Addressing the high-level segment of One Ocean Summit today, Shri Modi said that India has recently undertaken a nationwide awareness campaign to clean plastics and other wastes from coastal areas.

He said, three lakh young people collected around 13



tonnes of plastic waste. The Prime Minister also informed that the Indian Navy has been directed to contribute 100 ship days this year to cleaning plastic wastes from

the seas. Shri Modi added that India will be happy to join France in launching a global initiative on single-use plastic. In his address, the Prime Minister said that India has always been a maritime civilization and today our security and prosperity are linked to oceans. Shri Modi mentioned that India's Indo-Pacific Ocean Initiative contains marine resources as a key pillar. (Source: india.gov.in)

Country's inflation rate stands at 6.2% despite COVID-19 pandemic : FM

New Delhi, Feb. 11

Finance Minister, Smti Nirmala Sitharaman has asserted that the Government's inflation management is robust and the inflation rate stands at 6.2 percent despite the challenges posed by the unprecedented COVID-19 pandemic. She said this while replying to discussion on the Union Budget 2022-23 in the Rajya Sabha today.

Referring to the global financial crisis in 2008-09, she said, the Indian economy witnessed a contraction of 2.12 lakh crore rupees during that time, whereas the country witnessed contraction of 9.57 lakh crore rupees during the Covid-19 pandemic. She said, despite the huge contraction in the economy during the pandemic, the country's CPI inflation

is at 6.2 per cent whereas it was 9.1 percent in 2008-09.

The Minister said, Union Budget 2022-23 talks about the stability and creating modern infrastructure in the upcoming 25 years. She said the Budget will bring continuity and stability in the economy. She stressed that stability will ensure growth of the economy. (Source: india.gov.in)

People should not be made to wait unnecessarily and there should be no clandestine act in the allotment of quarters. Every

allotment order must be open for public for objections for seven days. The Chief Secretary said, "we cannot deprive Govt. Servants of what is their due entitlement".

It is to mention that the Housing & Estate Section, Andaman and Nicobar Administration, Secretariat had allotted various types of Govt. Accommodations

under General category through the Automated Allotment of Government Accommodation Application in the last round of allotment on 02/02/2022.

After last round of allotment of Govt. Accommodations, it is noticed that most of vacant Type-I, Type-II, Type-III and Type-IV quarters located at Nayagaon and Prothrapur areas could not be

allotted, as no applicant preferring these areas are available for allotment in the seniority list.

All applicants whose names have appeared in the seniority list have been requested to submit their revised willingness for change of preferred area as Nayagaon and Prothrapur, so that the vacant quarters at Nayagaon and Prothrapur could be allotted to the

needy Govt. The basic mandate of Model Code of Conduct is to curb the corrupt practices (distribution of liquor or bribery, influencing/pressurizing voter etc.) and to ensure that all electioneering process including permission for loudspeaker and procession is being run on the line prescribed by the Panchayat and Municipal Regulations & Rules and various directions issued by the Election Commission

(UTs) from time to time.

In case of violation of any provisions of Model Code of Conduct, FIR against the violators will be lodged and stern action will be taken under the relevant provisions of the law.

Similarly, defacement by means of interfering with the appearance of duty, damaging, disfiguring, spoiling or injuring in any other way of any property including building, hut, structure, wall, tree, fence, post, pole or any other erection, be it private (without consent of owner) or public is strictly prohibited under A & N Prevention of Defacement of Property Regulation, 1987. 




