### Survey attended by 5559 students of Grade III, V, VIII & X

#### Inputs will be used for policy planning to improve quality and ensure equity in learning

Port Blair, Nov. 12

The National Achievement Survey-2021 was conducted in Andaman and Nicobar Islands today in Govt. Schools, Govt. Aided schools, Private unaided and Central Govt. Schools. The survey was attended by 1105 students of Grade III, 808 students of Grade V, 2103 of students of Grade VIII and 1543 of students of Grade X in 170 sampled schools (71 schools in South



Andaman, 33 schools in Nicobar and 66 schools in North & Middle Andaman Districts). For conducting the survey, District wise Nodal Officer,

Coordinator, Board representatives were appointed by CBSE. Field Investigators and Observers were also deputed for sampled class in each school for

administering NAS-2021 in this UT.

It is an endeavor to assess the impact on learning outcomes of the COVID pandemic related lockdown. Based

on the NAS 2021 report, States and UTs will be able to assess the learning gaps and take appropriate remedial measures to bridge the gaps. The inputs from NAS 2021

will be used for policy planning and designing pedagogical interventions to improve quality and ensure equity in learning, a press release from SIE, Shiksha Sadan said.

to the problems being faced by the passengers. The DC (SA) after hearing the problems of the passengers made several decisions on the spot to mitigate the problems of the passengers availing the ship facilities from Port Blair to different islands.

## Farmers' Corner- A Knowledge Hub

### Teressa goat - First goat breed registered from A&N Islands

*Teressa goat is the first indigenous goat breed from Andaman & Nicobar Islands to be registered at ICAR-NBAGR, Karnal. In Nicobari language it is known as Pookore which means goat. Due to their origin and distribution in Teressa Islands and other islands of Nicobar it is popularly known as Teressa goat. Native breeding tract is mainly found in the Nicobar group of islands viz. Teressa Island, Car Nicobar, Katchal, Nancowrie etc. However, sparse population is also available at Little Andaman and Andaman Islands also. They are generally tall, sturdy, brownish or dark tan or black or white in colour with white and black patches. There is black hairs on dorsal midline which goes up to the tail. Peculiar white patch/line starting from inner canthus of both eyes or from eye brows and extending up to nostrils or mouth. Colour of the muzzle, eyelids and hoofs are black. Height ranges from 24 to 27 inches. Head length of male and female is 8.86±0.10 and 7.5±0.27 inches respectively. Tail is medium to long. Horn is large with flat at its base. Ears are erected and directing towards downwards. Age at maturity is about 8-9 months. Body weight at 12 months varies from 20-25 kg, weight at 2 years varies from 35-40 kg, and at 4 years varied from 50-65 kg. Average milk yield may go up to 1 litre/day. Twinning is common and it is more than 53%. The present population of this breed is less than 9000 which needs attention for conservation and further propagation in the native breeding tract.*

In anticipation of formation of low pressure area over South Andaman Sea around Nov. 13 and its likely intensification, enhanced rainfall activity with heavy rainfall is likely to occur over the districts of A&N Islands from Nov. 13 to 15. Heavy to very heavy rainfall (07-20 cm) with thunderstorm & lightning and gusty wind (speed reaching 30-40 kmph) is likely to occur at one or two places over Andaman & Nicobar Islands on Nov.14 while on Nov. 13 & 15, heavy rain (7-11 cm) with thunderstorm & lightning and gusty wind (speed reaching 30-40 kmph) is also likely to occur in A&N Islands.

Fishermen have been advised not to venture into the South Andaman Sea and adjoining South East Bay of Bengal on Nov.13 to15, 2021. Those who are in deep sea have been advised to return to the coast by Nov. 13 morning.

AYURVEDA DAY 2021  
'Ayurveda for Poshan'



BEETROOT HALWA

Ingredients	Quantity
Beetroot	- 2 ( 300 gm)
Ghee	- 2 to 3 tbsp
Milk	- 300 ml
Sugar	- 1/2 cup (100 gm)
Cashew nuts	- 10 to 12 (finely chopped)
Almonds	- 8 to 10 (finely chopped)
Raisins	- 1 table spoon
Cardamom	- as per taste

Method of preparation

Pour 2 table spoons ghee in a pan, as it melts, add washed, peeled and grated beetroot to it. Stir and roast on medium flame for 2 to 3 minutes, then add milk, cook it on low or medium flame until it becomes dense. Now add sugar and cook till liquid content gets evaporated. Add chopped and roasted dry fruits such as cashews and almonds.

Health benefits
