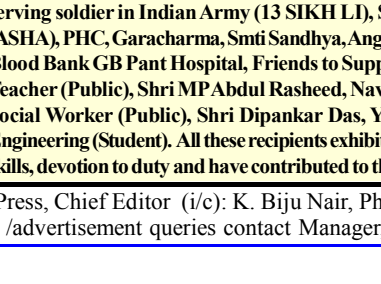

Media briefed on COVID-19

People urged to adhere to COVID appropriate behavior to keep the virus at bay: Director (IP&T)

Port Blair, Aug. 16

The Director (IP&T), Shri Alok Kumar briefing the media persons on COVID-19 status in the Islands held in the conference hall of IP&T here this evening urged the people to adhere to COVID appropriate behavior to keep the virus at bay. RAT test was

conducted on 174 passengers bound for North & Middle Andaman at Ferrargunj and no positive case was found. Similarly, RAT was conducted on 173 passengers at Phoenix Bay Jetty and all were tested negative. The Secretary said, today, 4 flights with 631 passengers arrived here and the results

of RT-PCR reports are awaited. Today, till 3 pm, 363 persons were administered doses of vaccine, out of which, 270 were in the age group of 18-44. The Deputy Director, GB Pant Hospital, Dr. Amitabha De said that GB Pant Hospital & ITI COVID Care Centre are free of COVID patients.

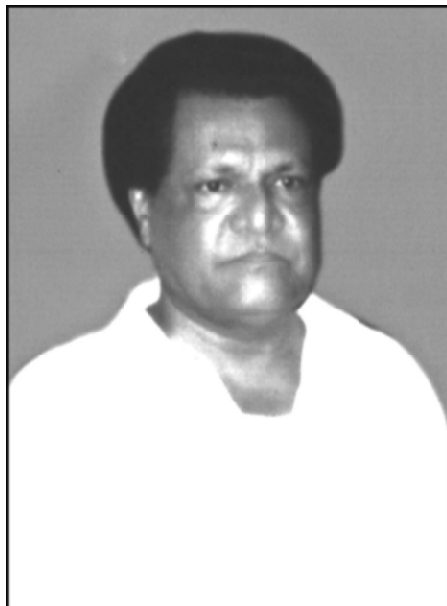

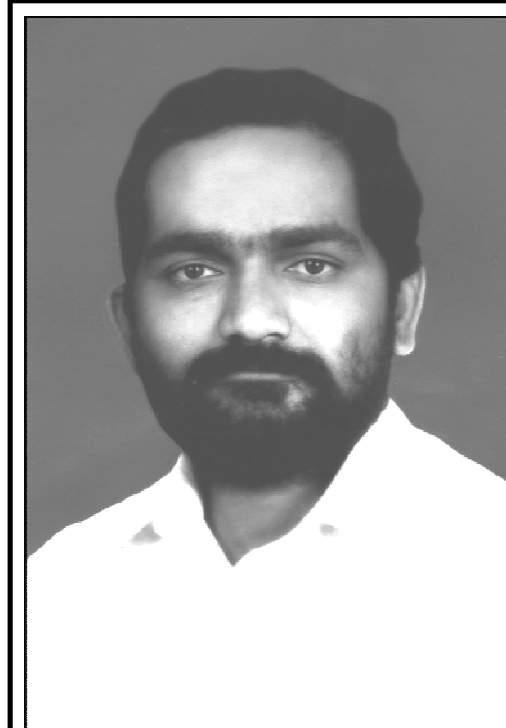
