## Prime Minister addresses National Rozgar Mela

### Distributes more than 70,000 appointment letters to newly inducted recruits in various Government departments and organizations

## "A small effort from you can create a huge change in someone's life": PM

New Delhi, July 22 (PIB)

The Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi addressed the National Rozgar Mela via video conferencing today and distributed more than 70,000 appointment letters to newly inducted recruits in various Government departments and organizations. The new recruits, selected from across the country will be joining the Government in various Ministries and Departments including the Department of Revenue, Financial Services, Posts, School Education, Higher Education, Defence, Health and Family Welfare, Central Public Sector Undertakings, Water Resources, Personnel & Training and Ministry of Home Affairs among others. 44 places across the country were connected with the 'Mela' during the Prime Minister's address.

Addressing the gathering, the Prime Minister said that it is not only a memorable day for the young recruits but also a historic day for the nation as today marks the day when the Tiranga was accepted in its current form by the Constituent Assembly for the first time



in 1947. The Prime Minister remarked that it is a matter of great inspiration that the new recruits are receiving their appointment letter for government services on this significant day as he encouraged them to take the country's name forward. He underlined that it is a

In the 'Azadi Ka Amrit Kaal', the Prime Minister said that every citizen has taken the resolve to make India a 'Viksit Bharat'. He highlighted the rise of India in the leading economies as it jumped from the 10th to the 5th largest economy of the world. ## AV Fistula creation camp for Chronic Kidney Disease patients organized by ANIIMS

### CKD patients from all three districts avail benefit of the camp

Port Blair, July 22

The Andaman Nicobar Islands Institute of Medical Sciences (ANIIMS) organised Arteriovenous (AV) Fistula Creation Camp for Chronic Kidney Disease (CKD) patients from July 19 to 21, 2023. A four-member team led by Dr G V Praveen Kumar, Vascular Surgeon empanelled with Ayushman Bharat was invited to create AV Fistula for those patients needing dialysis.

The AV Fistula Creation camp concluded on July 21, 2023 during which the Secretary Health, Dr Satyendra Singh Dursawat, IAS, met with the team of experts and thanked them for their valuable contribution to the health of islanders and felicitated them with certificates of appreciation. He requested them to continue their support in future also. The AV Fistula Creation Camp was inaugurated by the Director, ANIIMS, Dr. Pragma Sharma in presence of Faculty members including surgeons and physicians and other officials of the



ANIIMS on July 19, 2023.

During the camp, a total of 23 patients were attended by the expert team during the camp. AV-fistula was created in 18 CKD patients that include insertion of permanent catheter in two patients. The remaining five patients were reviewed for dysfunctional AV-fistulas that the patients already had. CKD patients from all three districts availed the benefit of the camp. During the surgical interventions ANIIMS's faculty members Dr. G. Gajendraraj, HOD General Surgery, Dr Mohammed Mustafa PP, Assistant Professor and Dr Anis Ahtarkhavari, Senior Resident of the Department of Surgery assisted the expert team and both faculty members took the opportunity to get hands on training on AV Fistula Creation procedures through on-the-job training, a communication from the Director, ANIIMS said here today.

## Nine more foreign poachers apprehended, making it 26 in a month

### Stolen dinghy recovered by N&M Andaman Police

Port Blair, July 22

Anti-Poaching Task Force team of N&M Andaman Police along with locals from villages searched for foreign poachers suspected to be hiding in the mangroves and creek near Loha Tikrey on July 20, 2023. During their extensive search in the creeks, the team found a dinghy of a local fisherman which was missing since last few days from Area 26. It



was suspected that it could be stolen by Myanmarese poachers and hidden there. On alert sounded by Inspector Anirudra Mondal, the team split into three and started

trying to run and escape in the jungle. However, the team chased them swiftly and apprehended 09 poachers successfully. To caution them from fleeing away, the team had to fire some warning shots. Further, the team continued its search for more poachers. However, after an extensive search in the dense mangroves and in the

works", the Literary Meet organized by Kala Kendra-A Society under Department of Art & Culture, A&N Administration at Andaman Club here this evening, saw budding writers and literary



professionals engaging in a fruitful discussion and sharing of ideas and inspiration through their writings. This meet was organized with the aim to nurture and promote creativity in the literary fields among Islanders.

