a target production of 10,000 MT seaweeds from A&N Islands by 2024-2025, a press release from Fisheries Department said.
