

## Chief Secretary's prompt action against black marketeers & hoarders of essential commodities yield results

### Extensive raids at godowns, warehouses & wholesale markets in different parts of city brings down prices of tomato, potato & onion

#### General public urged to report illegal activities of hoarders & black marketeers

Port Blair, May 18

The Chief Secretary, A&N Administration, Shri Jitendra Narain yesterday ordered to conduct multiple raids at different location in the city against black marketeers and hoarders of essential commodities like potato, tomato, onion etc. This prompt and timely action by the Chief Secretary against such practice which leads to price rise of the commodity has yielded result with the prices of these essential commodities coming down and its increased supply in the market. Extensive raids at godowns, warehouses & wholesale markets in different parts yesterday late night has also sent a stern warning to those indulging in such practices and depriving the people of essential commodities. The Chief Secretary has ordered stringent action against anybody found indulging in hoarding, black marketing and over pricing of essential commodities indicating scarcity of the commodities.

Acting swiftly on the directions of Chief Secretary, DC (SA), Secretary (CS & CA), Director (CS & CA), Jt. CPA personally monitored the

unloading of essential commodities and ensured timely supply of the same to retail outlets in market. Civil Supplies and PMB officials worked in coordination with each other. The Administration's stand towards zero tolerance against profit seekers exploiting the poor by malpractices like hoarding, black marketing and over pricing has resulted in sudden

downfall of market price of essential commodities to reasonable market rates like potato Rs.50/- per Kg, onion Rs.40/- per Kg and tomato Rs.110/- to Rs.120/- per kg in markets in and around Port Blair. Secretary (CS & CA) and Director (CS & CA) alongwith Civil Supplies officials visited vegetable market in Bathubasti in the late evening to monitor availability of the same at Retail outlets in

markets.

All the Vegetable vendors have once again advised to refrain from any unfair practices and over charging which may lead to exploitation of consumers. Stringent legal action as deemed fit will be initiated against anybody found indulged in such unfair trade practices as per the various provisions under the Essential Commodities Act, 1955 as well as the Legal Metrology Act, 2009. Offenders shall also be detained under the Prevention of Black Marketing and Maintenance of Supplies of Essential Commodities Act, 1980.

It is appealed to all the consumers that in case of any complaints regarding violation of any nature mentioned above by any traders, it may be brought to the notice of the Directorate of Civil Supplies & Consumer Affairs, Port Blair over Telephone No. 03192-230337. ## Vaccination drive in A & N Islands 12,122 beneficiaries in the age group of 12 to 14 yrs vaccinated so far

Port Blair, May 18

The vaccination drive is continuing smoothly in A&N Islands. As per data available, a total of 6,79,020 doses of vaccine have been administered to beneficiaries in the age group of 18 and above so far. Similarly, 23,464 beneficiaries have been vaccinated in the age group of 15 to 18 yrs and 12,122 beneficiaries have been vaccinated in the age group of 12 to 14 yrs. The number of beneficiaries administered precautionary dose of vaccine so far stood at 22944.

A total of 539 eligible beneficiaries were vaccinated in A&N Islands today. 405 eligible beneficiaries were vaccinated in South Andaman District, out of which, 25 beneficiaries were in the age group of 12-14 years, 8 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44 years and the number of beneficiaries administered precautionary dose of vaccine stood at 201. 33 beneficiaries were vaccinated in North & Middle Andaman District and the number of beneficiaries administered precautionary dose of vaccine stood at 32.

101 beneficiaries were vaccinated in Nicobar District, out of which, 5 beneficiaries were in the age group of 12-14 years and the number of beneficiaries administered precautionary dose of vaccine stood at 29, a press release from DHS said.

## PS Pahargaon cracks theft case in temple

Port Blair, May 18

In continuation to zero tolerance policy against any kind of crime, PS Pahargaon has cracked the theft case which took place at Selva Vinayaga Temple, Bhatubasti within 24 hours and arrested the accused person and recovered the stolen money amounting to Rs. 5674/-.

On 15/05/2022, a case vide FIR No. 84/2022 dtd 15/05/2022 U/s 380 IPC was registered at PS Pahargaon upon the complaint of Temple President, Selva Vinayaga Temple, Bathubasti regarding theft of money from the temple hundi. The investigation was entrusted to PSI Dilip

Singh of PS Pahargaon and during course of investigation, CCTV footage of the temple was analysed and the suspected person was identified to be a notorious thief Nayan Bar, S/o Bikash Bar, 21 yrs, Pvt. Worker, R/o Bhatubasti. A team of PS Pahargaon comprising of SI Mohd. Rahil Islam, HC/ A Raja, PC/Jagdish Babu, PC/Amit Kumar and PC/ Ashok Kumar under the supervision of Insp. Girish Kumar, SHO PS Pahargaon was constituted and the accused person was nabbed. He was arrested on 16/05/2022 at 1415 hrs and later during sustained examination, he confessed regarding committing

theft from the temple. The stainless steel heavy duty strip which was used to break open the hundi, shoulder bag containing the apparels which he wore during theft and cash of Rs. 5764/- was recovered from his possession. The team solved the theft case within 24 hours and successfully recovered the stolen money.

He outlined that wet-waste may be encouraged to manage at in-situ level within the individual household premises. Specifically, he directed all Panchayat Secretaries and VLWs to ensure that areas near main road, market places etc are not littered or dumped with waste. He also directed the State Directorate to conduct an assessment on the manpower requirement for Solid-waste management in Gram Panchayats.

Concluding the inaugural address, the Secretary (RD/Panchayat) exhorted for collaborated and collective efforts by all stakeholders to realize the vision and needs of the rural folk.

Earlier, welcoming the gathering, State Nodal Officer (RGSA) placed the context of the training programme and informed that the Gram Panchayats as part of the People's Plan Campaign prepares 'Gram Panchayat Development Plan' for each financial year. The GPDP sets the vision and mission of the Gram Panchayats collectively comprising of the activities that the Gram Panchayats shall be taking up under various sectors with the various Grant-in-Aid budget allocated. He emphasized that Govt. of India, Ministry of Panchayati Raj with an aim to digitalize the activities of the Gram Panchayats right from planning stage to its execution, monitoring, accounting and asset documentation has come up with an online digital platform called e-Gram Swaraj. The online e-Gram Swaraj provides an important platform to connect with citizens and to ensure better transparency in process and accountability of public funds.

The Sr. Accounts Officer (RD/P) addressing the gathering stressed on timely utilization of funds. He directed upon all Gram Panchayats to adopt works that are feasible and tangible at the ground level. He exhorted that implementation issues and delay in procedure causing delay in utilization of funds may be timely flagged to the knowledge of Block, District and State Directorate level so that timely redressal can be made.

The programme was followed by technical sessions conducted by the domain experts of the State Panchayat Resource Centre (SPRC) Directorate of RD, PRIs & ULBs. The participants were outlined on the modalities and process of updation of data in the e-Gram Swaraj portal and the system of monitoring of activities with the help of the online dashboard. Technical sessions were also conducted on PFMS portal. Thereafter, handholding sessions were conducted on e-Gram Swaraj and mAction Soft mobile application, a press release from DC (SA) said.