Speaking on the occasion, the Director (Art & Culture), A&N Administration, Dr. Jatinder Sohal informed that events like this will be conducted regularly by the Art & Culture

remarked that there cannot be a better time than today to be recruited by the government as the new officers have got the golden opportunity to serve the country in its 'Amrit Kaal'. He suggested that their priorities should lie with serving the people of the country and resolving their issues to increase ease of living, while also aligning themselves with the goals of 'Viksit Bharat'. "A small effort from you can create a huge change in someone's life", the Prime Minister said as he reiterated that the populace is the form of God and serving them is like serving God itself. He emphasized that the new appointees should work with the belief of serving others to unlock the greatest feeling of satisfaction.

Talking about the banking sector which had a good number of recruits in today's programme, the Prime Minister underlined the role of the banking sector in the expansion of the economy. "Today, India is among the countries whose banking sector is considered to be the strongest", said Shri Modi recalling the journey of the last nine years. He dwelled on the ill impact of political selfishness on the sector in the past. He mentioned 'phone banking' of the past when loans were disbursed on the phone calls of the powerful. These loans were never repaid, he said. These scams broke the back of the banking sector of the country, he said. He listed the measures taken after 2014 to retrieve the situation. He mentioned strengthening of management of the government banks, stress on professionalism and consolidation of small banks into large banks. Shri Modi said that by insuring deposits up to 5 lakhs, more than 99 percent of deposits became safe leading to a renewed trust in the banking system. By acts like the Bankruptcy Code, banks were protected from losses. Furthermore, by tightening the grip over those who looted the government property by attaching their property, the banks known for losses and NPA are being discussed for their record profit.

The Prime Minister expressed pride in the hard work of the employees of the banking sector. "People of the banking sector never disappointed me or my vision", he said. The Prime Minister hailed the efforts of the banking sector in making the Jan Dhan Account scheme a huge success by opening 50 crore Jan Dhan Accounts. This was a great help in transferring money into the accounts of crores of women during the pandemic.

Speaking on the efforts for the betterment of the MSME sector, the Prime Minister mentioned Mudra Yojana which provided collateral-free loans to the enterprising youth. He praised the banking sector for making the scheme a success. Similarly, the banking sector rose up to the occasion when the government doubled the loan amount for women Self Help Groups and helped the MSMe sector by providing loans which saved 1.5 crores jobs by protecting small enterprises. He also thanked the bank employees for making PM Kisan Samman Nidhi a grand success. More than 50 lakh Street Vendors were helped in the SVANidhi Scheme. "I am sure, you will take a 'Sankalp Patra (resolution letter) for making banking a tool of empowerment of the poor along with your 'Niyukti Patra' (appointment letter).

The Prime Minister said the recent NITI report has found that 13 crore Indians were brought above the poverty line in the last 5 years. He acknowledged the hard work of government servants in this and mentioned schemes for pucca houses, toilets and electricity connections. "When these schemes reached the poor, their morale also increased. This success is a symbol of the fact that if together we increase the efforts to remove poverty from India, then poverty can be completely eliminated from India. And certainly, every government employee of the country has a big role in this", the Prime Minister said.

The Prime Minister highlighted another dimension of decreasing poverty in the country, which is the expansion of the neo-middle class, which is creating new job opportunities. Growing demand and aspirations of the neo-middle class are driving manufacturing. He highlighted that it is the youth of the country who benefit the most from the boosting production in India's factories and industries. He also mentioned how India is creating new records every day be it mobile phone exports, the number of cars sold in the first 6 months of 2023, and record sales for electric vehicles. "All such activities are boosting employment and employment opportunities in the country", he added.

"The entire world is keeping an eye on India's talent", the Prime Minister said as he noted the issue of a declining working population due to higher average age in many developed economies in the world. Therefore, the Prime Minister said, this is the time for the youth of India to toil and enhance their skills and capabilities. Highlighting the great demand for India's IT talent, doctors and nurses, the Prime Minister said that the respect for Indian talent is continuously growing in every country and every sector. The Prime Minister highlighted that in the last 9 years, the government has focused on skill development where about 1.5 crore youth have been trained under PM Kaushal Vikas Yojana. He also mentioned setting up 30 Skill India International Centers so the youth can be prepared for global opportunities. The Prime Minister also touched upon building new medical colleges, ITIs, IITs and technical institutes across the country and informed that till 2014, there were only about 380 medical colleges in our country whereas this number has increased to more than 700 in the last 9 years. He also mentioned the significant increase in the number of nursing colleges. "Skills that meet global demand are going to create lakhs of new opportunities for the youth of India", Shri Modi added.

Concluding the address, the Prime Minister underlined that all appointees are joining government service in a very positive environment and the responsibility of taking forward this positive thinking now rests on their shoulders. The Prime Minister also urged them to continue the process of learning and self-development and take maximum advantage of iGoT Karmayogi, an online learning platform prepared by the government.

The Rozgar Mela is a step towards the fulfillment of the Prime Minister's commitment to accord the highest priority to employment generation. The Rozgar Mela is expected to act as a catalyst in furthering employment generation and providing meaningful opportunities to the youth for their empowerment and participation in national development.

The newly inducted appointees are also getting an opportunity to train themselves through Karmayogi Prarambh, an online module on iGOT Karmayogi portal, where more than 400 e-learning courses have been made available for 'anywhere any device' learning format.

Procedure, vacated their respective place of work and through the prescribed escape route reached to the predetermined safe point near Fitting Shop II. The Disaster management team of Directorate of Shipping Services immediately started boundary cooling and also started fire fighting with available portable fire Extinguisher. A real time demonstration was carried out on use of different kinds fire extinguishers with the participation of employees of DSS.

Simultaneously all operational boats berthed at Cholunga wharf were moved to sea. Altogether 193 personnel including employees of DSS and staff of private contractors working inside the marine dockyard participated in the mock drill. Eventually at the end of the session a combined briefing was undertaken by Nodal Officer, Disaster Management, DSS and Technical Superintendent DSS.

Centre approves Market Development Assistance of Rs 1500 per MT to promote organic fertilizers: Govt informs LS

New Delhi, July 22

Minister of State for Chemical and Fertilizers, Shri Bhagwanth Khuba today informed the Lok Sabha that the Centre has approved the Market Development Assistance, MDA of 1500 rupees per metric tonne to promote organic fertilizers. In a written reply in the Lok Sabha, he said that the government

promoting a balanced and judicious use of fertilizer based on soil tests in conjunction with organic and biofertilizers.

The Minister said the Indian Council of Agricultural Research conducts research to test and develop organic inputs for different crops. It also promotes these products among the stakeholders through the

Virat Kohli equals Sir Don Bradman's record of most test centuries after smashing his 29th ton in second test against West Indies in Trinidad

Port of Spain, July 22

In Cricket, West Indies were 86 for 1 at stumps on the second day in reply to India's first innings 438 in the second Test at Port of Spain in Trinidad. West Indies still trail India by 352 runs at the end of the second day. West Indian openers Kraigg Brathwaite and T a g e n a r i n e Chanderpaul stitched solid opening stand of 71 runs before Ravindra Jadeja picked up wicket of Chanderpaul.



Earlier, Indian star batsman Virat Kohli smashed magnificent 121 runs. With this ton, Virat Kohli has reached a milestone of 29 Test centuries in his highly

anticipated 500th international game. He equaled legendary Sir Don Bradman in the list of most test centuries. Bradman had scored 29 centuries in 52 tests

while Kohli achieved this feat in his 111th Test match. It was Virat's 76th international ton including 46 centuries in ODI and one in T20 format.

Skipper Rohit Sharma's 80 runs, Ravindra Jadeja's 61 and Ravichandran Ashwin's 56 helped India to post a massive total in their first innings. West Indian bowlers Kemar Roach and Shannon Gabriel picked up 3 wickets each.
